Both teams were penalized for a total of 31 times. The Tigers were called for 15 mistakes, while Duke was called for 16.

Cornerback Donnell Woolford had his first interception of the season, but it could not have come at a better time. Woolford snagged an Anthony Dilweg pass with only 2:57 remaining in the game. The Blue Devils never got possession of the ball again.

When Duke held Clemson scoreless in the first quarter, it marked the first time that Clemson did not score at least two points in a quarter. Before this game, the Tigers had scored at least once in every quarter this season

Clemson quarterbacks have not been sacked all season

Michael Dean Perry's 3 tackles today put him over the 200 career mark. He now has a total of 202.

Terry Allen broke Kenny Flowers' freshman rushing mark of 557 yards. Allen had 508 yards before today's game and his 52 yards today gives him a total of 560 after only six games

The Tigers are now riding a 11 game unbeaten streak. The last team to defeat Clemson was next week's opponent, N.C. State

POST GAME QUOTES

DUKE HEAD COACH STEVE SPURRIER

We had a chance today. We caught Clemson at a good time in winning fairly easy and they took us lightly I'm sure. Our guys played with great effort at just about every position. But we didn't play very smart. If we could have been a little bit smarter and executed a big play here and there then we could have had a good chance to win the game.

We had the breaks going early for us. We just didn't play well enough to win and that's the way it eventually turned out.

It's always hard to take (losing). We're proud of our players and their effort today. Our offense really played well. We moved the ball well and got some first downs. We messed up our basic pass protections.

(On Dilweg) He played gutty. HE hung in there and made some mistakes but not all that many. He competed pretty well.

CLEMSON HEAD FOOTBALL COACH FORD: Naturally, we're happy to have won, but we had to struggled real, real bad. We didn't improve over last week week as much as we would have liked to.

But give Duke University all the credit in the world. They just hung in there and gave us fits all afternoon. It was a very tough football game for us to win. We obviously got whipped many, many times. We didn't execute very thoroughly, we didn't have them prepared to play, we didn't do a very good job coaching, we had some bad things happen. It was just a very poor performance on our part, if you're looking for excuses, but I had rather give Duke a whole lot of credit than to say that we didn't do what we were supposed to do. Give Duke credit for playing a great, great football game against us. But I didn't see a lot of things impressive by the people in the orange jerseys.

I wish we were a little bit more physical football team, a little bit better organized football team, a little bit more mature as coaches and players and not think that we're going to show up out there and play good and people will roll over dead because those people are going to play just that much harder against Clemson.

I don't think we were mentally prepared to play. We went out there like it was a Saturday morning scrimmage.

(When asked about the officiating): I don't think that they were no worse than we were. I'm sure they did the very best they could do and that is all that you can ask for.
