COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON : We're glad to have played the first game. We did not have any idea how we'd do because Furman has a class program as anyone knows. We're real pleased with out kicking game. That is always a key in any football game.

We forced several mistakes--or at least we think we did--and was able to take advantage of a couple of them. But we're not satisfied with our offense, although we did some things well. We're real proud of our kicking game.

Furman controlled the line of scrimmage a good part of the game and that is one reason our offense looked sluggish. I believe we'll get better with our running game. I'm hoping that Terry Allen will make a difference when he returns.

We're most pleased with (the few) number of penalties we had. We threw well at times--we dropped some passes--and we caught some passes. I'm pleased with both quarterbacks. We had planned to open up and throw deep. They shut our sweep down and you could tell that they had worked a lot on stopping our option. But I like to think we'll get better with our running game.

COACH JIMMY SATTERFIELD OF FURMAN: Anytime you play a game like that, there's a tendency to dwell on the many things you didn't do well, and in our case there were a lot of things we didn't do well. I did think our defense played well. While we didn't stop them, they had to work for what they got, even in the second half.

That was probably one of the worst offensive games we've ever had, but that was due primarily to Clemson's fine defense. Their outside linebackers are probably the best we've ever faced, and they are quick, I mean quick. They also played hard the whole game, and that's a tribute to their players and coaches.

The fumbles hurt us for sure. We thought we had some good plays called, but Bobby (Daugherty) dropped the ball and Greg (Key) fumbled after making the catch there on our first series.

Clemson has great players, I mean truly outstanding players. We just don't see that type of quickness and talent. Their defensive backs locked up well on our receivers, and their pass rush was effective, so we couldn't get anything going through the air. We probably wouldn't have scored if we had stayed out there for eight quarters. Our offensive execution was very poor. I take the blame for that. I don't think I did a good job preparing this team for this game."

Furman Notes: The shutout marked the first time in 76 games Furman has been blanked in a game. The last team to do it was South Carolina State, which defeated Furman 17-0 in the NCAA I-AA playoffs in the final game of the 1982 season.

The loss snapped an eight game winning streak for Furman.
