Most satisfying win, we did not play very good defense in the first half, we played better in the second half, but ~~xxxx~~ at the end, the defense saved the game for us. It was exciting, good game, I like good games. ~~We~~ You can't make changes at halftime, You run the same plays all spring and all season. The only coaches that say that they make changes at ~~the~~ halftime are the coaches that lie. I dont lie, honesty sometimes =gets me in trouble, but I dont lie. We always seem to play better in the second half. We tried to recruit Jordan, he was one of the best players in the state, he will tell you he was in my office listening to Jim Croce with me. I like him, he is a nice young man. We expected him to make more errors but he was excellent. Our problem defensively is that when they throw long we cover short, when they throw short we cover long. But pass defense is not only the secondary, it is linebackers, and lineman. We need to put more pressure on the passer. I dont want to be predictable.

CLEMSON COACH RED PARKER QUOTES:

We're all hurt (physically). Our players thought we'd win. There's no doubt in their minds.

The kicks put us in a hole. Except for a real bad lapse in the third quarter, we were a pretty good team. We had a zero punt and they went in from there, and then we had another one which went for about 8 yards.

There was a span also in the third quarter where we didn't establish the run where the pass would be effective. When we put motion in in the third period, we tried to do too many things instead of running right at them. The pass comes because of the run.

Jordan did a great job. He got tired, but somebody will have to beat him out to prove he's not the quarterback. Willie and Ratchford got hurt on the same play. I don't think either one is too bad though.

Parker said that freshman defensive end who went out in the first series probably would have to undergo surgery (knee). It hasn't been completely diagnosed, but it doesn't look good.

Our young kids played hard and the old ones came back with some improvement. I'm hoping we'll be all right.
