GAME NOTES

Rodney Williams became the winningest quarterback in Clemson history today. Clemson is 23-8-2 when Williams is the starting quarterback compared to 22--6-1 when Homer Jordan started.

The 40 points scored by the Tigers this afternoon are the most a Clemson team has ever scored in the series against Virginia Tech, a series which dates back to 1900. Clemson now leads the series 16-7-1. Clemson also claimed the biggest margin of victory since the Tigers beat the Hokies 35-0 in 1945. This game was uncharacteristic of the series in that the average victory in the five games between 1980 and 1987 was 6.2 points.

Rodney Williams moved 72 yards closer to third place on the career passing list. He needs 69 yards against Furman next week to pass Homer Jordan. Williams has 3575 passing yards in his career.

COACHES' QUOTES

FRANK BEAMER, Virginia Tech: "First of all, let me say that Clemson is a helluva football team. They went out there and just blocked us off the line of scrimmage. And the Clemson defense did a terrufic job too.

"But we are not a 40-point defensive team. I guarantee you that we will play much better than that. I was disapointed in our tackling and the fact that we let Clemson block us in the fashion that they did.

"It was a frustrating day. We scored and cut the Clemson lead to 14-7. Then we have a breakdown and let Clemson run the kickoff back into good field position. That gave Clemson new momentum and changed the complexion of the ball game.

"We played like what we are--an inexperienced football team. We made so many little mistakes and gave the ball so often ~~xxx~~ to Clemson in good field position.

"I thought that Will Furrer did a ~~js~~ good job under the circumstances. He played with poise and gave us real hope for the future. We never really considered putting Cam Young into the game. I said earlier that it took us a long time to decide on our quarterback and it will take a long time for us to change our minds. I was pleased with Will and wanted him to get experience in every type situation. That is why we kept him in the game. It was our receiving corps that was disappointing. Those fellows kept dropping the football all day.

"The effort of the team was good and even in a 40-7 loss, I saw some good signs. We've just got to go back to work and get ready for the game next week against East Carolina."

Coach Beamer was asked if he would take the three points off the board if he had that decision to make again.

"We would do the same thing again. Heck, we had a first down at the 10-yard line and wanted seven points. There was never any question that we would take the three points off the board and accept the first down."

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON: "We're very pleased in winning the football game. We had a distinct advantage of having more depth than they did and we were able to play a lot of young people late in the game.

"At times, I didn't think we looked like we had enough intensity on defense. I don't know yet how to get our people to come out and play good the first five minutes of the second half.

"I think the poorest phase of our game today was the punting. We had one get blocked and another was touched. I thought Gardocki did pretty good. He got two field goals and had a good punt, that nearly got blocked, but for a freshman, believe he'll take this day.

"We can get better. One thing good about today's game is that we didn't have a penalty or a turnover on offense. For the most part, we controlled the line of scrimmage a greater part of the game. And we put some good pressure on their quarterback. But for a freshman, coming in here is a difficult job and we know we'll have to face him next year at his field, and he'll be improved."

Coach Ford passed out five game balls in the dressing room after the game. They were given to Richard McCullough, Jesse Hatcher, Rusty Seyle, Jeff Bak, and Rodney Williams. One was also given to assistant head coach and head defensive coach Tom Harper.
