HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

- Clemson vs. NC State is the 11th oldest series in Clemson men's soccer history.
- Clemson enters Saturday's contest with a 22-match unbeaten streak at home. This is the third longest unbeaten streak in program history. Clemson started its current streak on Oct. 23, 2018.
- With one more solo shutout, George Marks would move into a tie for ninth all-time for career solo shutouts at Clemson. Marks is currently tied for 11th with 10 solo shutouts.
- With five saves, Marks would become the 15th player in program history to record 100 or more saves in a career.
- With a win, Clemson would improve to 56-10-3 when playing a match ranked No. 1.
- With a win, Clemson would improve to 40-3-1 when playing a home match ranked No. 1.

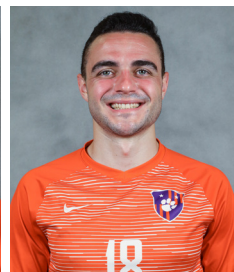

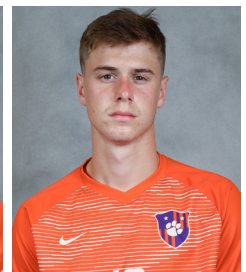

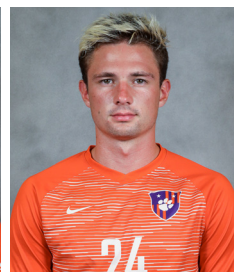
