COACHES' QUOTES

COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON:

I knew that our team was ready to play and I knew that we were in condition to play and I knew that Furman would come in here and play us absolutely as hard as they could play. They have that type of program and I knew they would play us tough; but I thought our team stuck to what it came into the game to accomplish. Late in the third quarter I thought we wore them down a little and we moved the ball.

The only negative I saw in the game was our kickoff coverage, besides I thought we had way too many penalties. Our kickoff coverage team I thought was very poor, but we'll go to work on that. We've got people running out of their lanes. It's really hard to work that team live in pre-season, but we'll come back and work on it and we'll improve there.

We try to be a formation team and what happened--we should have moved the ball better early on the game. But they matched up with us, they walked outside with us. We just had some mistakes and that's going to happen and I'm a little impatient. But as the game wore on, I thought they warmed up to it. But that's the first time a lot of them have played and then I thought they played well throughout the second half.

I was pleased coming in. We had a very tough camp and a very physical camp to test these tailbacks and I think they're ready to play college football.

I think Patrick (Sapp) is comfortable with this offense, but I didn't think he was completely on today. He missed some early in the game that he'll make on down the road, but we wanted to come into this game and not turn it completely into an all-out running game, but have a balanced game plan. When we got them loosened up a bit, we were able to go back to our running game and I believe did very well. Our defense kept us in the game and our defense is going to allow us to be a little more wide open on offense and try to score points. And we were able to put a couple of drives together. Several times it looked like Clemson again when a four or five yard ~~xxxxx~~ run turned into ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ nine or 10-yard runs.

PLAYER QUOTES --

Wardell Rouse (OLB)

"We used the quickness that we had to our advantage, but we have a lot to work on in the near future. We'll be a good defensive squad. It's nothing like last year so far. Our offense did what they had to do and they did a great job. We put a lot more pressure on the quarterback this season."

Warren Forney (DE)

"I felt a lot of pressure today, but it all paid off. I like our defensive scheme that we have gotten from the coaches. It allows you to know the game. I feel like I'll know the game of football when I'm out of Clemson. It's hardhitting football, but it's fun. Coach West has stressed that we have fun as well as play the game as best we can. I had some pains in my knee today, but I worked through that and I played as best I could. Furman is a good, sound team. The things that they do, they do very well. We wanted it (the win). But they were a great team and they'll have a great year. Depth-wise, we don't have a lot of depth on defense, but we'll get better as the year goes on.

I wanted to go out and play hard and win the game, and that's exactly what we did."

Anthony Downs (TB)

"The win for the team is the biggest thrill that I have today. I found out I was starting just before we came here (to the stadium) today. The fans were great, all the screaming before, during, and after the game. I felt OK as the starting man for my position. I felt like I did all right. The game is a lot faster than high school football.

I felt like the offensive line did a great job."

FURMAN HEAD COACH BOBBY JOHNSON:

"When you're on that sideline, you see how well those Clemson defenders can pursue. We couldn't get outside, and we couldn't loosen them up inside. That was due to them (Clemson) more than it was poor execution.

"I think our guys were ready to play. I thought we played well in the first half. We got awfully tired in the fourth quarter. That was when they bruised us a bit up the middle. Still, until they scored to go up 27-6, I thought we had a chance. That fumble call down there -- I thought we had a chance until then, and they scored right after that.

"We played hard. I thought we were too aggressive in spots, and that hurt us. I think this game will help us out. We don't see that type of personnel we saw today, although next week South Carolina State will have some guys that are good."

"Clemson's got a good set of tailbacks for the future. They sure ran a lot of them in there. They are well coached, and were prepared for us.

FURMAN JUNIOR FREE SAFETY MARK TATE

"The coaches told us coming into the game not to make super heroes out of them, to just play hard. I thought we did a good job against them early, particularly against the run. We could have played better, but Clemson made the plays.

FURMAN QUARTERBACK PHILLY JONES

"They (Clemson) were real quick. As far as personnel goes, they are the best team we'll face this year. They really stopped us on the run. Our biggest problem from an offensive standpoint was our inability to get yardage on first down. It's tough to move the ball when you can't get much on first down.

*Furman's six points today were the most scored by a Paladin squad against Clemson since 1961, when Furman lost 35-6 to Clemson.

*Furman placekicker Jim Richter's two field goals gave him six straight made field goals dating back to last season. His last miss was a 45-yarder last year in a 20-10 loss to The Citadel.

Postgame Notes

- * Clemson acting President Phil Prince became the first person in history to dot the "I" in Tigers and Run Down the Hill during the pregame ceremonies. It was 50 years ago this season that Prince first ran down the hill as a freshman football player for the Tigers. That was just the third season of football in Death Valley (1944).
- * Clemson first-year freshman Anthony Downs gained 89 yards rushing in 17 attempts, the most yards by a first-year freshman in his first game in 49 years. In the season opener of the 1945 season Bobby Gage gained 144 yards in just eight carries against Presbyterian in the opener of the 1945 season. He had an 88 yard run in that contest.
- * Downs was the first first-year freshman to start the opener since 1973 when Ken Callicutt got the nod. Callicutt, who went on to a pro career with the Detroit Lions, had 12-59 on the ground against The Citadel.
- * Clemson got 185 yards rushing in 37 attempts from its first-year freshman running backs this afternoon, an average of 5 yards per rush.
- * This was Clemson's most productive season opener from an offense standpoint since 1991. Clemson gained just 332 yards in total offense vs. UNLV last year and just 291 against Ball State in 1992. The Tigers had 409 against Appalachian State in 1991. Today Clemson gained 377 yards in total offense. Today's 268 rushing total was the best in an opener since 1991 when Clemson had 275 against APP. State.
- * This was Clemson's 25th win in a row over Furman and its 30th win in a row over a team from the Southern Conference. It was the ninth straight game that Clemson has held a Southern Conference team without a touchdown. It has been 10 years since the Southern Conference scored a TD against Clemson. The last to do it was a Sparky Woods coached Appalachian State team in 1984. Johnny Sowell scored on a 9-yard pass from Randy Joyce in the third period of a Clemson victory.
- * Nine first-year freshmen appeared in the game for Clemson. The list includes Anthony Downs (TB), James Jenkins (TB), Lamont Pegues (TB), Raymond Priester (FB), Kenya Crooks (WR), Undre Williams (WR), Tony Horne (WR), Tony Plantin (DT), and Mark Landry (OG, C). That does not include the 6 red-shirt freshmen who participated: Jim Bundren (OT), Glenn Rountree (OG), Lamont Hall (TE), Ed Altma (OG), Raymond White (DT), Benji Wood (FB).
- * Clemson held Furman to -3 yards rushing, the eighth best rushing defense in Clemson history and the best since the season opener of 1990 when Long Beach State had just -16 yards rushing.
- * Clemson did not have a turnover on offense and forced two on defense. It was Clemson's first turnoverless opener since the 1988 season against Virginia Tech. It is safe to say it was the first turnoverless game in many years in which Clemson had first-year freshmen carry the ball 37 times.
- * Clemson held Furman to 99 yards total offense. That was the best total defense by the Tigers since Appalachian State had just 84 yards total offense in the opener of the 1991 season. In other words today's performance was the best total defense figure in 34 games.
- * Nelson Welch booted two more field goals, both over 40 yards. He now has 58 field goals in his career, five off the Clemson record (Chris Gardocki and Obed Ariri)
