Blocked KICKS:

Coach Fells: "I shouldn't have used David Simsas a punter today. He was up tight with a hamstring. I put him in under unusual pressure. I don't think he was confident about his leg but he felt like he could do it and I have a lot of faith in him. But I believe his injury had as much to do with the fumble as anything -- his anxiety -- I'll take the credit for that. That fumble and the long run was the difference in the first half.

"North Carolina has a fine football team. They had to fight and come up with the big play to tie.

"I was pleased with the way the team came back, ~~xxx~~ came from behind and got ahead. It was our mistakes that kept us from winning the game today. We fumbled on that drive and it's something we'll have to live with.

"I was surprised ~~xxx~~ at the ability of both team to move the football. We held them move the football -- the offsides penalties, particularly on their first drive had a lot to do with the way the first half went. When the nose guard moves when the ball moves, it's kinda hard for him to be offsides twice in a row.

"I'm not sure we had our players properly prepared. We were a little up tight. I felt like we'd played the game so many times since Wednesday that we were already tired (at kickoff). At halftime we told them they would have to go back out in a work attitude and I think they came back the second half and did that.

"I can't remember Obed Aziri missing an extra point at anytime since he started kicking in the spring. That's the difference between a win and a tie. But I was proud that our football team got in a situation where North Carolina ~~xxx~~ had to come from behind and go for the tie. And I would imagine they're pretty proud to get the tie. I don't know.

I was surprised that we were able to move the ball on them. We did that by blocking well and threw well, and having the best ~~@~~quarterback in the conference helped a bunch too. That Fuller is a big play man."

Coach Dooley:

"I'm certainly disappointed we didn't win the football game as I'm sure Clemson is disappointed they didn't win it. They have a very strong team. They are as good a team as Kentucky or Texas Tech on defense and Fuller is an excellent quarterback.

I thought Clyde Christensen did a real good job there at the end directing our attack when we got the tying field goal. We were thinking about the conference championship when we kicked the field goal. That has been our goal all season and now we can still get it by winning our last two games.

(In answer to a question) "We were going for the win until fourth down. That's why we were throwing on ~~xxx~~ third down. We ran the first two plays on that last series because Clemson was coming so fast, we felt we might be able to break something up the middle.

"It looks like Matt Kupec may have ~~xxx~~ a broken clavicle. And we've got a lot of other people banged up, too. It was really a physical game.

"There were a lot of ifs both ways. If we hadn't had a holding penalty on a long run by Amos Lawrence, we might have won the game. That took ~~xxx~~ us out of good field position. And, of course, if Clemson hadn't missed the extra point, we would have had to go for the win at the end."
