- Clemson and American will meet for the first time since Sept. 19, 1986.

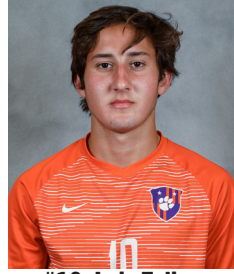

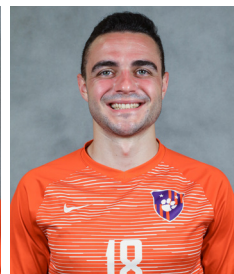

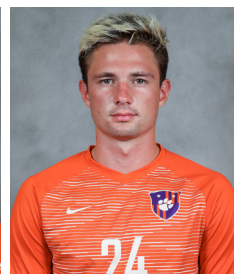
