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COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON: It was great to be back home again after three weeks on the road. I thought our players did an excellent job this week. We're disappointed that we are out of the bowl picture, and Tuesday the team was very dead and I knew what was going on. But toward the end of the week our seniors did a great job with their leadership in picking this team back up and a never say quit.

We're creating on this team some competition (between quarterbacks) and that's what we wanted. Nealon (Greene) can't play and Louie (Solomon) comes in and has a great day-- that's competition.

I thought our backs took it up a level. And the reason for that is that we are getting some blocking up front. Our offensive line played much better today and they're improving weekly. They came off the ball well today.

We talked about it last night, again at the meeting this morning and before we came down the hill -- we gotta get somebody from the get-go. We gotta play our game. We gotta play as hard as we can from the outset and not wait for something to happen and that is what our team did.

Louie is not a throwing quarterback so we gotta be good on first down plays and I thought he did real well today in converting third downs. We let him sprint out some and I believe that he can be more effective out of the shotgun that up on the line under center. And I thought that Pat (Sapp) came in and threw with a little more authority than he has, so the competition is picking up.

What distrubs me is that we get a penalty before the game starts. For some reason we were held (on the hill) and I don't know what was happening there. I'm very proud of our baseball team and band, but we can't afford a penalty to start the game.

COACH JIM CALDWELL OF WAKE FOREST: (ON QB SOLOMON) "He had a big day. We knew he had a lot of talent and he's like a tailback with the ball in his hands. He ran well today and we just couldn't stop him.

"Clemson is a pretty good defensive team, one of the better defensive teams in the conference, and we just couldn't put any drives together where we moved the ball consistently

"I thought going into the game that if we could maintain good field position and keep our defense out of bad position, that we could stay in the game. I thought we might be able to pull the game out by a score of something like 6-3 because I figured if both teams played great defense, and we were able to force a couple of turnovers, that we might be able to kick a couple of field goals and win, but that didn't happen. Clemson played well on both sides of the ball and we weren't able to make anything happen."

(ON WAKE FOREST'S EFFORT): "We've always had great effort and today was no exception. We went out there and played as hard as we could, but we're getting to the point now where we've got to start winning some ball games."
