WAKE FOREST NOTES

Today's win was the first ACC victory for first-year head coach Jim Caldwell... The last time Wake Forest won at Clemson was in 1961; the last time the Deacons won two in a row in this series was in 1946 and 1947... The 48-yard run by Ned Moultrie in the third quarter tied his career-longest run and was Wake Forest's longest run from scrimmage this season... The 59-yard reception by Roger Pettus was the longest of his career...

CLEMSON HEAD COACH KEN HATFIELD

I didn't do a very good job in a lot of the little things. We've gone down to the fourth quarter four games in a row. Previously, we made some plays to win the games, but today we didn't make them.

I think if we've made the two-point play, we'd kicked off (and not tried a short kick) on a long field and a slick ball, we would have taken our chances with the long kick.

We had some continuity in the first half and had a little something going on the option moved the ball down and made some things happen. Course, Louie Solomon hurt his ankle again in the first half and couldn't play in the second half. We had to change gears a little bit and we didn't make anything happen with the option play.. We did throw the ball and we had some tough plays, but offensively, we didn't do what we needed to do. We were our own worst enemy.

The fumbled punt (snap) gave them ~~xxxxxx~~ field position for one score; and then we had a couple of critical penalties that hurt us after we had made a good gain or a first down.

I just didn't do a good enough job of preparing them. In any game, you have to dominate in offense, defense or kicking. If you dominate two out of three of them, it's usually what it takes to win the ball game. We did not dominate in either one of those categories today.

We lost Dexter McCleon early in the ball game, which is a big blow to us, taking a big offensive weapon away from us; then we lost Solomon and several times Patrick Sapp was shaken up and had to come out. Again, Richard Moncrief comes in and helps us out.

We've got a lot of young players and we need to grow up here at mid-season and it takes a lot of intensity to play hard each and every play. When things are going your way, everybody's excited but it takes a lot of maturity to play hard each and every down even when things aren't going right. You gotta dig down and find something extra.
