**WEEK TWO:** The second weekend of Ohio State's 52nd season of softball takes the Buckeyes to a place they've never played: Clemson, S.C. The Tigers host Ohio State, Northwestern and Notre Dame as part of the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

**A CHALLENGING SLATE:** For the second straight weekend, Ohio State is scheduled to face a team that advanced to last year's NCAA Super Regionals (Clemson) and a perennial NCAA Tournament participant (Notre Dame).

**RETURNING FIREPOWER:** Ohio State returns seven field starters from last season, its designated player and three pitchers from its 2022 roster.

**A CONSISTANT WINNER:** Ohio State has played in five of the past six NCAA Tournaments, including four in a row from 2016-19. That is the longest such streak in program history.

**OHIO STATE'S CHALLENGE HISTORY:** 2023 marks the sixth time the ACC/Big Ten Challenge has taken place. It will be the fifth time the Buckeyes have taken part, with previous trips that took Ohio State to Georgia Tech (2016), North Carolina (2017) and N.C. State (2018 and 2020).

The ACC owns a 3-2 lead on the Big Ten during the first five years of the Challenge. The ACC won the Challenge in 2017, 2018 and 2020, with the Big Ten claiming the title in 2016 and 2019.

**35**Ohio State has **averaged 35 wins per season** over the last five “full” seasons.**HISTORY VS. NOTRE DAME, CLEMSON**

- ▶ The Buckeyes and Fighting Irish have played 12 times previously, most recently in 2020.
- ▶ Ohio State’s last win over Irish came in a doubleheader sweep of the Irish in 1995. That season, the Buckeyes and Irish played four times and Ohio State won three of the games.
- ▶ This weekend will be the first time Ohio State and Clemson face each other on the softball diamond.

**WEEK ONE REWIND**

- ▶ Kami Kortokrax hit safely in six of her 12 at-bats and had three doubles.
- ▶ Melina Wilkison led the team with five RBI, including four in a 8-2 win over Boise State.
- ▶ In the final three games of the weekend – vs. Boise State, No. 18 UCF and UMass – Ohio State pitchers Allison Smith and Emily Ruck combined to allow just three runs over 20 innings with 24 strikeouts.
- ▶ Smith finished the weekend with a 2-1 record and 18 strikeouts in 17.1 innings.
- ▶ Junior Destinee Noury earned the first two starts of her career. She collected her first RBI as a Buckeye on Saturday vs. Boise State.
- ▶ Sam Hackenbracht collected five hits on the weekend, including the 100th of her career. The senior from Massillon, Ohio has played in 108 games as a Buckeye.

**HOMETOWN FLAVOR**

- ▶ Fifteen of the 24 players on Ohio State’s roster are from the Buckeye State.

**129**Ohio State had **129 extra base hits** last season, including 50 home runs.

- ▶ Even with the hometown flavor, a total of six different states are represented on the 2023 roster.
- ▶ All five of the Buckeyes’ pitchers call Ohio home.
- ▶ Additionally, five players are from central Ohio - within 30 miles on the Columbus campus.

**2022 SEASON REWIND**

- ▶ Ohio State’s 36 wins this spring matched its most in the last nine full seasons. It also won 36 games in 2018.
- ▶ The Buckeyes’ .679 winning percentage was the second-best in the last 12 seasons, topped only by the 2018 squad that won at a .692 clip.
- ▶ Ohio State finished with 13 or more conference wins for the sixth straight season.
- ▶ The Buckeyes were especially good away from home in 2022 – they won 30 road/neutral site games and were 8-3 against Big Ten opponents on the road.
- ▶ Ohio State earned four wins over ranked teams: No. 23 South Florida (twice), No. 22 Michigan and No. 8 Kentucky.
- ▶ The Buckeyes were 2-0 against teams from the Southeastern Conference. In addition to the win over Kentucky, Ohio State also defeated South Carolina.

**MORE 2022 THIS AND THAT**

- ▶ Freshman Melina Wilkison finished her rookie campaign with a .342 batting average, the best by a freshman since Taylor White hit .341 in 2015.
- ▶ Wilkison, a member of the Big Ten All-Freshman Team and a third-team All-Region selection, had the best batting average among Big Ten freshmen who had 100 or more at-bats.
- ▶ Another member of the freshman class – shortstop Kami Kortokrax – was one of four players to start every game this season. The other three were Sam Hackenbracht, Niki Carver and Meggie Otte.
- ▶ The Buckeyes started freshmen at both of the middle infield spots in 39 of 53 games (73.5 percent of all games).
- ▶ Ohio State played each of the teams that finished first, second and fourth in the

- ▶ In just two full seasons, senior Sam Hackenbracht already sits in the top 10 for career home runs.
- ▶ The slugger from Massillon, Ohio led the team with 16 last spring and enters the 2023 with 30 in her career, which is tied for eighth all-time.
- ▶ The next person on the list is Alex Bayne, who hit 37 from 2015-17.

## SMITH &amp; STRIKEOUTS

- ▶ As a freshman in 2021 against a schedule of Big Ten-only competition, Allison Smith struck out 134 batters, the fourth-most by a rookie in a single season.
- ▶ She enters the 2022 season already in the top 20 in career strikeouts with a chance to move into the top 10 with a strong showing this spring.
- ▶ With two full seasons remaining, Smith needs 68 Ks to reach the No. 10 spot and 292 for a spot in the top five.

- ▶ Four student-athletes signed National Letters of Intent to further their academic and athletic careers as members of the Ohio State softball program, head coach Kelly Kovach Schoenly announced in November.
- ▶ The newest Buckeye are: Jazzy Burns, a catcher/utility player from Menifee, Calif., Taylor Cruse, an outfielder from Basehor, Kan., Lottie Landmesser, a shortstop from Canton, Ga., and Cadyn Ruffer, an infielder from La Mesa, Calif.
- ▶ Ohio State's class is ranked No. 17 nationally by Extra Innings Softball and is the second highest-ranked class in the Big Ten.

**WHITNEY JONES ADDED TO STAFF**

- ▶ Whitney Jones, who has been to the Women's College World Series as both a player and coach, joined Ohio State as an assistant coach in July.
- ▶ Jones spent the 2022 season as the hitting coach at UCF where the Knights enjoyed one of their most successful seasons ever.
- ▶ Under Jones' tutelage, UCF hit .295 as a team and ranked in the top 50 nationally in batting average, runs scored per game, doubles and on-base percentage.
- ▶ Jones had a four year-stint at Washington as a volunteer assistant coach.
- ▶ A four-year letterwinner as a player at Washington, Jones was a two-time Pac-12 All-Academic performer and was an All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention in 2014.

**A TEN YEAR SNAPSHOT**

- ▶ Over the last 10 years, Ohio State can measure up against any Big Ten program in total number of wins, winning percentage, conference wins or conference winning percentage.
- ▶ In that span (2013-22), the Buckeyes are one of just five conference schools with 300 or more wins. The Buckeyes' total of 303 victories is topped only by Michigan (433), Minnesota (388), Northwestern (317) and Nebraska (307).
- ▶ Ohio State has a .619 winning percentage since 2013, which is the fourth-best among Big Ten programs.
- ▶ With 131 conference wins in the last 10 seasons, the Buckeyes rank fourth. In that same span, they've had eight consecutive

seasons with a .500 or better record in Big Ten play.

- ▶ Ohio State's .588 conference winning percentage since 2013 is topped only by Michigan (.853), Minnesota (.771), Nebraska (.598) and Northwestern (.653).
- ▶ Ohio State's string of five NCAA Regional berths in the last six tournaments (2020 excluded) is the third-best in the conference. Only Michigan (six of the last six tournaments) and Minnesota (six of six) have better stretches.

### AT OHIO STATE

In her 10 seasons in Columbus, Schoenly's teams have won 303 games, including 22 over teams ranked in the Top 25. Twenty eight of her players have earned All-Big Ten or NFCA All-Midwest Region honors. And just as important, the Buckeyes are excelling in the classroom. In 2021, 13 players garnered Academic All-Big Ten recognition, which accounted for 87 percent of those who were eligible.

Schoenly's current winning percentage of .617 (303-188-1) at Ohio State is the best in program history, as is her Big Ten winning percentage of .588 (131-93-1).

In 2022, Ohio State finished 36-17 overall and earned an at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament for the fifth time in the last six tournaments. It marked Schoenly's eighth 30-win season in eight full seasons leading the Buckeyes (2020 excluded for COVID and 2021 for a conference-only schedule). The Buckeyes had their best-ever final RPI of Schoenly's tenure (No. 25) and produced four All-Region players.

### AT MIAMI (OHIO)

At Miami, Schoenly led the team to four consecutive 30-win seasons, including a record-breaking 41-win campaign in 2012. That year, the RedHawks won three consecutive games in one day at the MAC Tournament to claim the league tournament title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament. She guided the RedHawks to an upset over fifth-ranked Tennessee in the opening round of the Knoxville Regional. Under Schoenly's leadership, the RedHawks collected 83 wins in MAC play.

### PRIOR TO OHIO STATE

Prior to her time in Oxford, Schoenly guided one of the nation's best pitching staffs in 2006, as the Nittany Lions finished the season ranked 12th nationally in ERA (1.36) and limited their opponents to 74 earned runs in 380.2 innings. During her eight-year tenure, Schoenly helped Penn State to seven 30-win seasons, including a program-record 39 wins in 2006. Schoenly also produced two All-America pitchers, including 2005 National Fastpitch Coaches Association third team honoree Ashley Esparza and 2006 Second-Team All-Great Lakes Region pitcher Missy Beseres, the first Nittany Lion in program history to be drafted to play professional softball.

During her stint in Ann Arbor, the Wolverines won two Big Ten regular-season titles, three Big Ten Tournament titles, three NCAA Regional Championships and made three trips to the NCAA Women's College World Series. In addition to being honored as part of the NFCA Great Lakes Coaching Staff of the Year in 1998, Schoenly coached one All-America pitcher, three conference pitchers of the year and six all-conference selections.

During her collegiate pitching career at Michigan (1991-95), Schoenly earned numerous conference and national awards, including 1995 NFCA First-Team All-America honors. A two-time Big Ten Pitcher of the Year and three-time all-conference selection, Schoenly was a member of three Big Ten Conference Championship teams and played on the 1995 squad, which finished seventh at the NCAA Women's College World Series.

A two-time GTE Academic All-American, Schoenly received her bachelor's degree in elementary education from Michigan in December of 1995. After receiving the NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship, Schoenly went on to earn her master's degree in elementary mathematics education from Michigan in May of 1998.


