GAME NOTES

Clemson vs. North Carolina

November 5, 1988--Clemson Memorial Stadium

Rodney Williams is now the Clemson leader in completions with 306. He broke Tommy Kendrick's (1969-71) record of 303 on the first pass play of the second half. For the day, Williams was 6-10-91 yards and one interception.

Williams needed 192 yards coming into today's game for the career passing yardage record. His 91 today leaves him 101 yards short of Steve Fuller's record of 4359. Williams now has 4,258 yards. Williams also needed 104 yards for 5,000 yards in total offense. He had a total of 95 yards today, giving him a total of 4,991, which is 1,105 yards short of Fuller's total of 6,096.

Tailback Terry Allen had 167 yards today is his second highest single-game total. He had 183 vs. Virginia last year. Allen, however, did break Ken Callicutt (1973-75, 77) record of 809 yards by a sophomore. Allen now has 956 yards in nine games this year. Allen already owns the freshman rushing record. He broke Callicutt's mark on the third carry of the game.

Keith Jennings moved past Charlie Waters (1967-69) into <sup>eighth</sup> ~~ninth~~ place on the all-time Clemson reception list. Jennings had three receptions today, giving him a total of 70 for his career. Ray Williams (1983-86) is seventh with 86 catches.

The 52-yard field goal by Chris Gardocki was the longest of his short career (nine games).

North Carolina's Kennard Martin had 116 yards on 16 carries, marking the first time a Clemson opponent had rushed for over 100 yards since Harold Green of South Carolina did it last November.

Clemson now has a record of 23-13-1 against North Carolina all-time.

Mr. Bradley's record for consecutive games watched as the Clemson SID now stands at 365 consecutive games.

The 164 yard passing (total) yards Clemson had today was the most the Tigers have gained through the air route this season.

~~Flanker~~ Wide Receiver Chip Davis is now 2-2 for 109 yards passing on the flanker option. He had a passing ~~of~~ efficiency of .722.

Clemson racked up 500 yards in total offense to North Carolina's 191.

Rodney Williams is now 30-49 for 405 yards passing against North Carolina for his career.

## COACHES QUOTES

North Carolina Coach Mack Brown:

"You have to give our young guys credit for forcing the Clemson mistake early. But they came right back and hit us with some big plays early. We won the turnover battle, but they dominated time of possession. We could never get the ball enough to make things happen. We never got the necessary rhythm offensively.

"We're a much better team than we were three weeks ago. But we've got to run on all pistons to win a game. We had a lot of people banged up coming in-and we got more banged up today. They just wore us out today on both sides of the football.

"Give credit to Clemson.- Defensively we played as well early in the game as we have in a long time. One of the things that killed us was their long drive at the end of the first half. That gave them a lot of momentum going into the second half.

"We knew coming into the game that we had to win the time of possession and Clemson had the ball 40 minutes to our 20. We did not play well in the specialty positions on offense except for Kennard Martin. They just wore us down defensively because we couldn't stay on the field on offense.

"I'm disappointed in the score but not in the effort today. We were not able to move the ball offensively and that was disappointing.

"I do want to credit Kennard Martin. He has played tremendously for us all year and was outstanding today. We had him alternating with Torin Dorn up until last week and when Torin got hurt we've asked Kennard to go all the way two weeks in a row.-He's really deserving of all-conference consideration."

## COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON

I don't think our football team took advantage of all of all of our opportunities early in the game. But I thought the turning point was right before the half when we had a drive and scored for the second straight week.

We caught North Carolina when they had some key people hurt, but I'm sure that Coach Brown is on the right track and is going to have a good program before it's over with.

I thought we did a good job following the game plan of the coaches that they had laid out for the team. The defense gave us some good field positions several times and we were able to take advantage of it.

We looked like we weren't weren't ready to play in the first half. But the offense played very well in the second half. And again we were able to use some young players and let them get a little bit of experience. Also, this was the next to last time that our seniors will play in Death Valley and they wanted to make a good showing. But we're pleased and we're happy to win.
