COACH RED PARKER OF CLEMSON

I don't have too much profound to say. You all could see the penalties in the first half. I'm so bitter...everything is going to be hard for me to take.

I thought Tennessee played good in the second quarter and I thought we played good for three quarters. We got a lot out of our kids. We had two cornerbacks go down in the first quarter (Marler and ~~Wingex~~ Wingo) and we had to go with two freshmen the rest of the way.

We're a real young football team (11 sophs started) and we're getting better everyday. I hurt us a lot with a 15-yard penalty, but I just could not take it anymore. I apologized to our team for it.

Tennessee did a good job taking our play passes away from us, but they didn't take away our sprint passes.

The two-point play (after our second touchdown) was the play of the game. We had everybody fooled except that one linebacker and he played it well, but that's what he's out there for.

Our greatest concern was the pass catching of Morgan and Seivers. We have been doing a pretty good job stopping the run all year. I'm proud of these guys. They laid it on the line today.

COACH BILL BATTLE OF TENNESSEE

"It was a win and any win at this point is a good one. Our defense played well and kept them out of the end zone. Our offense had some problems moving the ball, and that is going to happen. Sometimes the offense looks good and the defense doesn't. Sometimes it is the other way around. Our defense got after them good and got us into some good positions for winning the game. Rowsey makes a tackle on the kickoff, then we hit Seivers twice in a scoring drive. Jenkins makes one of the biggest plays of the game in stopping their two-point conversion with an interception. James stops the other two-point conversion, and then Williams gives us that interception. Fortunately, we got the breaks today. We had been getting those 30 yards in penalties and giving the other teams help in scoring drives. Clemson's defense did a good job stopping our offense. They handled us up front as well as anybody this season. They are a good defensive team, and nobody has run much against them."

TENNESSEE DRESSING ROOM COMMENT

Quarterback Randy Wallace: "I'm just happy we won. We looked good the first half offensively, but we certainly didn't the second. Our defense did great today when we needed them."

Tailback Stanley Morgan: "Regarding his 12-yard run to the Clemson 1 in the 2nd qtr.: "There was a key block by our right end. I went outside of him. Our tackle knocked their tackle to the right and I found a big hole up the middle. We had a real good game the first half. In the second, we couldn't do some of the things we wanted to do. We just couldn't move the ball. Their defense was better in the second half for some reason. They seemed to know what we were going to do."

Tailback Kelsey Finch Regarding 21-yd. TD run in 2nd qtr.: "(Bobby (Emmons), Stan (Morgan) and Larry (Seivers) all got good blocks on this play. Someone got my leg from the ground but he didn't get a good enough shot at me. Those remaining yards were like a track meet. I knew I was gone."

It was a play-action pass. He faked to the fullback, then backed up a couple of steps and threw to the tight end. I'm supposed to come up and hit him. This time I didn't do it, but instead followed him back there and just ran in front of him to get the ball."

Split end Larry Seivers: (Regarding ~~xxxxxx~~ single game reception record) "I don't care about the record--it was 21-19 and that's what counts. Randy (Wallace) was sharp as a tack today.
