COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON:

I think maybe we scored maybe in six of our first eight possessions. Offensively, we played pretty well in the first half, but we wasn't crisp like we should have been. In the second half, I thought things picked up pretty good. We got the ball into the hands of some people that we wanted to and we got a good look of what they could do.

We didn't look overly sharp, but we did show some potential in a number of areas. We might have more big plays in this game today than we had all of last year. I said earlier that we would like to have a balanced offense and we came pretty close (212 passing and 210 rushing). (NOTE: the last time Clemson had more yards passing than rushing was in last year's Duke game--172 to 127--a 19-13 loss).

On the 15-yard penalties: I don't like to see those 15-yard penalties we got and I want to study a couple of them on the film. A couple of them weren't smart plays, but were effort plays and I can't say too much to a player on that. One player told me that he didn't know the ball was down.

When we got the ball (right before the end of the first half) I didn't want us to sit on the ball, like maybe some of the fans wanted and mentioned to me. But I wanted to see what our two-minute offense looked like and we took the ball in and scored. That'll give us confidence. We're not supposed to sit down on the ball right before the half.

Patrick (Sapp) did a good job in his new position (linebacker). He rushed the passer a lot in the first half, but at halftime, he said that he wasn't tied.

We're happy with today's outcome. We got to use a lot of players and saw a number of different looks from a number of situations at different places on the field.

CLEMSON QUOTES

CARL BAKER, WR, Freshman --

"I learned a lot in camp this season. I thought my playing time was going to be limited few times and far between if I ever played this year. I came into it thinking if I play, I play, but I'm going to learn a lot from these guys. Coach Stockstill (Rick) said I was going to go in. I can't even describe the feeling (of making a touchdown). It happened on my second play in the game."

LAMARICK SIMPSON, DE,

"We practiced hard and went out there and executed the plays. We just did what we were supposed to do. We just went out there and played football. We never underestimate a team. We prepared for them like every team. As you can see from the score, we just came out on top. We are experience on defense. We have all our defensive linemen coming back. And the secondary is also experienced. Some freshman came in at linebacker, they came in and stepped up and played well for us today."

ANTWUAN WYATT, FLK

"We're going to keep working hard and try to win all of the ballgames. That's what we're here for. Going into spring practice, you're going to think about Florida State and Virginia and North Carolina, you just can't help it. We just didn't put all of our focus on them before this game. This game is going to prepare us for the next game. There's no such thing as not thinking about them because you have to with a team like that. "This is the first time since I've been here that we've scored more than 29 points in one game. I'm very relieved."

COACH STEVE HODGIN, WESTERN CAROLINA:

"We came out a little shaky...I think the noise caused a couple of those motion penalties on our first possession. I thought we recovered and had a chance to change the momentum when it was 7-6 and we recovered the fumble deep in their territory, but we gave ~~it~~ it back them and it was all down ~~the~~ hill from that point"

"Clemson is a much better football team than we saw on last year's tapes. They are like the Clemson teams of ~~xxxx~~ several years ago....they get after you on both sides of the ball."

"Our ~~offense~~ offense was just not there today and it hasn't been in preseason. Our timing is really off, I know we will be able to move the ball much better in a few weeks."

"I thought ~~we~~ we did a decent job, despite what the stats say, against the run."

"We had some positives in the game...not many, but we did come out of this one without any serious injuries that I am aware of."

"Clemson's quickness on both sides was just too much for us today."
