NEED TO KNOW

Block Party Tag-Team

- Senior Ava Pritchard and junior Ani Clark have combined for 122 blocks this season to lead Clemson.
- Either Pritchard (11-49-60) or Clark (14-48-62) has led Clemson in blocks in every match but three this fall.

Martin Among Nation's Best Finishers

- Graduate Kaylee Martin ranks 9th among active players in the NCAA with 1,981 career points.
- Martin surpassed 1,900 career points against Virginia with 17 kills on the night.
- Martin spent three seasons at Illinois State and one at Northern Illinois, where she amassed 1,536 kills and 748 digs, and was a four-time all-conference performer. She is using an additional season granted by the NCAA due to COVID.
- She leads Clemson with 267 kills this season following the UNC match.

Tigers Off to Hot Start

- Clemson entered ACC play 8-3, securing two tournament victories.
- The Tigers are 7-6 at home led by new Head Coach Jackie Kirr. Kirr's 7 wins mark the most-home victories for a head coach in their inaugural season since Jolene Hoover won 13 in 1993.
- Camryn Hannah (3.09) and Kaylee Martin (3.30) are each averaging over 3 K/S.

Slavik Hits a Milestone

- Junior setter Mckenna Slavik became just the 11th setter in Clemson history with 2,000 career assists, in her 57th match against UNC Asheville. She currently holds 2,535 assists for her career.
- Slavik now ranks 7th in Clemson history in career assists and her 9.60 assists/set career average is fifth in Clemson history (min. 2 seasons).

Familiar Face Leads the Pack

- Head Coach Jackie Simpson Kirr spent four (4) seasons as the Associate Head Coach for the Tigers prior to becoming Head Coach in May 2021.
- Prior to her arrival at Clemson, Kirr was the Head Coach at George Mason.

- Clemson's 68 kills, 149 attempts and 0.342 attack percentage against Wake Forest rank as the 2nd-most in the ACC this season in five-set matches.
- Ani Clark's 10 blocks (2 solo, 8 assists) against North Carolina is tied for sixth in the ACC this season.
- Mckenna Slavik averages 9.60 assists per set over her career, fifth-best in Clemson history.
- Freshman Devan Taylor is averaging 3.83 digs/set in her last 21 career matches; This mark would be third in Clemson history once the minimum of 2 seasons is met.

Head Coach Jackie Simpson Kirr



Jackie Simpson Kirr, a two-time All-American setter at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, just completed her fourth season as Clemson Volleyball Associate Head Coach and the team's offensive and recruiting coordinator. Kirr joined staff on April 24, 2017 and was named head coach on May 6, 2021.

Since arriving at Clemson, Kirr helped guide the Tigers to their first postseason appearance since 2009 and mentored four different players that earned All-ACC accolades on five occasions. Kirr has also raised the bar when it comes to recruiting. After bringing in two recruiting classes that were given honorable mention recognition by the AVCA, Clemson's 2020 recruiting class was tabbed No. 24 in the nation and was just one of two recruiting classes in the nation to feature four All-Americans.

Last season, Kirr and the Tigers went 3-0, including a sweep over SEC foe Georgia as well as a four-set win over a 2019 NCAA tournament qualifier in Kennesaw State, to win the annual Big Orange Bash tournament. Clemson's 2019 non-conference slate was also highlighted by the program's first-ever win over Central Arkansas as well as victories over Appalachian State and Oral Roberts. Kirr and the Tigers made history in the month of October last year when Clemson downed four straight ACC opponents, a first for the program since 2012. Outside hitter Kaylin Korte garnered Second Team All-ACC status for the second time of her career, having done so in 2017, after Korte tied for fifth in the conference in kills (3.58/set). Additionally, freshman setter McKenna Slavik was one of just five Power-5 freshman setters to average at least 9.70 assists per set.

In 2019, Kirr mentored then redshirt-sophomore Brooke Bailey, a transfer from Ohio State, who earned Second Team All-ACC honors after she finished the regular season ranked fifth in kills (3.71/set) against ACC opponents. Additionally, former Clemson setter Gabby Easton and right side hitter Solei Thomas were named to the All-ACC Freshman Team. Easton was the top freshman setter in the conference after leading all freshmen in the ACC in assists during the regular season with 1,278 (10.74/set), which also put her at No. 3 overall in the ACC. Her 10.74 assists-per-set average was also good for fifth in the nation among all freshmen and ranked third among Power-5 freshmen. Easton's 1,278 assists were also the second most by a freshman in program history, a milestone that she reached with two matches remaining in Clemson's regular season. Thomas ranked second on the team in kills after averaging 2.89 kills per set in 2018. Thomas totaled 17 double-digit kill matches, including a career-best 20 kills against Appalachian State (Sept. 1, 2018). Both Easton and Thomas were named ACC Freshman of the Week on two occasions each. The 2018 ACC postseason awards announcement marked the first time since 2011 Clemson collected three ACC postseason selections.

Since joining the Tigers' staff, Kirr has lured three Power-5 transfers to Clemson in outside hitters Bailey (Ohio State) and Korte (Illinois), and former Clemson setter Caroline Pearson (Arizona State). In 2017, Kirr guided Korte to Second Team All-ACC status, who led the team in kills (3.36/set) and attempts (9.67/set). In the Tigers' opening match of 2017, a win over Bethune-Cookman, Simpson-Kirr steered Pearson to tally 57 assists, which was second-most in a four-set match among all ACC players in 2017.

Kirr was the Head Coach at George Mason in Fairfax, Virginia from 2015-16. In her first season with the Patriots, she led the team to the best Atlantic-10 finish in program history and its best overall record since 2010. While at the helm of the Patriot program, Simpson-Kirr served on the AVCA All-American Selection Committee in 2016, during which time she was the East Region Committee Chair. She also earned the AVCA's 30-under-30 Award in 2015, a prestigious national honor awarded to the top 30 volleyball coaches, at any level, under the age of 30.

Kirr was a standout setter both on the court and in the classroom at Wisconsin from 2004-07. She led the Badgers to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including two Elite Eight berths. Kirr was a two-time AVCA All-American and a two-time All-Big Ten selection. She ranks second all-time in Wisconsin program history in career assists and is 19th all-time among Big Ten setters.

Kirr earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Letters & Science – Sociology from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 2008. She earned a Master of Science degree in Exercise & Sport Science – Sport Psychology from East Carolina in 2013.

Kirr and her wife, Jordy Kirr, have two children, Jackson and Besser.

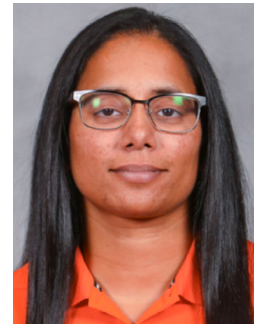

UNC Tops Clemson in Five-Setter

CLEMSON, S.C – Clemson Volleyball fought off a 2-1 set deficit against North Carolina and forced a decisive fifth set before ultimately falling to the Tar Heels (18-5, 7-5 ACC) in five, 17-25, 25-23, 23-25, 25-20, 14-16. Clemson (11-12, 3-9 ACC) fell to 7-6 inside Jervy Gym for the season.

Graduate Transfer Kaylee Martin led all players with a season-high 23 kills on .432 hitting, while true freshman Azyah Dailey notched 3 blocks and a season-high 15 kills to lead Clemson offensively. The Tigers' 14.0 blocks defensively were its third-best total of the season, and Ani Clark was in on a career-best 10 of them. Clark also added seven kills on the night, and Ava Pritchard added four. Setter McKenna Slavik recorded a career-high-tying 52 assists and guided Clemson to 65 kills and .272 hitting for the day. On the defensive end, Anna Renwick registered 15 digs.

The Tar Heels took command of the first set 25-17, after going on multiple 6-0 runs. Clemson responded in the second set, hitting .324 behind seven kills from Kaylee Martin and took the set 25-23. The Tigers kept the match competitive into the third with eight ties and three lead changes, before falling 25-23.

The Tigers pushed it to five with a 25-20 win in the fourth set behind six blocks, in a set in which they led throughout. In the fifth, the Tigers fell behind early, but fought back to knot it at 9-9.

UNC rattled off four of the next five to take a 13-10 lead. Clemson would again fight back after the Heels led, 14-12 as Kaylee Martin put down her 23rd kill and Dailey and Pritchard combined on a block to tie the score at 14 apiece. UNC put the match away with the final two points to take the match.
