GAME NOTES

Today was the first time Florida State has worn all white uniforms since the 1958 season. The white pants were a gift from actor Burt Reynolds. Reynolds lettered for Florida State in football in 1954.

Clemson is now 14-2 in orange pants. The Tigers had won 4 straight in orange pants ~~coming~~ coming into today. The last loss in orange pants came in 1984 by South Carolina, 22-21.

Chip Davis' touchdown pass to Gary Cooper in the first half was the first TD pass by a wide receiver for Clemson since Ray Williams threw one 59 yards to Terrence Rhoulac against North Carolina in 1985.

Florida State's one yard rushing in the first half was the lowest team rushing total in one half given up by Clemson so far this year.

Deion Sanders' punt return for a touchdown in the second half was the first against Clemson since Nathaniel Lewis scored on a 67-yard punt return for Georgia in 1987.

Sanders now has three career punt return touchdowns. It was Sanders' second touchdown of the year, the other coming on an interception return.

Gary Cooper caught two passes for 99 yards today, all in the first half, after catching just one all season coming into today and being the intended receiver just three times.

Florida State is now 32-20-1 in TV games, 25-17-1 under Bobby Bowden, and 5-4 on CBS.

Clemson is now 50-27-1 on TV, 6-7 on national network games, and 5-5-2 on CBS.

LeRoy Butler's 78-yard run on a ~~kick~~ fake punt to set up Florida State's game-winning field goal was the 21-st longest play ever against Clemson and tied for the eighth-longest from scrimmage.

Clemson is now 1-3 versus Florida State, 0-2 at home.

Richie Andrews' game-winning field goal was the first field goal of his career.

The fake punt 78-yard run was the longest non-scoring run from scrimmage in Florida State history.

There were no turnovers in the game today. Clemson has not committed a turnover with Rodney Williams in the game this year. It was the first time this year that Florida State has not committed a turnover.

Clemson sacked Chip Ferguson two times today. Over the last 30 games, Clemson has sacked opposing QB's 77 times while giving up only seven sacks.

Today was the first time Clemson has come out ahead in time of possession this year, and it is the first time the Tigers have lost this year.

LeRoy Butler's 78-yard run on a fake punt made him the game's leading rusher over Clemson's Terry Allen, who ran for 77 yards and now has 1187 yards rushing in his 14-game career.

Quotes from Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden:

"We're pleased to win this game. At the half, it was decision time for our team, we had just lost to Miami with high expectations, Clemson had just made a 99 yard drive. If you can't stop them for 99 yards, you're gonna have a hard time stopping them along the way. I've never been more pleased with a bunch of kids.

"We put it in this week, cause I thought we might need it sometime. They chased all the motion to the right and LeRoy Butler outran em to the endzone. We actually copied it from somebody else. I saw Jerry Claiborne run it a couple times in the '60s. We were liable to use it anytime in the second half, we were just waiting for the right opportunity. All our offensive coaches, we decided that we were gonna use it now. If we miss it, they're gonna hit a field goal and win. I just wanted somebody to win the game."

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON : I have no fault to find with the way we played the football game. It was an excellent game to watch.

I'm real proud of our team. Sometime things happen which you don't understand, and I'm sure our people are wondering why certain things went certain ways today. There were big plays on both sides and they probably had more than we did.

The fake punt was a nice call -- a good gamble and very successful. We knew they had it, but I'm not sure if our people were warned about it this particular time. They were told about it earlier.

We thought about going for two points after our third touchdown, but decided that we had two timeouts to their none and there was over two minutes left in the game.

We had command in the first half and they got the momentum in the third quarter. They were playing well and we weren't and several things could account for that. But overall, we have nothing to be ashamed of. We'll start thinking about Georgia Tech Monday. This will be the first game in our ACC schedule.
