COACH'S QUOTES

Jerry Claiborne:

It was a tremendous game I thought for a championship game - the only thing I regret is we didn't come out the winner.

It was big plays all day - - big plays on the passing game, big play right before the half with the blocked punt, great run by Steve in the third quarter..

I'm very proud of our football team - I thought they fought hard. It's been a great season, they've had a great year.

I think a lot of people are probably saying why did we kick the field goal, we'll, actually we thought to make 20 yards in one play our chances were slim and if we scored we'd have to go for two. So we thought we'd go for the field goal and try to get the ball back on an onside kick. Also, we had three time outs and if we could stop them we could get the ball back with time to score.

They (Clemson) came up with the big plays when they needed it and you've got to give them credit - they are champions.

Charley Pell:

The story of this game is more than what happened in 60 minutes. We're talking about something that's been happening a long time -- over a period to two years.

It was a tough time, we've had some hard practices, we tried to learn how to win and learn to how to come from behind. Last week. they showed a little sign of it by coming back and beating North Carolina and this week, they capped it all because they came back against a very fine Maryland team

There is no way we can give enough credit to Steve Fuller, as far as leadership. That doesn't mean that Randy, Bubba and all of them didn't do a great job because you know they did, but Steve Fuller was the catalyst -- he was the engineer -- he was the field general that made it happen when we had to have it. And from what I know and what I've learned, that's what the Heisman trophy is all about..

It was a great team victory. Everybody from A to Z did their job, when we called on them at halftime to go out and play their part one play at a time they did. They didn't get shook if we had a bad play, and if we had a good play, they didn't get shook because they were getting ready for the next play.

If there was a key in the second half, let's call it determination and championship football team by a team that wanted to win the conference championship.
