DUKE COACH MIKE MOCHER-- "I don't have much to say. Obviously the most clear cut thing in the football game was the fact that the Duke squad, particularly in the second half, although making mistakes that enabled our opponent to win, ~~they~~ fought their hearts out.

Duke injury report-- FB Mike Bongardner, knee injury; Mark Johnson, shoulder injury; Tailback Larry Martinez, knee injury; Status at this point is undetermined.

CLEMSON COACH JERRY RED PARKER:

Duke is just as good as anybody we've played except Texas A&M. They have a great off-tackle football team. With the exception of their early turnovers, they probably outplayed us.

We played with two freshman linebackers most of the game (because of injuries to Jimmy Williamson and Tim Stough). But Tom Boozer had a great game, Jim Ness always plays good, and we had two good gkz goal line stands.

I thought ~~our~~ our defense picked us up today, and that's what football is all about. Some days it's the offense scoring all the points, and again, it might be the defense who has to put the stopper on. But our defense came up with some big plays.

The fact that we didn't move the ball was because of the Duke defense. But I thought we hit them pretty good, and believe you me, they hit us too. It was just a great ball game. One thing I want to say about Duke: They did a fine job doing what they wanted to do.

Of course you might say we beat Georgia Tech, we g beat Georgia and we survived Duke.
