- *Clemson registered a season high in terms of total offense (410), time of possession (36:54), and rushing yardage (278).
- *Clemson did not have a turnover this afternoon, its first turnoverless game since the South Carolina game last year. Clemson's offense now has just eight turnovers in games this season.
- *Richard Moncrief hit Chris Franklin with a 77-yard scoring pass in the first quarter. That was the second longest reception for a Clemson running back in Tiger history and the longest since 1954. Joe Pagliei has the record for a reception by a Tiger running back. He caught an 81-yarder from Joel Wells against South Carolina that year. Ironic that pass was thrown by another running back, as Wells threw the ball on a halfback option pass.
- *Overall, the pass completion to Franklin was the 10th longest in Clemson history. You only have to go back to last year, however, to find a pass as long. Last year against UTC, Patrick Sapp hit Terry Smith for a 77-yard scoring pass.
- *Nelson Welch booted two field goals in today's game, the third time this year and the 17th time in his Clemson career that he has had a multiple field goal game. Welch now has eight field goals this year and 49 for his career. He moved ahead of David Treadwell into third place on the all-time Clemson field goal list with his performance in today's game. The only players ahead of him are Chris Gardocki and Obed Ariri, who both had 63 made field goals.
- *Clemson gained 278 yards on the ground, its highest rushing figure since the 1992 North Carolina game when the Tigers had 286 rushing yards. Clemson is now 15-1-1 under Hatfield when the Tigers gain at least 250 yards rushing. Since 1983, his teams are 62-3-1 when they gain 250 yards or more on the ground.
- *Chris McInally served as Clemson's punter this afternoon. It was his first appearance as a punter, be it high school or college. McInally was a member of the Clemson soccer team in the falls of 1991 and 1992, but joined the football team this fall. He had a successful debut with six punts for a 40.2 average and he allowed just one return for two yards. He also had three punts inside the 20 and got off a 55-yard boot, longest punt of the year by a Tiger. McInally did get into the Wake Forest game and attempt an on-side kick.
- *Clemson has now won 29 in a row over Southern Conference schools dating back to a loss to South Carolina in 1952. Clemson has held Southern Conference schools without a touchdown for 33 straight quarters dating back to a 1984 touchdown by Appalachian State.
- *Clemson had a lot of firsts today. Travis Harvey saw his first action at quarterback (he has been the holder all year) and completed his first pass, a 13-yarder to Greg Hood, who had his first reception of the year. Tony DeSue, a red-shirt freshman had his first career rushing action and had 4-14. Terry Smith, certainly not a newcomer had his first career rushing attempt, a 26-yarder. Andy Ford saw his first action in the secondary, and his twin brother, Peter Ford, had his first career interception.
- *Brett Williams had three tackles for loss, including two sacks, the first Tiger this year to have three tackles for loss or two sacks in a game.
- *The player who had the most unlikely first was outside linebacker Don Haney. The junior who is a transfer from St. Mary's College in Texas, had a tackle for loss and forced a fumble on consecutive plays in the fourth period. He is a native of San Antonio, TX and went to High school with fellow OLB Darnell Stephens. Haney is the son of a Clemson grad and had a 4.0 in his first semester at Clemson. He entered in January of 1993. Today was his first action in a football game since his senior year of high school (1990). He played rugby at St. Mary's, that school does not have a football team. He was Clemson's answer to Rudy, he even plays the same position as Rudy (OLB) and had a tackle for loss just two plays into his college career, the same number of plays it took Rudy to record a tackle for loss (in real life, not the movie).
- *Today was Clemson's first shutout since a 34-0 win over Appalachian State in 1991 and was the fifth since Ken Hatfield took over as Clemson coach in 1990.
- *The Tiger team attended the movie "Rudy" on Friday night.

COACH KEN HATFIELD OF CLEMSON

We're very appreciative of the support that the fans gave us today and the players responded well. We got so many young people to play in the game and for the most part, we were satisfied with their play. The Ford twins I thought gave a good account of themselves on that goal line stand at the cornerback position and even Andy had been playing some safety earlier in the year.

This was a great day to have a third team quarterback (Travis Harvey) come in and play. We were trying to get everyone in who had been on the practice field, but we missed a couple of them and I apologized to them.

We had a great defensive effort. The only thing they did was hit that long 66-yard pass into the wind which we didn't expect. Again, I'm just proud of the young men, even when they got down there on the two-yard line and that's a credit to them and that they do have a shutout to register.

The wishbone did okay for us, but we could have gone the other way a couple of times, and got some more yardage, but this is something we can build on. We did adjust to some things, and the screen pass to Chris Frankling was a big gainer for us; Milt Shaw had a super run. But we showed we could move and throw the ball out of it. We're just missing a little timing there of a couple of inches to Terry Smith on three big passes.

COACH MIKE CAVAN OF EAST TENNESSEE STATE

"I don't think we played as well as we can especially on offense. I think we have improved a lot this season. We have a week off now and we will certainly practice hard. We still have a bunch of football left.

"Naturally there were some mismatches size wise. This was a great experience for our kids. We felt real good at halftime. We were down 13-0 and it could have been 13-7.

" We made some good plays and got the ball down field but could not get it in. Of course, the Clemson defense is pretty stout.

I think Clemson put it out of reach early in the second half.- They have some huge people. I thought Gabe Berry came in and did a pretty good job at QB considering. He has made a lot of improvement since the beginning of the
