CLEMSON VS TEMPLE GAME NOTES

On Temple's second play from scrimmage, Conrad Swanson rushed for 10 yards, the longest running play against Clemson to date. Later in the first half, he had a rush for 16 yards, which was the longest run for Temple in the game and the longest against the Tigers in the last two games.

When Temple scored on a ~~one~~^{one} yard pass play at the 3:17 mark in the first quarter, it marked the first time since the N.C. State contest (October 20, 1990) that an opponent had scored a touchdown against the Tigers in the first quarter.

When DeChane Cameron connected with Dwayne Bryant on a six-yard pass, it marked the first reception of Bryant's career. With 24 seconds left in the first half, Bryant caught his second career pass and his first career touchdown pass. On the day, Bryant caught two balls for 13 yards and one touchdown.

On the day, DeChane Cameron connected on seven of 12 passes for 85 yards and two touchdowns. This was the third time in Cameron's career that he has thrown two touchdown passes in a game. He also did it against Duke and Illinois last year.

When the first quarter ended today, it marked the first time since the N.C. State game (October 20, 1990) that the Tigers had trailed at the end of the first quarter. Temple led 7-0 at the end of the first quarter.

At the end of the first quarter, the second most impressive stat of the game besides Temple's 7-0 lead, was that Temple held the ball for 11:09 in the first quarter as compared to 3:51 for the Tigers. At the end of the contest, Temple had controlled the ball for 34:56, while the Tigers held the ball for 25:04.

When Clemson's Larry Ryans scored on the end around in the second quarter, it marked his first carry of the season and the first rushing touchdown of his career. Ryans now has 130 yards rushing in his career.

On the year, Ed McDaniel unofficially has 19 total tackles, giving him 294 for his career. He is currently tied for seventh with former Tiger great Terry Kinard on the Clemson Career Tackle list.

Senior middle guard Rob Bodine had three tackles for loss this afternoon, giving him 27 for his career. He is now tied with former Tiger Vance Hammond with for seventh place on the Tiger Career Tackle for Loss List.

When Temple scored on a ~~one~~^{one} yard touchdown pass in the first quarter, it marked the first time since the Georgia Tech-Clemson contest in 1989 (Oct. 14), that an opponent had connected on a touchdown pass in Death Valley. Tech's Shawn Jones connected with Bobby Rodriguez on an 81-yard touchdown pass in that contest. Tech defeated the Tigers 30-14 that afternoon.

At the end of the first half, Temple had compiled 73 yards on the ground. On the day, Temple compiled just 89 yards in rushing and 104 yards in total offense. Temple had just 23 yards in total offense in the second half. They had just 15 yards passing on the day.

Outside linebacker Wayne Simmons finished the game with three tackles for loss for 20 yards on the day. For his career, Simmons has 11 tackles for loss.

On the day, Tiger placekicker Nelson Welch, was good on a 27-yard field goal and also converted on three PATs on the day. For the season, Welch has scored 16 points for the Tigers.

The 15 yards passing for Temple this afternoon, set an all-time low for passing yards record for the Owls. The former record was 22 yards which took place against Cincinnati in 1982.

Also, the six first downs for Temple today, tied an all-time low which took place against Penn State in 1979.

COACHES QUOTES

COACH KEN HATFIELD: I knew we'd have a little problem, but I didn't want it to be that close (in the first half). But that blocked punt was probably the key play in the game. Something like that can demoralize a team and it showed that today. They were still very much in the game and they had a lot of fight in them. But the blocked punt does a lot to team down the confidence of one team and lift the confidence of the other. And you can see how our spirits were lifted after the punt was blocked.

We don't get many chances to pass inside the 10-yard line like we need to do, and we had one time out left and I knew we could get a field goal try but we wanted to get some of that work in (Hatfield was referring to the touchdown pass just before the end of the first half). But we were fortunate and everything turned out good for us.

We were able to stop their draw play after they got some good gains off it early, and that was about the only that that was really hurting us. We slowed it down and finally took it away from them. I was hoping for a shutout, but nothing but our turnovers gave them good field position.

Our kicking game was good to us (on the blocked punt and a couple of good returns) and that made some positive things happen for us.

I don't think we had our minds completely on the game, with Georgia Tech just being on television Thursday night and we have them next week. But the results we wanted happened and we're happy to be 2-0.
