KEY STORYLINES

SCOUTING CLEMSON

- Heading into ACC play, the Tigers are 9-3 in non-conference play with solid wins over South Carolina (3-2), USC Upstate (3-0) and Georgia State (3-1)
- Clemson's three losses came against Jacksonville State (3-2), The Citadel (3-2) and East Tennessee State (3-2)
- Most recently, the Tigers were in Birmingham, Ala. at the Samford Invitational. The Tigers defeated Samford (3-1) and Murray State (3-1)
- Hannah Camryn is the offensive leader for the Tigers, recording 189 kills so far through her 12 matches played. She is averaging 4.02 kills per set and a .290 hitting percentage. Ani Clark is also hitting at a .359 clip with 72

kills

- Overall, Clemson is hitting at a .225, compared to only a .168 put up by opponents. The Tigers also have 633 kills vs 524 from opponents
- Defensively, Devan Taylor has 214 digs with 4.37 per set. She has a .931 reception percentage so far and adds a team-high 15 aces
- Jacyn Bamis has a team-high 36 blocks so far this season and Colleen Finney adds 27

SCOUTING GEORGIA TECH

- Ranked No. 13 in this week's AVCA poll, the Yellow Jackets are 7-2 on the year with a win against No. 10 BYU (3-1), as well as wins against No. 17 Illinois (3-0) and Ole Miss (3-1)

- Most recently, Georgia Tech played in two road matches, falling to No. 24 Arkansas 3-1 but defeating Georgia 3-0
- Julia Bergmann is the points leader for the Yellow Jackets and in the ACC, recording 207 so far with 6.09 per set. She has 183 kills to go along with 13 service aces and 19 blocks
- Breland Morrisette currently ranks 9th in blocks with 1.09 per set. She has 37 total with 34 block assists and three solo blocks
- The assist leader is Isabella D'Amico with 296 total and 8.71 per set. Defensively, Bianca Bertolino ranks 10th in the ACC in digs with 123, averaging 3.62 per set
- In the ACC, Georgia Tech ranks 5th in hitting percentage with a .259, adding 456 kills in the 7 matches played

LAST TIME OUT

- The Hokies completed a sweep of the Virginia Tech Classic, defeating Norfolk State 3-0, followed by a win over Western Carolina to close out the tournament
- Sydney Petersen was named the MVP of the tournament, finishing the two matches with a .395 hitting percentage and 19 kills. She averaged 3.17 kills per set and 20 points for the Hokies over the weekend, including two blocks.
- Cera Powell was also named to the All-Tournament Team. She recorded 24 kills over the two matches, hitting .296 with 4.00 kills per set.
- The non-conference victories improved the Hokies' overall record to 7-4 on the season and a perfect 5-0 at home. Tech has not dropped a set in Blacksburg so far this season.

OFFENSIVE SUCCESS

- Over the course of two matches last week, the Hokies recorded a .290 hitting percentage with 92 kills, compared to a .071 put up by opponents
- Tech averaged 15.3 kills per set and only had 32 errors in six sets played
- In the win over Western Carolina, the Hokies put up solid offensive numbers, hitting .464 in the third set to complete the sweep over the Catamounts
- The offensive success is aided by setter Hanna Borer, leading the team in assists. She recorded 44 assists over the two matches last week, with 7.33 assists per set. She also added two service aces as well

ROOKIE PERFORMANCES

- Freshman Amaya Roberson played in all 11 sets to open the 2022 season, finishing her weekend second on the team in kills with 17
- She hit .217 with 1.55 kills per set and only seven errors on 46 attempts. Roberson hit over .300 in the matches against UNCW and Coastal, registering only one attack error in each match
- Freshman Hanna Borer has continued to impress. She currently leads the team in assists with 237 (6.08 per set)
- Her current career high is 38 assists in a match, set against Davidson in the opening weekend of play
- Ava Francis has seen time in the rotation as well, tallying 49 kills with 2.33 per set. She has played in 21 sets and assisted on nine blocks for the Hokies

TOUGH TRANSFERS

- The 2022 roster for the Hokies features six transfers: Cara Lewis, Maddie Slagle, Reagan Goeke, Sydney Petersen, Jenna Appel and Ava Francis

- Lewis, a transfer from Maryland, ranked first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set. Totaled 126 total blocks which also led the team
- Another Big Ten transfer, Slagle posted 760 digs in her career with Iowa, finishing with 1.959 digs per set, as well as 52 aces
- Goeke and Petersen will also join the Hokie block as transfers, with Goeke coming from Pepperdine and Petersen from Nevada. Francis comes to Blacksburg as an outside hitter, spending fall of 2021 at Arizona
- The Hokies add another setter in Jenna Appel from Loyola Chicago. As a sophomore, she finished with 605 assists and 26 aces. She also ranked 13th in the MVC with 5.00 assists per set

FRESH FACES

- Along with the six transfers, the Hokies also add nine freshmen to the squad for this season
- Three of those freshmen were early enrollees and played the 2021 spring season for the Hokies; Sierra Cates, Hanna Borer and Lauren Fowler
- The other six joined the Hokies this summer and look to make an immediate impact on the young squad

NEWCOMER FAST FACTS

- #0 Hanna Borer – Broke her high school record for assists in a single season with 798, also reached 1,000 career assists
- #1 Lauren Fowler – Helped her high school team to three State Championships and was named the 2020 Region Player of the Year, State Player of the Year and All-State honoree
- #6 Cara Lewis – Helped Maryland become Big Ten's best blocking team for the second straight season, ranking first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set
- #8 Josie Bloom - Named to the AVCA Phenom List in 2020 and 2021. Also named the No. 1 ranked L/DS in the state of Michigan by PrepDig
- #9 Sierra Cates – Helped her high school team reach the second round of the State Championship Tournament and was named to the County All-Star Team
- #10 Maddie Slagle – Finished her career at Iowa with 760 digs and 1.96 digs per set. As a junior, ranked second on the team with 128 digs and tallied seven or more digs 10 times
- #11 Amaya Roberson – Named to the USA Volleyball Junior National Championships All-Tournament Team and helped her club team to a third-place finish at AAU Nationals
- #16 Sarah Malinowski – Posted an attack percentage of .370 or above in five different matches, with a high of .680 in high school. Also named to the JVA Watchlist (2019-2021)
- #17 Aerin Bowman – Made the All-Tournament Team at USAV Nationals and the 2021 AAU All-tournament Team in 2021
- #18 Lucky-Rose Williams – Earned First Team All-Conference and All-State honors, while

helping her team to a Top-5 ranking in the state of Hawaii

- #19 Reagan Goeke – In a season at Pepperdine, finished the year with 19 kills, .54 kills per set and 31 points. Posted 20 blocks with only two errors
- #20 Sydney Petersen – As a junior at Nevada, placed first on the team in blocks (98), second in kills (223). As a freshman, set a new single season program record with 137 block assists
- #23 Jenna Appel – Played two seasons at Loyola Chicago and ranked 13th in the MVC as a sophomore with 5.00 assists per set. She also had eight double-doubles with 605 total assists
- #24 Ava Francis – Named to the PrepVolleyball Phenom List and ranked the No. 2 recruit in the state of Ohio. Also named an AVCA All-Region Team member, All-American Honorable Mention and an Under Armour All-American
- #26 Jordan Hallman – AVCA Second Team All-American and National All-Region Team in 2021. Ranked second in the state of Tennessee with a .428 hitting percentage and ranked 22nd nationally with 313 kills in high school

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her third season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. The Hokies defeated Virginia in 2021 as well, taking down the Cavaliers in five sets. Tech also defeated Boston College and Wake Forest in ACC play during Byers' second season at the helm. Byers looks to build off the 2021 season with many key returners and 15 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8

mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

NOTEWORTHY

ACC POWER

- Three Atlantic Coast Conference teams were ranked in the preseason American Volleyball Coaches Association Top 25 Poll and all three were in the top 10 to enter the season
- Reigning ACC Champion Louisville is No. 2 in this week's poll, followed by No. 10 Pittsburgh and No. 13 Georgia Tech. Both the Cardinals and Panthers advanced to last season's NCAA Championship semifinals and each finished with more than 30 wins.
- Georgia Tech's No. 5 ranking in week 2 was the highest ranking in program history. Miami, North Carolina and Florida State also received votes in the preseason poll.

ANABEL AT THE TOP

- Heading into week 3 of competition, Anabel Zier led the conference with 1.50 blocks per set
- She had 27 total blocks, which was tied for first, with 25 block assists and two solo blocks
- Her current season-high is eight blocks, which she recorded in the win over UNCW to open the season
- Heading into this week, Zier sits at fourth in blocks per set with 1.27. She has 47 total, which also ranks fourth in the conference

HOME SWEET CASSELL

- The Hokies are 5-0 so far at Cassell Coliseum this season
- Tech has not dropped a set so far in Cassell, recording all five sweeps this season
- The Hokies are 388-181 in Blacksburg in program history

TALKING DEFENSE

- Last season, Logan Mosley ranked seventh in the conference with 409 total digs and 10th in digs per set with 3.62
- In her 113 sets played, Mosley posted a reception percentage of .960 with only 17 errors in 425 attempts
- The Hokies also add graduate student Maddie Slagle to the libero position, a transfer from Iowa
- Slagle has been a great addition in the back row, picking up 150 digs so far this season which ranks 4th in the conference
- Her 3.39 digs per set also ranks her 6th in the ACC.

- Slagle was named the MVP of the Hokie Invitational, as well as a member of the All-Tournament Team at the DePaul Invitational

1,000 ASSISTS

- Junior Brie Postema currently sits at 950 career assists after leading the team as a sophomore a season ago
- In 2021, she posted 538 assists, playing in 26 matches. As a rookie, Postema had 310 assists
- Her current career-high sits at 47 which she achieved in the five-set win against Virginia on Oct. 29, 2021
- Postema averaged 6.18 assists per set last year and also added 24 aces and 48.5 points for the Hokies

C. POWELL

- Cera Powell was one of the most consistent Hokies in the lineup a season ago, playing in 26 matches
- She totaled 223 total points, with 203 kills and 2.56 points per set. She also averaged 2.33 kills per set
- She currently leads the team with 110 kills and 3.06 kills per set
- Powell is averaging 3.49 points per set, which is more than a point more than the next highest player on the team
- The senior has also made an impact defensively and on the service line, adding 72 digs and 11 service aces

HOKIE BLOCK PARTY

- A season ago, Virginia Tech ranked fifth nationally in total blocks midway through the season
- Tech ended the year with 259.5 blocks per season vs 205.5 posted by opponents throughout the season
