Comments from Long Beach State Coach George Allen

"This is a new experience for Coach George Allen to get beat 59-0. What I told the players is that we'll take this out on somebody else.

"Clemson is powerful football team. Coach Hatfield told me after the game we were totally outmanned, and we knew that coming in.

"I don't think that these types of games help the winner or the loser. I don't want to be involved in any more games where you're so outmanned. It's not fair to the kids.

"I thought maybe we could pull off an upset. We're trying to build togetherness on the squad. We had a great feeling of confidence coming in to the game.

"I think the first touchdown--the interception--really took a lot out of us. We were moving the ball. I'm disappointed, but I didn't see anybody loafing. Everybody was trying.

"Clemson's defense is not going to give up many points. They're linebackers are so quick. Now I know why Major Harris had such a poor game against them. They don't stay blocked.

COACH KEN HATFIELD, CLEMSON : We're thankful our kids played as well as they did in the opening game. Long Beach State came in here with a lot of enthusiasm and I didn't think they let down at any time and I don't think they quit.

We felt like our line would wear them down. Once we found out what they were going to give us, we settled down to just a few plays. We needed to work on our option more and we ended up running it about 10 times in the second half and they gave us a better indication of our option and our throwing game.

We ran the play action pass we started the game with, and we ran the option, the sweep and the fullback plays that Clemson has been noted for that are really good football plays. We felt that on a hot day we could wear them down and we did what we felt like we had to do to win the football game today. We certainly didn't do everything we practiced; but once we saw what they were going to give us, we just settled in on a few plays.

Arlington Nunn came up with that great interception, on a third and one of all things and that turned the game around.

We've had a lot of fullbacks injured throughout pre-season. Tony Kennedy didn't even play today, Howard Hall's been injured some, Greg Burke was able to play; Caputo had been injured, and that's why we had to move Derrick Witherspoon there to be sure we had somebody healthy for the first game and I think it helped because I don't think any one could have played the whole game, all of them had to contribute for a little bit, but I think our fullback played a lot better than what we had done in pre-season.

I was disappointed in our turnovers at midfield. I think our defense played well..they got 'em a shutout. We got to play a lot of players and they got some game experience. We made a few adjustments at halftime that ~~paid~~ paid off. We're just happy to get that first one out of the way.

1 CLEMSON VS. LONG BEACH STATE POSTGAME NOTES

Arlington Nunn picked up his second career interception this afternoon as he returned the ball 55 yards for Clemson's first score of the 1990 season. Nunn's first career interception came against Duke on October 15, 1988. There were no return yards on that interception.

When Clemson's tailback Rodney Blunt scored on a three yard run at the 1:59 mark in the first quarter, it gave him his first career touchdown.

Clemson place-kicker Chris Gardocki still has not missed a PAT in his career. Today he connected on six. Throughout his career he has made 48 consecutive PATs.

Doug Thomas's 29-yard pass reception from DeChane Cameron in the second quarter was his longest reception of his career. His previous long had been 17 yards. That took place against Wake Forest on October 21, 1988.

The Clemson defense caused five turnovers while the Clemson offense turned the ball over twice this afternoon. Last season Clemson was second in the NCAA in Turnover Margin with a +1.82 mark.

Freshman quarterback Richard Moncrief completed his first career pass this afternoon as he connected with Doug Thomas on a 19-yard pass in the second quarter. On that drive Rodney Blunt scored his second touchdown of the game.

Freshman tailback Rodney Blunt scored two touchdowns this afternoon against Long Beach State. The last time a Clemson back scored two touchdowns in a single-game took place against South Carolina last year. Both Terry Allen and Tony Kennedy scored two touchdowns against the Gamecocks.

With Clemson shutting out Long Beach State this afternoon, the Tigers have not been scored on in the last seven consecutive quarters. Clemson has been scored upon in just two of the last 16 quarters.

The halftime score of today's game was 28-0. It was the most points Clemson has scored in the first half since Clemson scored 34 against Wake Forest on October 28, 1989. The final score of that contest was 44-10.

At the start of the second half, Doug Thomas returned a kickoff 98 yards for a touchdown, marking the first time a Clemson player returned a kickoff for a touchdown since Joe Henderson took one back 95 yards against Georgia Tech on Sept. 26, 1987.

Thomas's kickoff return tied for the third longest kickoff return in Clemson history. He tied Hal Davis who returned his kickoff 98-yards on October 12, 1962. Clemson has returned just two kickoffs for touchdowns since 1962.

Tony Mauney picked off his first career interception this afternoon when he got one in the third quarter.

True freshman Ronald Williams had 16 yards on his first career rush this afternoon. He ended up the day with 38 yards on six carries. He also leaped over from the one-yard line for a score. Teammate Derrick Witherspoon, also a true freshman, rushed for 46 yards on eight carries.

With today's final score 59-0, it was the largest margin of victory in an opening day game since Clemson defeated Prebyterian 66-0 in the home opener on September 21, 1957.

Two of Clemson's true freshman played this afternoon. They were Witherspoon and Williams.

Long Beach State crossed the 50-yard-line just three times this afternoon and their deepest penetration took place when Long Beach State got the ball down to the Clemson 42-yard-line.

Third-string quarterback Jimmy McLees scored his first career touchdown at the 4:57 mark in the fourth quarter to give the Tigers a 59-0 lead.

When Clemson held Long Beach State to (-16) yards rushing this afternoon, it marked the third lowest rushing total by a Clemson opponent in Tiger history. Long Beach State was held to just 57 yards in total offense, tied for the sixth lowest total in Clemson history.

In today's game, Long Beach State successfully converted their first third down play in the opening drive, but was 0-12 in the remainder of the contest.

The Clemson offense closed out the game with 40 consecutive running plays.
