Game Notes

Clemson vs. South Carolina

November 22, 1986

- ****The announced attendance of 82,500 is the largest crowd to ever see a Clemson football team play. The largest previous crowd was 82,122 in Athens, GA, in 1984 where Georgia won 26-23. The largest previous Memorial Stadium crowd was 82,093 against South Carolina in 1984. This crowd was the second largest to see Carolina--104,213 at Michigan was the largest attendance for the Gamecocks and that was in 1980.
- **** The 21-21 tie marked only the third time since 1896 (Clemson's first year of football) that Clemson has had back to back ties. The last time occurred in 1919 when Clemson went 6-2-2 and again in 1906 when the Tigers were 4-0-3.
- **** This was the fourth tie in the Clemson-South Carolina series. The previous ties occurred in 1915 (0-0), 1945 (0-0) and 1950 (14-14). This is the first tie in the series that has occurred in Memorial Stadium.
- **** USC's Brad Edwards' interception return for a touchdown was the first such return against Clemson since 1984 when Mark Franklin of N.C. State returned an interception 81 yards for a score in a game played in Raleigh.
- ****The last time Carolina had two ties in a season occurred in 1964 when the Gamecocks went 3-5-2.
- ****Todd Schonhar's pass to Jim Riggs for the 2-point conversion was the first 2-point play scored by Clemson this year.
- ****USC placekicker Scott Hagler finished his career with 195 points., which puts him second on USC's all-time list. George Rogers holds the record with 202 points (1977-80).
- ****USC's Anthony Smith gained 26 yards in four attempts today, giving him 1,004 for his career. He is the 24th USC back to rush for 1,000 yards in a career.
- ****Sterling Sharpe caught nine passes for 167 yards, giving him 74 for 1,106 on the season. His 10 touchdown receptions are another school record. His 12 TDs overall are two less than the record 14 TDs scored by George Rogers in 1980.
- ****Todd Ellis' 275 yards passing give him 3,020 for the season, the 1st freshman in NCAA history to pass for more than 3,000 yards in a season. His TD pass gave him 20 for the year, extending his NCAA freshman record. With minus 38 yards rushing, his total offense for the season is 2,976, also extending his NCAA freshman mark. Ellis finished the year with 205 completions in 340 attempts for a percentage of .603. All are school records as are his 22 interceptions. That is the 10th time in 11 games this year he has passed for more than 200 yards.
- ****The Carolina sack on Clemson QB Rodney Williams in the 2nd Quarter was the first given up by the offensive line in eight games
- ****Clemson converted on two fourth down plays in the game today and both led to touchdowns ---Carolina got on Edwards' interception, and Clemson got one five plays after the conversion when Rodney Williams hit Terrance Roulhac for 35-yard TD pass. Both conversions were in the first half.
- ****Clemson placekicker David Treadwell has not missed an extra point in his career. His one PAT today gives him 56 for his career, which is the second longest streak in Clemson history.

SOUTH CAROLINA HEAD COACH JOE MORRISON -- "It's been a funny football season all year long for us. Our kids have just kept bouncing back week after week. They say you can learn a lot of lessons about life on the football field, and I think our players have learned a great deal this season that they can carry with them for a long time...No one is happy with a tie. That's two of them this year for both clubs. I'm proud of our defense. I thought they did a pretty good job of handling Clemson's option game...Sterling Sharpe had a great game today and he's just had a great season. That was a great catch he made there at the end to put us in a position to win the game...I'm sure a lot of folks thought it would end up more of a high scoring game based upon the halftime score. I was surprised that only three points were scored in the second half...Clemson did a good job of putting pressure on Todd, especially in the second half."

Wingback Sterling Sharpe -- (On his 72-yard TD reception): "We caught them in a man coverage and Todd did an excellent job of getting me the ball in a position where I could do something with it. I planted my foot, spun around and took off...Clemson did a good job of just giving us the short routes in the second half. We tried to throw underneath a lot and a couple of times we made some bad reads."

Quarterback Todd Ellis -- "I thought a big key to the game was the play of their linebackers in the second half. They did a good job of covering our patterns and didn't give us a whole lot...I led Kevin (White) just a little too much on that last throw. We were trying to go long over the middle and I overthrew him just a bit."

Linebacker Derrick Little -- "We didn't win and we certainly aren't happy with the tie. This week we had good practices and I thought we would come out and play well. Not to take anything away from Clemson, because they have an excellent team, but I thought we played hard enough to win the game. We came together on defense and I thought we did a decent job of covering their option."

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON We made way too many mistakes, but you can't always blame that on yourself. South Carolina had a little bit to do with that. They got after us a little bit better than we did in some things.

South Carolina was very well prepared for this game. They took away more of our running game than we thought they could. I thought we missed some scoring opportunities in the second half. I wish we would have won, but we had a great effort. I don't remember seeing any players who were not giving it a great effort.

I thought our defense played well in the second half. Only three points were scored and those were ours. We wish we had played a little bit better. But these kind of games (against your big rival) always have some things that are unexpected and it seems that this one today was no exception..
