COACHES' QUOTES

COACH KEN HATFIELD, CLEMSON: We're thankful for the win. We learned a lot of things, like what we can do best, what we have to work on this coming week and what our best chances are in certain situations.

UNLV made some key completions on third down passes. We'll give them credit because they certainly deserve it. They never did let us let up.

We made a couple of key mistakes like the fumble punt to start the third quarter and give them momentum where they were able to score on a short touchdown. That was a big, big play in the game. I think at that point if we could have taken the ball and did something with it, we'd been better off, but we let them back in the game and that's something you cannot do. I think Humphrey will learn from that and not do it again. Other than that, I was just pleased that we were able to rally and win.

I think we have a lot of work to do, there's no doubt about that.

But after Humphrey made his mistake, he came back and made a great punt return that gave us good field position and that was a big, key play.

I thought it was appropriate to put Louie (Solomon) in when we did because we didn't do as good offensively early in the game and I thought that we needed a change of pace. We felt like we could run the option after we knew what they were doing. I think we were maybe trying to do too much offense early in the game. And Louise gave us a little more variety.

One thing we didn't let them hit any deep ones on us and we were able to pretty much shut down their running game and that was encouraging. And if you can do that, you have a chance to play good defense.

UNLV COACH JIM STRONG

"I was very proud of our players and the intensity level they played with and the toughness they showed. Clemson is a big, physical team and I know they play a big game next week against Florida State. There was a lot that they did not run today against us. I'm sure that they have a lot more that they will do for next week.

"I think Clemson has an outstanding team with some quality players. They are going to win some games and go to a bowl game.

"We did not capitalize when we got a chance. We were knocking on the door at the two yardline and didn't get it. Garritano has won some games for us since I've been head coach but he just missed that field goal. We had a low snap and just didn't get it in.

"I was very proud of our defense, especially with two of our starting tackles out. Our team has been real young for the last couple of seasons. They were playing as freshmen and sophomores and now those guys are older and won't make those young mistakes. I think they are learning how to play football. This is the first time we have ever played an opponent like Clemson. They are the best team we've played since I've been coaching. ~~XXXXXX playing 80,000~~ It's not like playing 11 players on the field, it's like playing 80,000 and 11.

Clemson UNLV Notes

*At the end of the third period Tiger mascot Chase Nichols proposed to cheerleader Sandra Reid of Greenville, SC. The mic-man, Don Welsh actually did the talking, because the Tiger mascot cannot speak.

*When the game ended, there were less than 10,000 people in the stands due to the inclement weather (severe lightning and wind) that hit at 3:36 PM. The delay lasted 17 minutes. The crowd total present for the last 5:29 of the game was the smallest since Nov. 27, 1954 when Clemson beat The Citadel 59-0. According to SID Emeritas Bob Bradley, it rained cats and dogs all day and the crowd was very small. Frank Howard waved and shook hands with every fan prior to the game.

*The 17 minute delay was the first delay for a football game in Death Valley since October 13, 1962 when a hail storm during halftime delayed the second half kickoff by 30 minutes. Georgia was Clemson's opponent that day and defeated the Tigers 24-15.

*Today marked the first game in which Clemson has used the new 30 foot high uprights on the goalposts. The posts were put in at the urging of Clemson kicker Nelson Welch and the posts came into play as UNLV kicker Nick Garritano hit the right upright on the first play of the 4th period. The kick would have tied the score at that time at 17-17.

*Patrick Sapp finished last year on a down note, hitting just 4-22 passes for 26 yards against South Carolina in the 1992 season finale. But, Sapp hit 10-14 for 194 yards and two scores in the season opener against UNLV, a passing efficiency mark of 234.5. That 234.5 efficiency ranks sixth best in Clemson history given a minimum of 10 attempts. It is the best single game all-around performance since the 1983 Virginia game when Mike Eppley posted a 235.4 mark (12-15 for 199 and two touchdowns).

*Clemson wide receiver Jason Davis won the battle of the Jason Davis's on Saturday. Clemson's red-shirt senior had a career day with four receptions for 81 yards. Coming into the game, Davis had just five catches for 50 yards for 32 previous games. His 47-yard reception set up Clemson's first score.

*Terry Smith had 3-67 in terms of receiving. The senior now needs just 28 yards to reach the 2,000-yard mark in career reception yards. Smith will become just the third Clemson player in history to reach 2,000 yards. Perry Tuttle and Jerry Butler are the others.

*Leomont Evans, a sophomore from Abbeville, SC, was Clemson's leading tackler with nine stops, including eight first hits. As a freshman, Evans had just four tackles all season.
