Weather Forecast for Death Valley Today

Recorded at 90-yard line 10 / noon

Temperature: 67 degrees

Relative Humidity: 42 per cent

Sky: Clear

Wind: Northeast at 6 miles an hour

Skies will be sunny this afternoon. Temperatures will be near 70 degrees and winds will be northeasterly 5 to 10 miles an hour. Relative humidity will be low, 25-30.

Eleven Years Ago

The date was October 12, 1963. The place was Clemson, S. C. The sun rose 6:35 a.m. Skies were clear. The temperature was 51 degrees.

The temperature began its daily climb, reaching 82 by noon, with only a few wispy cirrus clouds in the sky.

At 1 p.m., the temperature rose to 84 degrees. The sky was still sunny; in the far-distant southwest, a thunderhead poked its anvil top over the horizon.

It was still sunny at 2 p.m., but a noticeable increase in cloudiness. The temperature was 85 degrees.

THEN, THE HEAVENS OPENED UP!!

Rain, with hail, began at 2:50 p.m., just before halftime. A 30-degree drop brought temperatures down to 55 degrees -- in just 50 minutes. Hail pelted and covered Death Valley. Football fans scurried for cover as many of them had come to the game in skirt sleeves.

It was all over at 3:40 p.m., but Clemson coach Frank Howard and Georgia coach Johnny Griffith decided to delay the start of the second half 15 minutes as there was an inch or more of hail covering the playing field.

Almost an inch of rain fell in that 50-minute period -- the only rain that occurred that month.

The final score: Clemson 7, Georgia 7, which is the last tie game played in Death Valley.

That was October 12, 1963.

COACH DOOLEY'S POST-GAME COMMENTS:

"Clemson deserved to win. We just couldn't stop them. Time after time their quarterback O'Cain would come up with a big play, and that combined with Cunningham in critical situations was the difference.

"We battled back, and I'm proud of that. But they always came back and took the lead. Their offense ripped us apart. The whole thing centered around the basic fact they couldn't stop them.

"I never thought about not punting the first time we had the ball. There's no question it was the thing to do, and we kicked it dead down to the six yard line. But we were never able to stop them on third down, and that's to their credit.

"We had several good opportunities in the first half. But we also had a couple of bad plays in the first half. One was on that fine keep by the quarterback, and then we had a terrible mistake in our kicking game. We had another bad play at the start of the second half that could have put us out of the game in a hurry."

COACH PARKER'S POST-GAME COMMENTS:

"The thing about this game is that nobody thought we were going to win, but us. The character of the players came through. I thought the coaches prepared our team well, but it was the players who ~~deserve~~ deserve credit for the win.

"We've seen some great teams so far. Texas A & M taught us a lot of things. Our guys have been to ~~the~~ the well before.

"I was disappointed at our turnovers early in the game, but when you're fired up and wild-eyed like we were, that will happen.

"That last ~~abuse~~ drive was really something. Starting from the eight yard line is not exactly the best place to start, but the key to our win was not letting them have the ball back.

"O'Cain and Fellers spell each other, and they love each other. They take care of each other. The proudest guy right now for Mike O'Cain is Mark Fellers

"There were a lot of big third down plays and we had a lot of them swing our way."
