NOTES ON THE CLEMSON - GEORGIA GAME

The Clemson safety was the first since the Wake Forest game in 1985. Today, Gene Beasley and James Lott tackled James Jackson for the loss in the end zone. In the 1985 game, it was a bad snap from center on a punt by the Wake Forest team.

Today's win for Clemson marks the first time since 1905-06 that the Tigers have defeated Georgia two years in a row.

Clemson won the time of possession battle in the second half. The Tigers had the ball for ~~10:49~~ 10:48 in the ~~third~~ third quarter and 11:51 in the fourth for a total of 22:39 out of the possible 30 minutes. Georgia had the ball but 3:09 in the fourth quarter.

David Treadwell's four field goals ties a Clemson record, held by Obed Ariri. Treadwell's 21 yarder was the difference today. One year ago, the Jacksonville, Florida native booted a 46 yarder as the clock ran out to give the Tigers a 31-28 victory.

Georgia's James Jackson is now fourth in the school's total offense list with 3,690 yards. Jackson moved into fourth place with his 36 yard pass to Kirk Warner, which set up Georgia's fourth quarter touchdown.

Georgia's rushing touchdown by Rodney Hampton in the fourth ~~quar~~ quarter was the first touchdown given ~~x~~ up by the Clemson defense this year.

Clemson is now 1-0 in the "new" Orange pants.

Clemson's non-losing streak has now reached seven games. The last loss was to ~~xx~~ ~~xx~~ N. C. State in Raleigh.

QUOTES FROM GEORGIA HEAD COACH VINCE DOOLEY

"First of all, I'm very disappointed in losing the ball game. I thought we played well enough to win and to lose right there at the end is really a tough way to lose. I'm really disappointed for the team.

"Clemson played a very good game and I want to give them credit for really playing us tough. It was another usual Georgia-Clemson game, going right down to the end. I'm also disappointed in myself for the poor call made when we were backed up in our own end zone. That's a play that you could make 10 yards on or one that you could lose yardage on. I'm disappointed in myself for making that call because I really don't think Clemson would have scored a touchdown on us.

"I thought our defense really played well except for the long touchdown run. We seem to be more inspired and that encourages me. We've gotten better defensively each week and that play continued this week.

"On offense, I also thought we played well against a real power defense. I really want to give the offense a lot of credit, especially since it was able to score a touchdown against that defense in the fourth quarter.

"Clemson has a solid football team on both sides of the ball. They really keep after you, all game long."

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON

I'm verry happy for our football team, and I think we were very fortunate to win. But we found a way to win, whether it was one point, half point...I don't don't even know what the final score was.

Georgia played very hard, just as they always do.

We did something right...we did a lot wrong, especially using time outs. I wasted everyone we had. And our coaches overcame me. That's a good one to stop playing Georgia on (Georgia is off the Clemson schedule in 1988 and 1989, but come back to Clemson in 1990 and to Athens in 1991). I don't want many more like this. It gets pretty tough on me. But I want to congratulate our people. We didn't win it like we wanted to, but that's what we set out to do. There were all kinds of big plays.

We had a guy for a loss on the sweep and he scored. But Hampton made a great run on us. It's the first touchdown we've given up on the ground. And a real fine punt return gave them an easy one there. And then it turned into a field goal game.

But you all saw a good football game. I know I saw a good football game... not error free, but they never are error free.

We're happy to win and go on to Georgia Tech. Georgia Tech now comes bigger than Georgia ever was. It's our first conference game and they'll give us all we want.
