## COACHES QUOTES

Coach Tommy West of Clemson: When you play a team like this, and give them a short field, you're putting your back up against the wall. They go in from 47, 30 and 42 yards. It should have been possibly 14-10 at halftime.

Thought we had a very physical game up front. We went toe to toe and chest to chest with them. Coming in, I knew we had to make it a physical game.

We didn't get that done, but we have nine more games. We're going to play hard next week (At Wake Forest) and I hope the results will be better.

#### Andy McCrorey - ILB

"They're a good football team, really sound, a lot of good talent and it showed today. We went out to win the football game. We weren't intimidated, they game out with some big plays. You take away three draws and a couple other big plays and we're in the game. It was 21-7 going into the half and we come back in the fourth quarter and score two touchdowns and we're back in it. You take away the big plays and it's a closer ball game than it appeared.

"They're real good on the offensive line. They're real good position blockers and that was a key today. The draw was the difference in the game today, I think."

#### Will Young - OG

"We've got guys that we're rotating in there now, instead of just some playing the whole game, that makes it better. We're just going to have to keep fighting, we're going to be a good football team here soon.

"(The Loss) It feels good and it feels bad. Sometimes I thought we had them on the ropes. I thought we had a chance to win the ball game and then they scored again. I guess it feels good that you know that you're better, but losing is for the birds. Nobody wants to lose and it doesn't feel great."

- \* Clemson gained 321 yards rushing against Florida State, just the fifth time since 1978 that Clemson has rushed for over 300 yards, yet lost the game. Clemson is now 78-5-1 since 1978 when it rushes for at least 250 yards. The only other losses are at Georgia Tech in 1990, at Duke in 1989, at North Carolina in 1985 and the Maryland game at Clemson in 1985. The tie was against Virginia in 1991.
- \* Clemson gained 422 yards of total offense last week against Western Carolina and had 428 against Florida State. This is the first time since the ETSU and Maryland games of 1993 that Clemson has had consecutive 400-yard total offense games. Clemson had just one 400-yard game all of last year (413 vs. Wake Forest).
- \* Clemson had 150 yards of total offense midway through the second quarter. The Tigers had just 149 yards total offense the entire game last year. Today, Clemson also more than doubled its first down total (9 to 22), its yards per play (2.3 to 5.4), and third down conversions (3 to 8). Clemson improved its total offense 285 percent (149 to 428) and its rushing yardage by 373 percent.
- \* Raymond Priester rushed for a career high 111 yards in 22 attempts. His previous high 88 yards against Maryland last year.
- \* Emory Smith had his highest rushing game since he gained 113 yards in 18 attempts against Virginia in 1993. His 8-97 against Florida State included his longest career run, a 48-yard effort. His 97 yards today is the second highest total of his career.
- \* Clemson's 321 yard rushing game was the most since the Tigers gained 339 on the ground against Wake Forest last year. Clemson's 5.4 yards per play is the best by a Clemson team since the Tigers averaged 6.4 per play against Virginia in 1993.
- \* Clemson had three backs gain at least 80 yards this afternoon, 111 by Priester, 97 by Emory Smith and 83 by Lamont Pegues. This is the first time Clemson has had three players over 80 yards rushing in the same game since the 1992 Virginia game in Charlottesville. That day Rodney Blunt gained 141, Louis Solomon 116 and Rudy Harris 96.
- \* Nealon Greene's touchdown pass to Tony Horne of 56 yards was the longest pass of Greene's career and the longest reception of Horne's career. Horne had three catches for 72 yards, career highest in both areas.
- \* Antwan Wyatt had 150 yards in all-purpose running. He had a 144-yard effort against Western Carolina in the opener. However, Wyatt had just one reception for 12 yards, the first play of the game for Clemson.
- \* Clemson has 850 yards of total offense through two games. The Tigers had just 729 yards of total offense through the first three games last year. The Tigers had 321 yards rushing against FSU. Last season Clemson had just 349 yards rushing through the first three games of last year.
- \* Clemson punter Chris McInally had his best single game average as a Tiger. The senior who started his career on the Clemson soccer team, had a 43-yard average on six punts, including a career best 60-yarder.
- \* Clemson and Florida State scored on six consecutive possessions from the 6:25 mark of the third period to the 12:30 mark of the fourth. The streak ended when Nealon Greene threw an interception.
- \* Clemson had two more touchdown plays of at least 20 yards this afternoon, a 21-yard run by Raymond Priester and a 56-yard scoring pass from Nealon Greene to Tony Horne. Clemson now has six touchdowns of 20 yards or more this year after having just three offensive TDs on scoring plays of 20 yards or more all of last year.
- \* When Clemson scored a touchdown in the second period it ended a drought of nine straight scoreless quarters by Clemson against FSU. The last Clemson score had taken place at the 11:11 mark of the fourth period of the 1992 game with the Seminoles in Death Valley.
- \* Freshman Anthony Simmons had nine tackles to tie for the team lead according to the press box stats. He also led Clemson in tackles last week against Western Carolina with 10. No Clemson freshman has ever led the Tigers in tackles in his first two games as a Tiger.
- \* Patrick Sapp was involved in a sack of Danny Kanell in the first half. He was sacked twice as the Clemson quarterback against Florida State in 1993. Sapp, who also played basketball for the Tigers last year, might be the only college athlete to sack Heisman candidate Danny Kanell and guard first round draft pick Rasheed Wallace in the same year.
- \* Clemson lost a fumble against FSU and now has two lost fumbles this year, the same total Clemson had for the entire 1994 season. Clemson running backs have lost just one fumble covering their last 480 carries over the last two years. No current Clemson running back has lost a fumble over the last two years.

# FLORIDA STATE VS. CLEMSON

## FIRST HALF GAME NOTES

**GARNET BRITCHES AGAIN:** The Seminoles who are playing their second straight "road" game today at Clemson chose to wear the garnet pants for only the fifth time in school history. The Tribe wore the pants last week against Duke in the Citrus Bowl (a Blue Devil home game) and Coach Bowden had the seniors vote on the traditional gold pants or the garnet.

**QUICK SCORE:** Pooh Bear Williams scored from two yards out with just 1:10 expired in the game to make it two games in a row that the Tribe took the first possession in for a score. It took 2:08 for FSU to open the scoring against Duke.

While the next scoring drive took just 1:16 (just 30 yards long after a fumble recovery), it came on the Tribe's fourth possession and nine minutes after the first score.

**THAT'S POOH:** Fullback Pooh Bear Williams' two first half touchdowns gave him six for the year already. He came just one shy of tying Greg Allen's school record four rushing touchdowns last week against Duke.

After Williams's second TD run, he had carried the ball six times this season for five touchdowns.

**GREEN ON THE REC...OOPS:** E.G. Green's drop with 11:48 left in the first quarter was the first drop for an FSU wide out this year. The Seminole receiving corps did not drop one in 26 attempts against Duke last week.

**PENALTIES HURT A LOT:** While FSU was flagged for four penalties in the first half for 35 yards, two of them really ate up big plays. A motion penalty negated a 21-yard pass to E.G. Green and a holding call brought back Warrick Dunn's 49-yard jaunt.

FSU players pay a heavy toll in the form of sprints during practice for penalties. The holding call on Dunn's run was charged to two-time All ACC center Clay Shiver who has not been called for holding since his freshman season.

**BLOCK PARTY FOR THE TRIBE:** Hank Grant's blocked punt was the first since Dulack Guerrier blocked a Miami punt last year. The effort proved costly for Grant who reinjured his shoulder on the play and will not return to the game.

**SHUTOUT STREAK OVER:** Clemson's touchdown with 11:20 left in the second quarter was its first score against Florida State since the two teams met in Death Valley in 1992.

**TRUE FROSH ON RETURN:** Rock Hill, South Carolina native Dee Feaster saw his first action as a punt returner in the first half pouncing on a loose ball in the second quarter.

**DUNN IT:** While Warrick Dunn's first half numbers will probably be impressive (written before stats are out) they might have been startling had he been able to keep the 49-yard run that was called back.

# FLORIDA STATE AT CLEMSON

## SECOND HALF GAME NOTES

**QUICK STRIKE ABILITY:** Florida State's first four scoring drives took an average of just 68 seconds.

**BACK-UPS GET BUSY:** Among a number of FSU second teamers to see more action than they might have planned was offensive guard Tim Johnson who played the entire second half. Johnson replaced Lewis Tyre who was suffering from cramps.

**BEEN A WHILE:** The last time a team rushed for over 300 yards on the Seminoles was during the 1990 season when Miami gained 334 yards on the ground en route to a 31-22 win. The last time an opponent outgained Florida State was last year when Miami totalled 363 yards of total offense to FSU's 219.

**HIGH SCORING SEMINOLES?** While Florida State at least tied a Death Valley record for most points by an opponent held by N.C. State (45-7 in 1975), it is only the second time in the last seven games that Florida State has scored more than 40 points, and just they've scored more than 41 points just three times over the last 11 games.

**POINTS ON THE BOARD:** Clemson's 26 points today tied Duke for the most points scored against FSU since the Seminoles joined the league in 1992. Duke had 26 points last week against the Tribe in a 70-26 loss.

**CAREER DAY FOR DUNN:** Dunn had a career-high 180 rushing on 12 carries today. Dunn's previous high was 174 yards on 13 carries against Georgia Tech last year. He now has nine career 100 yard games (one as a freshman, six last year and both this season).

The game note on Warrick Dunn's consecutive 100-yard regular season game is incorrect. Dunn did not rush for over 100 yards in the regular season finale against Florida. He has rushed for over 100 yards in four consecutive ACC games.

**SANDERS IS A COWBOY:** Former Florida State All-American Deion Sanders signed with the Dallas Cowboys during the game according to AP reports. Sanders was the "forgotten" hero of the Seminoles' win in Death Valley in 1988 as he revived a sluggish FSU squad with a punt return for a touchdown in the second half.
