Coaches Quotes

COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON: About the only work to use on this game today is "war" and that's what it was and for 60 minutes. That was some football game.

Our defense played outstanding. We gave up some passes. And we knew that North Carolina was the second ranked defensive team in the country. We made some mistakes, ^{there} in the fourth quarter and we haven't been doing that. But we had some players to come through for us. Our punter (Chris McNally) saved his best til last. But this football team did one thing--offensively and defensively--they never gave up, and that's what they've done all year.

When you talk about our offense going flat, you have to look at who you're playing defensively. I've said all week that North Carolina is as talented as Florida State. I think North Carolina has as much talent as any team in this league, and they are an outstanding defensive team. And that has a lot to do with your offense looking flat.

We came into the locker room at the end bruised up...we're banged up. It looks like maybe that Warren Forney, who dislocated his elbow early, could possibly be the only one we'd lose for next week (for Duke). Nad I hope that is the case, we're banged up right now. That was a physical football game.

I thought out coaches did a good job mixing blitz. - But you can't stay in blitz because they'll catch you underneath, which they did several times. However, we hit their quarterback a bunch of times and in the end, that pays off for you.

This is a big huge win for us. Let's don't forget where we're coming from. We were 3-3 at one time this year. We beat a good football team.

Our seniors came to me Thursday and asked if they could wear the orange pants and I told them I didn't know, but after I slept on it Thursday night. And I decided that they had worked hard and were deserving in wearing them. They have done what we've asked them to -- work hard, go to class, be an asset off the field. I told them (seniors) to get with the team and decide what they wanted to do, but I told them if they were going to wear them...when you put 'em on, we're going to play hard.

PLAYER QUOTES

RAYMOND PRIESTER - #27

It was a good week of practice. It was an intense week. Any time you have a chance to play in a bowl game, it feels great. The team wants to go out and do their best. I'm happy that we're in the situation that we're in. We just have to take it one step at a time, one game at a time.

(Was this a pressure game - the team under a lot of pressure?) "Somewhat. Everybody feels a little pressure when we do anything. But we just approached this game like we would every week. We tried not to get over-hyped. We just came out to play a game."

"Running is a big part of our offense. Whenever we get our hands on the ball we want to make the best of it. You never know when it's going to be your last time to carry it. We just come out and try to make the best of our offense."

ANTHONY SIMMONS - #41

"We figured if we stopped the run up the middle, they would have to pass the ball."

"Right now, we're doing well working together as a team. We're focused. We're trying to stay concentrated."

(Did you think about breaking the freshman tackle record?) "I really don't think about it. I just try to get in on every play I can. That's what's got to happen."

"The interceptions helped out a lot. We had really good pass coverage and were stuffing it up the middle. The defense had a lot to prove in this game. We know that we have a pretty tough defense right now."

North Carolina Head Coach Mack Brown

"First I would like to congratulate Clemson on a great win. This is a great step forward for them. They have a great chance to go to a bowl game.

"In the third quarter we fell behind and lost momentum, just like we did against Georgia Tech. We just made too many mistakes. This season has been extremely frustrating because of too many mistakes. I'm very proud of these guys. They went out there and played their best today.

"The turning point of this game was in the third quarter when Clemson intercepted the ball and went back for a touchdown. It just seems as if our team has not gotten many breaks this season. We will have to go back and improve. We had too many turnovers and Clemson had only one. I feel that we played good offensively but had too many turnovers.

"I am proud of our defense because of the way they played and fought throughout the game. We really had a lot of strong hits today. They did a good job.

"Clemson did good on defense also. Both teams had a lot of good hits. The key to winning is not turning the ball over, playing good defense, and playing with confidence. This is exactly what Clemson did today. This is a great place to play. All the coaches are great. There is so much pride and tradition here, but we usually don't have a lot of chances here.

"We're a young team, and we've come a long way. We must fight through. If we win a couple more games then we will have a winning record for the last six years. We just have to keep our expectations up."

Clemson vs. North Carolina Notes

- *Clemson's twin cornerbacks, Andy and Peter Ford combined for three interceptions today. It was the first time each of the Ford twins had an interception in the same game. That was easy to determine because the interception by Andy Ford was the first of his career. Peter Ford, who had two interceptions in the game, now has three interceptions this year and eight for his career. He had two as a freshman, three as a sophomore and three this season.
- *Brian Dawkins returned an interception 49 yards for a touchdown on North Carolina's first possession of the second half. It was his third interception of the season and eighth of his career. It was his first return for a touchdown and the first for any Clemson player since Tim Jones returned a Steve Tanneyhill Interception 26 yards for a score in the 1992 Clemson vs. South Carolina game. Dawkins's interception was the longest interception return for a touchdown since Arlington Nunn returned an INT 55 yards for a score against Long Beach State in 1990.
- *Anthony Simmons was credited with 15 tackles from the press box on Saturday. He now has 109 stops for the season. He broke the Clemson freshman record of 104 by Ed McDaniel in 1988. McDaniel is now a starting linebacker for the Minnesota Vikings.
- *Clemson's defense has now allowed just 13 points over the last three games. When North Carolina scored a touchdown in the fourth period it broke a string of 12 straight quarters in which the Tigers had not given up a touchdown. Georgia had scored a six-pointer in the third period of its 19-17 win over Clemson.
- *Clemson's defense has allowed just four opponent drives to penetrate its own 20 yardline over the last three games. Maryland did not get inside the Clemson 20 at all, Georgia Tech did it just once and North Carolina got inside the Clemson 20 three times today.
- *Inside linebacker Mond Wilson took over for Andye McCrorey when the latter was injured in the first half. Wilson responded with 10 tackles, a career high. Wilson's previous career high was five tackles against Western Carolina this year. He had never played more than 28 snaps in a game prior to today.
- *Patrick Sapp was credited with seven tackles today, including a tackle for loss. Sapp now has 25 tackles in the last four games.
- *Joe Woods caught a 30-yard touchdown pass from Neanlon Greene in the first half. It was the first touchdown of Woods's college career. He transferred to Clemson after Mississippi went on probation and thus was eligible immediately. He caught 17 passes at Mississippi, but never scored a touchdown.
- *Two Tigers suffered injuries today. Warren Forney suffered a dislocated elbow and probably will miss next week's game with Duke. Andye McCrorey suffered a sprained ankle and it is not known whether he will play next week.
- *Raymond Priester had 95 yards rushing against the Tar Heels and now has 938 net yards for the season. He needs 62 yards to become the first Tiger since 1988 to rush for 1,000 yards in a season. Terry Allen (1192) is the last to do it. Priester is trying to become just the seventh Tiger in history to rush for 1000 yards in a season. His 938 total is already 10th best in Clemson history for a single season.
- *Antwuan Wyatt caught seven passes for 64 yards today, his high catch total of the season. He caught eight passes in a game against N.C. State last year. Wyatt had 113 all-purpose yards today and now has 1125 all-purpose yards this season. That total ranks 10th in Clemson history. The record is 1446 by Terrence Flagler in 1986.
- *Chris McNally's 65-yard punt in the fourth period was the longest of his career and the longest by a Tiger in Death Volley since 1990 when Chris Gardocki had a 78-yarder against South Carolina in the last punt of his Clemson career in the facility.
- *Clemson is now 29-6 when wearing orange pants. It was the first time this year they had worn them. The 29-6 ledger includes a 20-3 record at home, and 14-2 in games in which Tommy West has been a Tiger coach. (3-0 as head coach and 11-2 as an assistant). Clemson has now won seven in a row in orange pants. Clemson's three losses at home in orange pants over the years have all been to top 10 teams (S. Carolina in 1984, Florida State in 1988 and 1992).
- *Clemson has assured itself of a winning season overall and in league play. Clemson has had a losing season in the ACC just once (1992) since 1981.
- *Clemson just finished back-to-back games against teams ranked in the top 10 in the nation in rushing defense. The Tigers gained 391 yards rushing in those games,
