COACHES QUOTES

COACH CHARLEY PELL OF CLEMSON: We were beaten today by a well-prepared and a well-coached team. They had a great game plan, they executed well and they kept the ball away from us. They did exactly what we expected them to do and I congratulate Coach Dolley and his staff.

We came into the game thinking they would try and control the ball and keep it away from our offense, and they did an outstanding job of that. Not only that, but we helped them in having the seven turnovers. I don't think our team has a thing to be ashamed of, but we just gave a good, solid football team and opportunity to whip us.

I don't think we as a coaching staff had our players prepared as well as we should. If we had had, we wouldn't have given them so many opportunities. Again, Georgia is a solid football team, they didn't beat themselves, they kept the ball and it's a little difficult to score when you can't keep possession.

They took away the deep ~~xxx~~ throws from us. We probably tried to do too much and in the second half, we tried to simplify our offense somewhat.

That touchdown play was just a great effort on Pyburn's part. We caused him to lob the ball (with the rush by Randy Scott), and this might have been why it was successful.

I've said it since July --Georgie is under rated. We should have been more successful, but Georgia didn't allow us.

COACH VINCE DOOLEY OF GEORGIA: We forced alot of turnovers today, we call them takeovers if we're on defense. We forced a lot of turnovers. Just aggressive hitting where getting the ball comes as a bonus. I don't think they (the turnovers) were necessarily miscues on Clemson's part but rather the ~~xxx~~ results of hard hitting.

I thought we ~~xxxx~~ would have to beat Clemson like we beat Baylor last week. I figured they would score about fourteen points and that would have to ~~score 16 or 17~~ to win.

Does it feel good to win? I'm happy to win any game where our team is the underdog and we beat a team that is supposed to be better. Yes sir, we were fighting like an underdog all ~~xx~~ day long.

I wonder if beating The Citadel as easy as they did hurt them. I can't say it helped. The first team did not stay on the field much more than a quarter and that isn't really even a good scrimmage. It couldn't have helped them prepare for us.

Were we confused when we went for two? (after Ga.'s 3rd quarter TD) No not really, it was just a normal gametime panic situation. We had several of those in the game. We have to work on our sideline situation, I like to have it a little more controlled. But at least it shows a fanaticism and I like to have that on the sideline as long as it is an itelligent fanaticism.

I don't think I mentioned last year's game to them at all. Not one time. Why should I have to mention the obvious.
