#### THE CITADEL HEAD COACH TOM MOORE

In all my years associated with The Citadel, I'm not sure that I've been prouder of a football team than I am today. This was a great performance for us. From an execution, performance and emotional standpoint, we had a great, great effort.

Clemson is a great football team. They are quicker than any team I've ever seen. I'm sure we won't see that kind of quickness again.

I dreaded this game four years ago when I was hired to coach at The Citadel. But our players made this a great experience for everyone connected with The Citadel. No one is happy with a loss, but I'm very happy with our football team. They gave everything they had and that's all you can ask.

Hopefully, this game will put us in a position to be successful. We play VMI next week at home in a crucial, crucial game for us. We have to come out and play inspired like we did today.

We spent an awful lot of time preparing the defense this week. They were ready to play today.

**\*\*NOTE\*\*** Greg Davis' 81-yard punt is a career best for the Atlanta, Ga. native. His previous best was 66 yards against South Carolina in 1984. 83 yards in the school record.

TODAY's crowd of 75,000 is the largest to ever view a Citadel football team. the previous best was in 1985 against South Carolina. That game drew 73,500.

#### CLEMSON HEAD COACH DANNY FORD

Couple of things that could have gone a little better--like our offensive execution and our special teams play--but one thing that did look pretty good was that shutout by the defense.

Citadel had a great desire to win the football game and that is a tribute to Coach Moore and his staff in getting his team ready to play. They came up here and got after our offensive team pretty well.

We made enough mistakes to put ourselves in a great bind. Most of the day we didn't look too sharp offensively.

Out of the three things we hoped to improve on, we didn't improve except on one of them and that was defense. I don't think the offense was up to snuff and the kicking game was not up to snuff. I was mainly disappointed at the mental attitude that some of the players went into the game with. They waited until Saturday to get ready for the game and that's something you can't do.

A lot of that that we didn't do can be attributed to the opposition. But we are happy to win and we'll be anxious to see how we bounce back and I hope we can have a good practice this week because we get back into the conference next week (at Virginia) and we'll have to be ready to play up there.

## POST GAME NOTES

- \*\*\*This marked the 23 shut-out in the series with the Citadel during the 34 meetings between the two. Clemson has recorded 20 and the Citadel has posted three. This is the first shutout for Clemson in 25 games.
- \*\*\*Terrence Flagler ran for 177YD. which is his personal best now. He had totaled 139 yards in the game versus Western Carolina in 1983. Also this is the first game since the Virginia game in 1984 when Flagler scored two TDs. Also his career best in touchdowns.
- \*\*\*Ricardo Hooper recorded his first career reception in the first quarter with a reception of 25 yards.
- \*\*\*Placekicker David Treadwell kicked three PATs, giving 12 of 12 for the season. The sophomore has kicked 37 PATs (consecutive) in his last 16 games.
- \*\*\*Kip Allen set a new Citadel record for attempts with 57. The record before was set by himself against Wofford in 1985 with 54. He also broke the most individual passing attempts by opponents. The record was 56 set by Jay Venuto of Wake Forest in 1980, against Clemson.
- \*\*\*Greg Davis of the Citadel, punted 12 times for an average of 51.3. This betters the Citadel best game average of 50.3 set by Charlie Ingram in 1970. His punt of 81 yards lists as the longest ever in Death Valley and is listed as the second longest for the Citadel. Paul Maguire in 1959 hit a 83 yarder against West Virginia.
- \*\*\*Delton Hall moved into third place on the Career Passes Broken Up list as he recorded two. Currently he has 24 while teammate Terence Mack blocked one and he remains fourth with 23.
- \*\*\*Michael Perry recorded one sack for the game which places him fifth beside James Robinson with 11. Brother William is the career leader with 27.
- \*\*\*Terrence Flagler's 177 yard game is the first 100 or more yard game for a Clemson runner this year.
- \*\*\*This was the largest crowd that the Citadel has ever played before. The record before was recorded in 1985 when they played against South Carolina. They had 73,500 for the game.
