Orange Tangle With The Tigers

Following the postponement of Wednesday's home contest with Louisville, Syracuse moves to South Carolina to take on Clemson, Saturday afternoon.

The Syracuse-Clemson Series

- ✓ The Tigers lead the all-time series with the Orange, 6-4. Clemson has won four of five pairings at home.
- ✓ Last season at Clemson, a 32-point outburst from Tevin Mack and a Clyde Trapp layup with two seconds left allowed the Tigers to edge the Orange, 71-70.

Syracuse Notes

- ✓ After NC State made 17-of-30 shots (.567) in the first half on Sunday, the second half saw the Orange limit the Wolfpack to 10-of-31 (.323) shooting from the field and 0-8 shooting from beyond the arc en route to a 76-73 victory.
- ✓ The assist turnover ratios of **Buddy Boenheim** (2.05) and **Kadary Richmond** (2.04) rank fifth and sixth respectively in the ACC
- ✓ The Orange have converted .798 of their free-throw attempts. The school record is .751, set in 1983-84.

Clemson Notes

- ✓ The Tigers took down North Carolina at home on Tuesday, 63-50.
- ✓ Senior forward Aamir Simms leads Clemson in scoring (12.3), rebounding (5.9) and assist (2.8) average.
- ✓ The Tigers hold opponents to 61.6 points per game, the 2nd-best mark in the ACC.

Quincy Guerrier

- ✓ **Jan. 31:** Facing a nine-point deficit at halftime, Syracuse outscored NC State 38-26 during the second stanza to defeat the Wolfpack, 76-73.
- ✓ Alan Griffin led the Orange with 19 points while Quincy Guerrier recorded his seventh double-double of the year (10 pts., 10 reb.).
- ✓ **Jan. 25:** Eighth-ranked Virginia connected on 14 3-pointers and built a 13-rebound advantage en route to an 81-58 victory against Syracuse.
- ✓ **Quincy Guerrier** led the Orange with 15 points while **Alan Griffin** grabbed a team-best eight boards.
- ✓ **Jan. 23:** Clinging to a 47-44 advantage with 13:48 left in the second half, SU rattled off a 20-4 run to take control en route to a 78-60 win against #16/14 Virginia Tech.
- ✓ Syracuse's front line of **Quincy Guerrier** (20 points), **Marek Dolezaj** (18) and **Alan Griffin** (15) led the Orange. Griffin had a career-best seven blocked shots.
- ✓ **Jan. 19:** Despite trailing 11-2, the Orange rallied past Miami, 83-57. Buddy Boeheim and Joseph Girard III each had 23 points.
- ✓ Syracuse forced 17 Miami turnovers, and outscored the 'Canes on points off turnovers, 27-3.
- ✓ **Jan. 16:** A 64-point second half propelled Pittsburgh to a 96-76 win against Syracuse.
- ✓ **Alan Griffin** scored a career-high 28 points, including 20 in the second half. **Quincy Guerrier** posted 18 points and 13 rebounds.
- ✓ **Jan. 12:** North Carolina outscored Syracuse 14-7 over the game's final three minutes to defeat the Orange in Chapel Hill, 81-75.

- ✓ **Quincy Guerrier** recorded his fifth double-double of the season with 23 points and 11 rebounds. He also tallied a career-high five blocks. **Buddy Boeheim** (18) and **Alan Griffin** (16) each scored in double-figures.
- ✓ **Jan. 9:** Syracuse prevailed against former BIG EAST rival Georgetown, 74-69.
- ✓ Four SU players scored 10+ points -- **Buddy Boeheim** (21), **Joseph Girard III** (18), **Quincy Guerrier** (12) and **Marek Dolezaj** (11).
- ✓ **Jan. 6:** Syracuse lost control of what was an 18-point, first-half lead, and Pittsburgh prevailed, 63-60. The visiting Panthers took their first lead with eight seconds left.
- ✓ **Alan Griffin** had a squad-best 15 points and eight rebounds. **Robert Braswell** connected on four 3-pointers and ended up with a career-high 12 points.

- ✓ **Dec. 19:** Syracuse rallied from a 16-point second-half deficit to beat Buffalo in overtime, 107-96. **Alan Griffin** had a last-second, game-saving block in regulation to extend the contest into overtime.
- ✓ Five players scored in double digits for the Orange -- **Quincy Guerrier** (27), **Alan Griffin** (24), **Buddy Boeheim** (22), **Marek Dolezaj** (19) and **Kadary Richmond** (13). Guerrier and Griffin completed double-doubles with 11 and 10 rebounds, respectively.

A layup by Clyde Trapp with 2.4 seconds remaining in regulation propelled Clemson past Syracuse, 71-70, at Littlejohn Coliseum. The loss snapped the Orange's five-game winning streak.

"I thought we played a good game. We had a dead spot in the second half and we didn't get that many trips down the floor. We just made some mistakes you can't make. Clemson is a good team, a good defensive team. It's not that easy to play against them."

Syracuse was led by Elijah Hughes and Buddy Boeheim, who each finished the night with 22 points. After leading by as many as 10 points in the second half, the Orange found themselves trailing, 59-56, with 7:04 to play in the game. Two 3-balls down the stretch from Joseph Girard III and four points in less than a minute from Hughes put Syracuse ahead, 70-67, with 1:34 on the clock.

Clemson responded with four consecutive points, including a layup through contact from Trapp with two seconds left to give the Tigers the edge, 71-70.

The Orange turned over the Tigers 16 times in the outing and accumulated 10 steals. Syracuse only gave up the ball eight times.

Clemson won the board wars, 36-26.





Mike Krzyzewski (Army, Duke) is the only active Division I coach who is ahead of Boeheim on the wins and games-coached list.

Boeheim's 44 seasons completed put him first on the list of Division I coaches at their current schools. Krzyzewski is second with 39 campaigns at Duke.

The Book On Boeheim

Boeheim owns a career record of *974-403 (.707).

His 1,375 games (total reflects 101 games vacated between 2004-07 and 2010-12 by the NCAA) ranks first for coaches who have served at only one institution in the Division I ranks.

The 2019 NCAA berth gave SU 40 post-season appearances under Boeheim, including 34 NCAA Tournaments. He has guided his alma mater to the NCAA title game three times, winning it for the first time in 2003.
