COACHES QUOTES

COACH RED PARKER, CLEMSON: I thought Virginia played very well. That Ambrose is a great football player. They are a well coached team, and they do a lot of things good. We played a good football team. They are a fundamentally sound group with a good plan. I thought we played well in the second half. Anytime you can hold a team without a touchdown, I guess you have to say your defense played good, but there were times when they hurt us on the 2nd sweep. We tightened up some in the second half and shut off some of the things they had been successful on in the 1st first half.

I'm glad the situation between the North Carolina and the South Carolina game has passed and next week we'll have our bowl game. It'll be here a week from today and it's three hours.

I'm afraid that Mike O'Cain has a shoulder separation and won't be able to play next week, and if this is true, Rick Weddington will back up 2 Fallers and he will do a good job.

I don't think we ran the veer enough in the 1st first half. But the veer has been good to us ~~like~~ this year and we went back to it in the second half. We wanted to run in the second half and stay away from as much passing as possible.

We didn't throw to Bessie (Cunningham) today because it wasn't there. Maybe that was a weakness we had the first part of the year, trying to do something we couldn't do.

COACH SONNY RANDLE, VIRGINIA: I can't stand it and I won't. We had some kids play their hearts out. We just didn't have enough. We had nine kids on defense play better than I've seen in my whole life. They couldn't do ~~at~~ anything (Clemson). But then our offense couldn't even take a snap.

I'll tell you what about those statistics. That's for losers.

On that touchdown before the half, we knew they were going to throw it. And yet one of our halfbacks comes up like he's going to stop a dive play. Have you ever seen a defensive halfback stop a dive play at the line. There's no excuse for it.

You can't ask the defensive unit to play the whole afternoon.

Those two touchdown plays (first half) swung the momentum.
