The 26 point margin, 33-7, is South Carolina's largest margin of victory at Clemson. In six victories on Frank Howard Field, the Gamecocks have won by scores of 7-0, 21-14, 28-14, 28-14, 28-14, and 24-13. The previous widest margin was 11 points two years ago.

The second half kickoff return that covered 94 yards was the eighth longest in South Carolina history. Brandon Bennett returned nine yards, then lateraled to Reggie Richardson, who carried 85 yards to the Clemson six.

Craig Morton's two field goals were the 22nd and 23rd of his career. The sophomore has made 23 of 32 field goal attempts and, after a two for five start in 1994, has made eight in a row for 10-13 on the season.

In addition to its biggest margin at Clemson, South Carolina's 33 points are the most for the Gamecocks in the series since 1975. The Gamecocks won 56-20 that year in Columbia.

The win over Clemson also marks the first time ever that South Carolina has won four road games in a season. The Gamecocks defeated Kentucky, Louisiana State, Vanderbilt and Clemson on the road this season. The only road loss was at Florida.

The 6-5 record is South Carolina's first winning season since 1990. The Gamecocks went 6-5 that season under Coach Sparky Woods. It is also the first winning season for a first year Gamecock head coach since Jim Carlen went 7-5 in his first season, 1975.

Runningback Brandon Bennett was ~~named~~ ^{VOTED} the Flagstar Most Valuable Player on offense for the Gamecocks and linebacker Hank Campbell won defensive MVP honors. For Clemson, the Flagstar MVPs were runningback Lamont Pegues on offense and linebacker Mike Barber on defense.
