COACHES' COMMENTS

COACH RED PARKER We just got the mortal devil beat out of us. I thought we were ready to play and being ready to play didn't have anything to do with it. South Carolina did a great job on offense, and we had some poor judgement that made a little bit of difference in field position. It was a case of not being able to stop them on anything they did offensively.

I was really disappointed that we gave them that easy touchdown right before the half because we thought we could come back and score some points.

I read that last touchdown as an insult and I'll never forget it. The biggest disappointment in my life today was the margin. But Jim runs his team and I run mine. If that's what he wanted to do, that's his prerogative. Everybody has to live with what they do and what they think.

Defensively, we didn't have any aggressiveness, and when we got in a hurry a couple of times it gave them good field position, and didn't do the things we set out to do. Jimmy Williamson got hurt in the N. C. State game and couldn't play anymore and yesterday afternoon, Mark Heniford sprained his ankle while ~~testing~~ testing the turf out here and he wasn't able to play. But I'm not saying that as an alibi. They have an offense where you don't want to get in any scoring contest with.

The game was not decided on anything except our inability to stop their offense. We couldn't stop any phase of their offense.

COACH JIM CARLEN:

"The biggest difference in today's game was Jeff Grantz's ability to come up with the ~~key~~ b play. I have said it before, but he's the best I have ever seen. He does things that are unreal."

"This is really a great win for our players and coaching staff, and I am proud of everyone of them. They have worked hard this year and my biggest regret about the season is we can't play those four losses over."

"Coach Parker has done a tremendous job at Clemson in the last few weeks getting his team turned around. I did not think scoring that last touchdown at the end was an insult. We outscored them 21 - 14 in the last half ~~and they were~~ and they were coming at us when the game ended. Clemson and Coach Parker have gone through a frustrating year, but I would never think of doing anything to ~~hurt~~ insult them. I consider Coach Park a close personal friend."

"As far as the Bowl picture is concerned, I believe our play today justifies us going to a bowl. The Tangerine Bowl has decided to wait until Monday to announce the decision, but we have already decided to accept a bid if we should get one. The Tangerine Bowl is a good bowl and when you consider that only 22 major colleges are going to a bowl, then that would be an achievement."
