We had three scoring opportunities in the first half and didn't take advantage of any of them. The interception killed our first big drive and that hurt. Against an excellent team like Clemson, you have to take advantage of every opportunity you get and we just didn't do that.

We did have several bright spots. Fallen's kick kickoff run was a fine one and Smigelsky's punting was very good. Otherwise, I didn't see much that pleased me.

Our quarterback David Lamie jammed his thumb and he became swollen. He couldn't handle the ball properly so we couldn't use him. I don't believe his injury is serious and we hope he will be ready next week.

We have to regroup now and get ready for West Virginia next week. I have confidence that we will come back and play well.

I congratulate the Clemson team. They played an exceptional game.

Coach Charley Pell of Clemson: Today's victory was important for reasons other than just being in the "W" column. This ball club went through a lot last week -- a lot of position changes, a lot of extra meetings -- a lot of extra practice. There had to be some doubt in some of their minds that we could be able to sustain ourselves offensively. I think they answered that in the first half extremely well in two sustained drives. I was real proud to see that.

The other thing I told the players -- the first half was an example of what we really want at Clemson. When one unit has a break down, the other unit steps in and does what it has to do. It happened just like the story book in the first half when our offense broke down and the defense stepped in and stopped them. That's what good football teams do and I'm proud of them.

I thought Jerry Butler was nothing short of great today, breaking records, and all of you have written about that young man, but I don't believe words can describe him. He's tremendous.

Steve Fuller again showed why he is the best quarterback in the country. I wish anyone who doubted that could have him play today and remember, he was doing this behind some mighty "rookie" type people up front.

Fuller's run was a misdirection play where we found the linebackers going after the fullback on the early downs, which is normal. But Steve just did a tremendous job, but the thing that made it go was the downfield blocking. Billy Hudson, Chris Dolce and our tight end, Cliff Bray, and Jerry Butler made a tremendous block on the corner. That's what made it the run it was.

It was a tremendous victory. I think we had a lot of people wondering just what this team would do in the first time it really faced a serious injury problem. We didn't face any a year ago. In fact, I can't remember of of this proportion since we've been in football of what we faced this past week.
