WAKE FOREST COACH BILL DOOLEY:

"There weren't many things to be happy about for us out there today. Offensively, defensively, in the kicking game--we just didn't execute very well.

"Clemson has a very good football team. They have excellent personnel and they played extremely well today, especially in the first half. They really did just about anything they wanted. They hurt us quite a bit with the pass, as well as with some big plays. That (giving up big plays) has been a problem for us on defense all year, however. / That's probably been the most disappointing thing about the way we have played on defense this season. We get a team in a third-and-long situation, or backed up in its own territory, and then we let them off the hook.

"I will commend our team for not quitting. We came out and did a better job in the second half.

"We also get a few people hurt out there this afternoon. Marvin Mitchell and Ron Lambert, two defensive starters, both have knee injuries (Mitchell the left knee, Lambert the right), but we won't know the full extent of those until tomorrow or Monday. It doesn't look too good, though.

NOTE ON RICKY PROEHL: With his two receptions today, Proehl has now caught at least one pass in 30 consecutive games as a Demon Deacon. He now has 164 receptions for his career, tying him with former Duke receiver WEs Chesson (Chesson had been the all-time ACC leader until being passed by Blue Devil Clarkston Hines last week).

CLEMSON COACH DANNY FORD

I thought our football team played very well. We're real proud of this. I thought they played with emotion and excitement. We got to play a lot of people who haven't had a chance to play very much this season.

I'm real proud of our 19 seniors -- I believe 13 of them are on scholarship. I think they got us ready to play today. They have been a good group of young men. Maybe they haven't expressed as much emotion as some of the other senior classes we have had, but they have led by example.

But we're pleased with the win. I think they showed some maturity. I thought we caught the ball extremely well. Our running game wasn't as sharp as I would have liked, but they had an eight-man line up there most of the time which made it a little more difficult to run and that is the reason we went to the pass more. But the most pleasing thing to me about the game was getting to play as many people as we did. They work just as hard as the others out there during the week, but don't get in on Saturday.

Morocco and Cameron were sharp, but I think Michael (Carr) might have been pressing a little too much. This is the most he has played in a game this year and I'm sure he wanted to look good while he was out there.

1 CLEMSON VS. WAKE FOREST POST GAME NOTES

It took the Tigers 27 seconds to run down the hill this afternoon.

Gary Cooper and Terry Allen were the last Clemson players to run down the hill.

In today's game with Wake Forest, Clemson scored on its first seven possessions, marking the first time this season that the Tigers have scored on their first seven possessions this season.

When Joe Henderson took a Chris Morocco pass 41-yards, it marked his first touchdown reception of his career. That was his only reception of the game.

In today's game the halftime score was 34-3, marking the first time since 1984 that Clemson has scored 34 or more points in the first half. In the 1984 game with Duke, the halftime score was 41-0. The final score of that game was 54-21.

At today's halftime ceremonies three former Clemson athletes and one administrator were inducted into the Clemson Hall of Fame. The Clemson Hall of Fame was formed in 1973. Since that time, 99 athletes, coaches and administrators have earned the distinction of being named in the Clemson Athletic Hall of Fame.

Today Terry Allen played just one series for the Tigers, but finished the game with 16 yards on four carries and one touchdown. He now has rushed for 496 yards this season and needs just 254 yards to become Clemson's all-time leading rusher.

When Michael Carr connected with Stacy Lewis for a 12 yard pass play in the third quarter, it was the first reception and pass completion for both players. It was also Carr's first pass attempt of his career.

True freshman Tyrone Gibson caught his first pass of the season in the third quarter. It was a seven yard reception for a first down.

James Lott now ranks third in Clemson career punt return yardage with 633 yards. Today, he returned three punts for 89 yards, more than his output for the first eight games of the season (87 yards). Lott returned a punt for 50 yards in the fourth quarter, marking his longest punt return of the season. Shad Bryant is the Clemson career leader in punt return yardage with 779 yards, followed by Donnell Woolford with 754 yards.

Going into today's game Reggie Lawrence had carried the ball just five times for 22 yards. Today he rushed for 34 yards on 10 carries and scored on a three-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter.

Clemson scored 44 points this afternoon, the most points since the Maryland game last season. Clemson defeated Maryland 49-25.

Phil Barnhill had a 35-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter, marking the longest run of the season against Clemson. Going into today's game the long was 21 yards against the Tigers.

True freshman Robert O'Neal picked off his sixth interception of the year this afternoon. Going into today's game O'Neal led the ACC in interceptions and was 18th nationally in that category. He already holds the Clemson freshman interception record. He broke Terry Kinard's freshman record for interceptions in a season when he picked one off against Virginia. Kinard was a red-shirt freshman and O'Neal is a first-year freshman.

At the 7:10 mark in the fourth quarter, Fernandez West caught his first pass of the season and just the second pass of his career. West is a walk-on senior from Cornelia, GA, playing in his final home of game of his career.

The Tigers attempted their first punt of the game with 8:34 remaining in the fourth quarter.

John Kubu made his first extra point of his career in the fourth quarter. He also joined Chris Gardocki on kickoff duties.

Chris Gardocki has now made 19 of 24 field goals this season and made good on 27 of 27 extra points attempts.

When Wesley McFadden scored on a 39-yard touchdown trap play, it marked his longest run of the season. Going into the game, his longest run of the season was a 24 yard run against Virginia Tech. His longest run of his career was an 89-yard scoring run against Virginia Tech in 1987. McFadden led the Tigers in rushing today with 52 yards on seven carries.

When Levon Kirkland recovered a Wake Forest fumble in the second quarter, it was his third fumble recovery of the season. Kirkland recovered one fumble last season and he is now tied for eighth on the Clemson all-time fumble recovery list. Former Tiger Jeff Davis (1978-81) is top on the list as he recovered eight fumbles throughout his career. Davis was inducted into the Clemson Hall of Fame this weekend.

Today's referee was Don Safrit. He is the same referee who worked the Clemson-Wake Forest football game in 1982 at the Mirage Bowl in Tokyo, Japan.

Today Clemson had 465 yards in total offense. It was the second-highest total for the Tigers this season. The top total offense game was 474 versus Virginia.

Today's game marked the sixth time this season that Clemson has rushed for over 200 yards. The Tigers gained 218 yards on 54 carries this afternoon with 11 players carrying the ball.

The Tigers passed for 247 yards this afternoon, just the third time this season that Clemson has passed for over 200 yards.

Today's game marked the second time this season that the Tigers have passed and rushed for over 200 yards. It was also the eighth time in Danny Ford's career that the Tigers have done so. Clemson's record is 8-0 in Ford's career when passing and rushing for over 200 yards.

Danny Ford holds a 10-9 record when Clemson has more yards passing than rushing in a game. The Tigers had 218 yards rushing and 247 passing today.

Today the Tigers scored 44 points. This total, combined with last week's 30 points, is the top scoring performance for two games since last season, when the Tigers' had a two-game total of 78 points (37 vs. UNC and 49 vs. Maryland).

Clemson had 80 total offensive plays today, tying the top mark of this season, which was set against Furman in the season opener.

Clemson averaged 5.81 yards per play today, marking the fifth time this season the Tigers have averaged over 5.0 yards per play.

Robert O'Neal picked off a pass in the third quarter this afternoon, marking the seventh game this season in which Clemson has intercepted an opponent pass.
