

They (Clemson) were a quick team but it seemed that the offense just wasn't out on the field long. That's our fault, though, because we couldn't move the ball when we had the chance. We wanted to get the ball to the corners and away from the pressure. I felt like we did fairly well on the second drive, but the coaches made the decision to put in Pat. I just waited for my chance to come back into the game and contribute."

Runningback Harold Green -- "They (Clemson) were in control of the game from the start to the finish. They did a good job ~~outside~~ outside on the corners. We just didn't execute well on the offensive game plan. They had really quick outside men. It's (his career) is over. It's been really great. I'm sorry that we had to have this type of game for our seniors and fans. I had no intentions of breaking any records coming into the game -- I just wanted to win the ball game. I'm not "Superman" out there -- it's not just a one man show and we needed an all-around game out there to win. The loss really hasn't hit me yet. Maybe I'll read it in the newspapers and realize the loss tomorrow."

Defensive End Corey Miller -- "We just didn't tackle well at all. Florida State had some really good athletes and Clemson had some good players. The bottom line is that they just outplayed us. We were in position to make the plays all night and we just missed the tackles. This hurts really bad. We wanted to win the game but that's just the way it is and we're just going to have to deal with it."

Free Safety Stephane Williams -- "I guess they (Clemson) just outplayed us when they had the ball -- they just dominated the line. We wanted to stop the run and try to get them to pass. If we would have done that, I feel that we would have come out on top. Everyone was confident coming into the game; in fact, if there's only one game to get up for all season, it's Clemson. SOUTH CAROLINA GAME NOTES 11/18/80

The 45-0 margin was the second worse defeat for the Gamecocks in the series with Clemson and you have to go back to the turn of the century to find a wider margin. Clemson beat South Carolina 51-0 in 1900. The Tigers won 44-0 in 1935.

Tonight's win was the 51st for Clemson. South Carolina has won 32 and there have been four ties in the series.

Farold Green finished regular season play with 3,005 career rushing yards. He is only the second South Carolina back to rush more than 3,000 yards. George Rogers, 1977-80, rushed for 5,204. However, Green fell 11 yards short of rushing for 1,000 yards for the second time in his career. Green netted 60 yards tonight, giving him 900 for the season. Green rushed for 1,022 yards as a sophomore.

Tonight's attendance totaled 74,509. That was the seventh largest crowd in Williams-Brice Stadium. The record is 75,043 for the Clemson game in 1967.
