- > Temple travels south to take part in the Shriners Children's Charleston Classic. The Owls open with Clemson, a team they have met three previous times in the event. Temple is 1-2 in meetings with the Tigers at this tournament with the Owls lone win coming in the championship game of the 2017 Classic.
- > This is Temple's first road contest of the young season as the Owls split two game at the Liacouras Center, defeating Maryland Eastern Shore, 72-49, on Nov. 10 and falling 76-71 to USC on Nov. 13.
- > Clemson is 3-0 on the season winning home games against Presbyterian, Wofford and Bryant.
- > Temple will play either St. Bonaventure or Boise State in the second game on Friday afternoon.
- > The rest of the field includes Elon, Marquette, Mississippi and West Virginia.

NEWS AND NOTES

SCOUTING TEMPLE

- > Khalif Battle leads the Owls and ranks second in the AAC in scoring at 24 ppg. He is third in the league in FG% (.548), tied for first in threes per game (4.0) and fourth with teammate Zach Hicks in 3PT% (.500).
- > Damian Dunn (13.0 ppg) is the only other Owls averaging double figures and is tied for the AAC lead in FT% (9-9, 1.000).
- > Nick Jourdain (3.5 ppg) is tied for fourth in the AAC in rebounding (9.0 rpg) despite averaging just 20.5 mpg off the bench.
- > Jeremiah Williams (4.5 ppg) is tied for fifth in the AAC in assists (4.5 apg).
- > Tai Strickland (9.5 ppg) and Hicks (8.5 ppg) have been impressive off the bench,
- > Sage Tolbert III (2.0 ppg/5.0 rpg) and Jake Forrester (5.0 ppg/4.5 rpg) round out the Owls starting five.

SCOUTING CLEMSON

- > Clemson, under the direction of head coach Brad Brownell, is off to a 3-0 start, defeating Presbyterian, Wofford and Bryant all at home.
- > Four of the Tigers five starters average double figures with AL-Amir Dawes leading the way at 17.0 ppg.
- > Clemson was picked to finish 11th in the ACC this season by select media, however, the Tigers have outperformed.
- the preseason poll rankings in eight of Brad Brownell's 11 seasons in Tigertown.
- > The Tigers finished the 2020-21 season 16-8 overall, including 10-6 in the ACC and earned their 13th NCAA Tournament berth in program history and second in the last four years.

SERIES HISTORY

- > This is the sixth meeting in the series will each contest being held in the state of South Carolina.
- > Temple leads the series 3-2, with the Owls defeated the Tigers, 67-60, to win the 2017 Charleston Classic. Clemson had won the prior two meetings, both in the Charleston Classic. Clemson won in the first game of the 2013 Classic, 72-58, and downed Temple in the 2008 championship game, 76-72.
- > The Owls' other wins in the series came in 1991, 71-52, at Clemson and in the 1981 NIT, a 90-82, decision at Clemson.

LAST MEETING: TEMPLE 67, @USC 60 (Charleston, S.C. - Nov. 20, 2017)

- > Five players reached double figures in scoring to lead Temple to a 67-60 win over Clemson and the championship of the 2017 Gildan Charleston Classic. It marked the first time in program history that Temple (3-0) opened a season with three straight wins away from home.
- > Senior forward Obi Enechionya was named the Gildan Charleston Classic MVP, while sophomore guard Quinton Rose notched the first double-double of his career against Clemson and also earned a spot on the All-Tournament Team.
- > Shizz Alston, Jr. finished with a team-high 14 points, followed by Josh Brown with 13. Enechionya and Alani Moore scored 12 points apiece, and Rose rounded out the double-figure scorers with 10 points.
- > Sheldon Mitchell led three Tiger double figure scorers with 16 points.

LAST GAME: USC 76, @TEMPLE 71 (NOV. 13, 2021)

- > Temple came back from 23 down in the second half to close within three points but was not able to finish its rally in falling to visiting USC, 76-71.
- > Khalif Battle led all scorers for the second straight game, tallying 26 points.
- > Nick Jourdain led all rebounders again, tying his career-high set in the opener with nine while also making three steals.
- > USC broke open the game midway through the first half with a 16-2 run, then tacked on a 15-5 stretch to take a 46-27 lead at the half.
- >After USC built its lead up to 23, Temple used a 9-0 run over to cut the margin to 14, 55-41, with just under 14 minutes to play.
- > Temple kept the pressure on, and after trading baskets ran off 13 straight points with the run including a nearly 30-foot three-pointer from Battle and a Tai Strickland trey to make it 58-54 at 9:42 on the clock.
- > The Owls would stay close, but were never able to cut the margin below three (74-71).

1,946 Victories

5th All-Time in Wins

- > Temple's 90-73 victory over ECU on Feb. 7, 2018 put the Owls in elite company as they joined Kentucky, Kansas, North Carolina and Duke with 1,900 wins. Temple Basketball owns a 122-year won-loss record of 1,940-1,094. The Owls history also includes:
- > 52 postseason tournament appearances (33 NCAAs, 19 NITs)
- > Two Final Four appearances (1956 and 1958) under Harry "The Chief" Litwack.
- > Five regional finals in 22 years under John Chaney (1988, 1991, 1993, 1999 and 2001)
- > NIT championships in 1938 and 1969.
- > Two Naismith Basketball Association Hall of Fame Coaches in Litwack and Chaney.

NEWS AND NOTES

IN-SEASON TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- > This is the 83rd in-season tournament/classic that Temple has competed in during its program history.
- >The Owls own a 101-73 overall record in tournament/classic games.
- >Temple has won 15 tournament championships (not including single-game classics). The Owls have won two tournaments over the last five seasons: 2017 Charleston Classic; 2016 Preseason NIT.
- > This is the fourth time Temple will take part in the Charleston Classic with the Owls owning a 7-2 record in the event.

BATTLE BACK AT IT

- > Temple guard Khalif Battle has continued where he left off at the end of 2020-21, torching the nets.
- > The transfer from Butler led the Owls in scoring last season, averaging 15 ppg, despite joining the team late due to an injury.
- > Battle scored 20 or more points in four games and double figures in eight of the 11 games he competed. He closed the year averaging 23.3 ppg in his final four contests, scoring a season-high 32 against USF on Feb. 21.
- > So far this season, he has had game highs of 22 and 26 points to start the year and his 24 ppg ranks second in the AAC.

CHARITY STRIPING

- > Damian Dunn has a knack for getting to the foul line. Last season, he ranked fifth in the NCAA in free throws made per game (6.08) and attempts (7.92).
- > He is the first Owl to average more than six free throws made per game since Khalif Wyatt set the school record for free throws made in a season with 204 in 2012-13 for a 6.00 average per game. Wyatt averaged 6.97 attempts per game that season.
- > Temple single season records are held by Bill "Pickles" Kennedy for free throws made per game (6.8, 1959-60) and Jim Williams for free throws attempted pergame (8.9, 1963-64).
- > This season he is a perfect 9-of-9 from the field, averaging 4.5 made and attempts per contest while ranking second on the team with a 13.0 scoring average.

PASSING FANCY

- > Point guard Jeremiah Williams became just the second Temple true freshman to lead the team in assists when he averaged 4.1 per game last season. He joins Pepe Sanchez, who averaged 5.3 apg during the 1996-97 season.
- > Williams has picked up right where he left off, leading Temple with four assists against Maryland Eastern Shore and five versus USC for a 4.5 average.

STRICKLY SPEAKING

- > Tai Strickland is back, healthy and making an impact on the 2021-22 team.
- > Bothered the past two years with a shoulder injury, Strickland is an integral part of the Owls rotation this season, averaging 16 minutes and ranking third on the squad in scoring (9.5 ppg).
- > His 19 points in the first two games are more than all of last season (14).

AIR JOURDAIN

- > Nick Jourdain, who cracked the Temple starting lineup at the end of last season, is having a strong year off the bench this season.
- > In his first two games, he has averaged 9.0 rebounds to lead Temple and rank third in the conference. He also is averaging 3.5 points in 20.5 minutes per game.

FRESHMAN FACTOR

- > Zach Hicks has given Temple a spark off the bench in his first two collegiate games.
- > The true freshmen has averaged 8.5 points per game (4th on team) while tying Khalif Battle for three-point percentage (5-10, 50%).
- > Hicks hit two keys threes during a second half run that helped the Owls break away from Maryland Eastern Shore in the season opener.

NEW FACES OF TEMPLE

- > Temple has two new faces at the helm now as Dr. Jason Wingard took over as the university's new president over the summer, and Arthur Johnson was announced as the Owls' new Vice President and Director of Athletics on October 7.
- > Wingard comes to Temple after previously serving as the dean of the School of Professional Studies at Columbia University.
- > Johnson joins the Owls from the University of Texas where he served as the Executive Senior Associate Athletic Director for Facilities and Operations.

NEWS AND NOTES

WALKING ON

- > Ryan Sayers, a 6-1, 175-pound junior guard who played his high school basketball at Owen J Roberts, made the Temple University men's basketball team as a walk-on.
- > Sayers averaged 14 points as a senior (2018-19) at Owen J. Roberts, while making 40 three-pointers and earning the team's Offensive Player of the Year award.
- > A standout student at Temple, Sayers has been on the dean's list every semester and owns a 3.95 cumulative grade point average while majoring in risk management and insurance.

MAKING AN IMPACT

- > Temple Men's Basketball signed 15-year-old Omar Singhateh in September 2021.
- > A member of the Team Impact program, Omar signed his letter in front of the Temple Basketball team and his parents and younger brother in the program's film room.
- > Omar, who lives with sickle cell, a condition that affects his red blood cells, resides in Philadelphia with his parents and three brothers. He was matched with the Temple men's basketball team in September of 2020, and since then, he and his teammates have been communicating virtually.

FOUR OWLS NAMED TO NABC HONORS COURT; TEAM HONORED

- > The National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) announced the 2020-21 NABC Honors Court in July and four Owls Jake Forrester (Criminal Justice), Arashma Parks (Advertising), Tai Strickland (Finance) and Colin Daly (Business Management).
- > Temple was also recognized with the Team Academic Excellence award for outstanding academic achievement by a team with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better for the 2020-21 season.

FOR THREE

- > Temple has made at least one three-pointer in 815 consecutive games.
- > The last time the Owls did not make a three-pointer in a game was February 1, 1996. Temple missed all 16 three-point attempts that day in dropping a 59-35 decision to #1 UMass at McGonigle Hall.

GOING OT

- > Temple is 66-50 all-time in overtime games and have won their last seven overtime contests.
- > Since the 2014-15, Temple is tied first in the nation in OT wins with Auburn. The Owls are 12-3 during this span with Auburn at 12-2.
- > Temple last played an overtime contest on Feb. 20, 2020, a 93-89 2OT win over UConn.
- > Aaron McKie is 2-0 in overtime games as the head coach at Temple.

LEGACY OWL

CHARLESTON CHARM

> Temple will again play in the Shriners Children's Charleston Classic, meeting Clemson on Thursday, Nov. 18 at 4 p.m.

> Temple will play either St. Bonaventure or Boise State in its second game of the tournament, held at TD Arena in Charleston, S.C. on Nov. 19 (12/2:30 p.m.) The rest of the field includes Marquette, Ole Miss, Elon, and West Virginia.

> This is the fourth time the Owls will compete in the Charleston Classic, with Temple defeating Clemson to take home the title in 2017. Temple won the first two games of the 2008 tournament before falling to the Tigers in the championship game and dropped the opener against the Tigers in 2013 on the way to a fifth-place finish.

> The Owls have a 7-2 record in the Charleston Classic and have won the last five games in the event.

> Temple is 53-17 all-time against former Atlantic 10 Conference rival St. Bonaventure, but has not met the Bonnies since 2013.

> Another A10 rival, the Owls own a 37-34 advantage against West Virginia, last meeting the Mountaineers in the championship game of the 2016 preseason NIT. Temple won that contest, 81-77, at the Barclays Center.

> Temple owns a 3-1 advantage against Mississippi with the last meeting on Nov. 18, 1998 at the Liacouras Center, a 68-52 Owls win.

> The Owls are 2-0 against Marquette, the last meeting coming during the 1994-95 season.

> Temple has never met Boise State or Elon.



HEAD COACH **AARON MCKIE**

One of the greatest players in Temple Basketball history, Aaron McKie is in his third season as the head coach at his alma mater.

McKie officially took over the program where he starred under Hall of Fame coach John Chaney and served as an assistant coach for five seasons under Fran Dunphy, in April

of 2019. He is the 18th head coach in Temple men's basketball history, but just the fifth since Hall of Fame coach Harry Litwack took over the reins of the program in 1952. He is also the first alum to serve as the Owls' head coach since Litwack, who won 373 games and made two Final Four appearances in his 21-year tenure.

His first season at the helm was a year of transition for the new Temple mentor. After starting the season with four straight wins, which is the best start by a first-year Temple coach since Josh Cody ('42-'43), the Owls fell in a close contest, 76-69, to #5 Maryland. The team ended the calendar year with a 9-3 mark, but the 2020 took its toll.

Temple posted just one win in January, but that victory, a 65-53 defeat of #16 Wichita State, extended the program streak of 13 straight seasons with a win over a ranked foe. McKie also became the first first-year Temple coach to defeat a nationally-ranked team since 1952-53 (Harry Litwack).

After regrouping, the Owls finished the 2019-20 campaign with a 14-17 record with the season coming to abrupt end to the Covid-19 pandemic.

His second season was full of stop and starts due to the pandemic. Temple, which had a limited preseason due to health restrictions in the city of Philadelphia, was unable to open its season until Dec. 19, a home victory of NJIT, due to Covid protocol issues within the program.

These protocol issues would result in five stoppages during the season and the cancellation of all but 15 regular season games. Without able to gain a rhythm, the Owls struggled during the 2020-21 campaign, finishing with a 5-11 record, 4-10 in conference play.

Prior to taking over as head coach, McKie served five seasons on Dunphy's staff at Temple, the last as associate head coach. In 2018-29, the Owls went 23-10, earned an NCAA Tournament berth and tied for third in the American Athletic Conference after being picked to finish sixth. The 20-win season was the third for Temple in McKie's five years on the staff, during which the Owls went to the NCAA Tournament twice and to the NIT Semifinals in 2015.

The Philadelphia basketball roots are deep for McKie and started in high school where he played at nearby Simon Gratz ('90). There, under the tutelage of legendary coach Bill Ellerbee, he helped lead the

Bulldogs to the 1990 Philadelphia Public League Championship, their first title since 1939.

McKie then took his talents to North Broad Street to play under another legend in Chaney. Arguably one of the best players in Temple history, he had an incredible three-year playing career for the Owls (1991-92 through 1993-94) and is tied for sixth on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,650 points. A starter for all 92 games, he averaged 17.9 points per game while leading the Owls to three NCAA Tournaments and a trip to the 1993 Elite Eight. He earned many accolades during his heralded collegiate career, including Atlantic 10 Conference and Philadelphia Big 5 Player of the Year for his performance in the 1992-93 season, when he averaged a team-best 20.6 points per game.

Selected in the first round (17th overall) of the 1994 NBA Draft by the Portland Trail Blazers, McKie played 13 seasons, including eight with the Philadelphia 76ers where he was coached by another basketball giant in Larry Brown. As a member of the Sixers in 2000-01, McKie enjoyed his best season, taking home Sixth Man of the Year honors while helping his hometown team reach the NBA Finals.

McKie has more than a decade of coaching experience. Besides serving as an assistant coach under Dunphy for the past five seasons, he was also a five-year assistant (2007-13) on the 76ers staff and helped lead the franchise to four NBA playoff appearances.

McKie resides in the Philadelphia area with his wife, Lisa, and their four children, Erin, Jaron, and twin sons Justin and Julian.

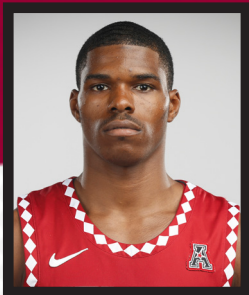

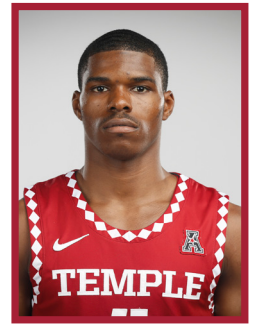
