GAME NOTES

- ***Donnell Woolford's 78 yd. punt return for a touchdown was the first time a punt was fielded and run back for a touchdown since Don Kelly's 85 yd. touchdown punt return vs. Maryland, Oct. 31, 1970 at College Park, MD (Clemson 24, Maryland 11)
- ***Woolford's touchdown punt return was also the first time that a Clemson player had returned a punt in 17 years and 185 games. It was also the 5th longest punt return in school history.
- ***Clemson had received 450 punts without a score prior to Woolford's touchdown.
- ***Joe Henderson's 95 yard kickoff return in the 4th period was the first time a Clemson player had run a kickoff back for a touchdown in 25 years. The last time a kickoff was returned for a touchdown was by Hal Davis vs. Georgia, Oct. 13, 1962 at Clemson. Davis' return was for 98 yards.
- ***Clemson had not returned a kickoff for a touchdown for 25 years, representing 843 kickoffs and 272 games.
- ***Micheal Dean Perry's one sack puts him into second place on the all-time ACC Career Sack List.
- ***Rodney Williams' 52 yard touchdown pass was the longest pass completion of his career.
- ***Clemson broke a school record for most punt return yardage with 227 yards.
- ***Each of the last four times Clemson has beaten Georgia, the Tigers have also beaten Georgia Tech.
- ***Clemson had not beaten Georgia Tech in consecutive seasons since 1906-1907.
- ***Series record, Georgia Tech leads 36-14-2. Games at Clemson, Clemson leads 3-1.
- ***Clemson had never returned both a kickoff for a touchdown and a punt for a touchdown in the same game.

COACH BOBBY ROSS QUOTES:

"Clemson is every bit as good as people say they. I don't think there is any doubt about that. Easily one of the top 10 teams in the country, there's no question.

"I still believe that had we had better special teams play, we might have been in the football game. Defensively, we played well enough to stay in the football game. We were outmanned in certain spots, and we had some trouble there, but I thought defensively we hung in the game real well.

"Offensively, we had a very hard time containing their rush. They came into the game very early with some pressure and got us into some one-on-one things, and when that happened, we lost our numerical advantage and that gave us some difficulty. We just got beat in the one-on-one, the man for man phase of the game.

"I thought that overall, our team did not quit; we played hard. We kept our poise, but physically we're getting beaten some of the time. That was a key thing.

"Their defensive line is very, very quick. It's an awfully good one. I hope I don't see a better one. We had a very hard time getting anything goin. Then when we did, we would either drop the ball, or make some mistakes. That didn't help us any.

"The special teams was the key thing. If we had played well on special teams, we would have been in the ball game. But our special teams just totally broke down, I thought McDevitt actually kicked the ball much better today. But our coverages just totally broke down in all phases. We messed up a couple of times on the sideline. It just was not a good game for our special teams. Very poor. That hadn't been a problem. If we had tackled we'd have been okay. We had tackles on each one of them (TD returns) that were there for us, we just didn't make them."

NOTES: Clemson's 227 yards in punt returns is the most Tech has ever given up in a game. The old mark was 154 yards by South Carolina in 1971...Woolford's punt return for a TD was the first against Tech since Georgia's Fred Lane returned one 72 yards at Sanford Stadium on Dec. 1, 1984 (Tech won 35-18)...The kickoff return for a TD was the first against Tech since LSU's Jerry Stovall returned one 98 yards on Oct. 24, 1962 at Grant Field...Tech's Greg Lester, a freshman from Lakeside H.S. in Atlanta, has a TD reception in all three Tech games... The TD pass from Richard Hills was his first career attempt.

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON We are very grateful to have won the football game.

We had some good defense today, and our kicking game was excellent. It was a great run by Woolford (on punt return). He had a good block, but he also showed great individual talent.

Defensively, we had to be very good. I don't know what they ended up with, but our people was on top of them. Course, Georgia Tech had one starter out and two of their offensive linemen who are playing different positions this year. But our defense put on good pressure all day long. I guess good football teams make things happen, as do individuals.

We're glad for the open week. We got a list a mile long on people who are banged up.

But we had several good things happen, but we are still not taking advantage of good field position.

I thought Rodney (Williams did pretty good. He had that long pass, and he executed well. He did have one bad pitch. But he is part of our total effort and he is part of the kicking game, or the passing game or the running game like everybody else is.

I knew Bobby would have his team ready and he did. We just made some great individual plays and showed some great individual talent. Joe Henderson bobbled the ball, and Tech seemed to let up, and he made a terrific run behind some good blocking and some extra effort on his own. I'm just happy he wasn't tackled back there where he bobble the ball. If he had been, we might have been in trouble with the score just 19-6.

We're happy to get our conference season started off with a win and I hope we can have everybody well by the Virginia game.
