Georgia Tech Head Coach Bobby Ross

"I thought our kids played very hard. They played with a tremendous amount of intensity. It was a very tough football game on the part of both teams. I'm really proud of how hard our kids played. I was fearful that that touchdown right before the half (nullified by penalty) was going to be a costly one for us, and it turned out to be. I'm not complaining about the call. I thought it was a legitimate call. Our player who did it admitted that he did. It was a big big penalty in the football game. I thought our defense hung in there and played extremely well. Clemson is a great football team. They are a very strong line of scrimmage type football team. I was very, very proud of the way our kids hung in there. We had a lot of adversity. Most of the second half we had two freshmen in our secondary. I thought they hung in there and played with a tremendous amount of character in the entire second half.

"It's a tough loss. It was a tough, tough hard football game. I thought overall our kids handled the crowd reasonably well. I was really proud of our two-minute offense. We got in a position to win the game and that's really all you can ever ask. "

(On early TD) "We really emphasized to our squad the importance of playing well early. The whole intent on that was to get the crowd out of the ball game. I don't know if we did, but our kids came out and played really hard. We had some opportunities even after that if we had been able to capitalize. They're a great football team."

CLEMSON COACH KEN HATFIELD: That was one of the greatest victories I've ever been in in all my life. That's as exciting since I've been here. We played harder I believe than any game since I've been here and we set a record in victories in a row at home. The fans stayed with us, the players never doubted.

Last year we saw Chris Gardocki miss a field goal that would have given us the victory and today we saw Scott Sisson have one go astray. I didn't want the game to come down to him and I'm sure last year they didn't want it to come down to Chris, but I think they had a great respect for our si- guys rushing up the middle, we had great pressure and great surge I know, and we're just thankful to God that we had a chance to win and that's the way it turned out.

We got a term called 'bonzi kicking' which means, attack, attack, attack. And we told them before the game that the bonzi kicking was going to decide a game like this and it did. The Only flaw in our kicking game today was the blocked extra point attempt. But the great catch by Terry Smith right before the half, Nelson Welch's field goal as time ran out in the first half and Darrell St ephens' punt return was some of the greatest pressure plays you'll ever want to see. We went to a two-tight end offense late in the game and that helped us out and when we went in the end zone (with the winning score) from three yards out, that's something you might not expect. But the line came off the ball and we did make it. That was a big, big play.
