## COACHES QUOTES

### COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON

I told both our offensive line and defensive line that this game was going to be won right there. If our defensive line could pressure the quarterback, and the offensive line control their part...there was no doubt, that our offense had to control the ball and I thought they played tremendous.

The offensive line -- I think they take a lot of pride in us having a 1,000-yard rusher (Raymond Priester). I'm just happy for them (offensive line) because it has not happened overnight for them. We had to grow. We went through some growing pains...now they've grown up a little bit and they're playing really well right now and giving our running backs a chance.

When Duke scored, we went down and told the offense, 'it's up to you now' -- it's on your shoulders!..and I tell you what -- nobody turned away when we said that-- they said 'we know it' and they knew what their job was.

This football team has done something real special I think. Four weeks ago, there was a lot of pressure on the team with people telling them they gotta win four out of five and what do they do, they win four in a row...and I think that shows character. This football team has really accomplished something. They worked hard, they stayed focused, one game at a time and it takes a very mature football team to do that, and we did it basically with a bunch of sophomore and a senior class that has done very well.

It looked <sup>like</sup> Brian (Dawkins) had a chance to break the world's record there for awhile with three intercepts in the first quarter. He was everywhere. But when we go back and look at this game, I think the key defensively is that we put pressure on the quarterback, and we hit him a lot. We took chances in the secondary, but that was the key -- putting pressure on the quarterback.

And we want to take our hat off to Warren Forney. He dislocated his elbow last week and he told me this week, 'coach, there's no ~~way~~ way I'm going to miss this game.' And that's what we've got right now -- a bunch of youngsters who love to play for Clemson.

I think the way you sum this team up right now--they won't quit...they won't go away. They try to stay after you...they play as hard as they can play every week. Some weeks it's been good enough and some weeks it hasn't. But one thing they've done ... they've play hard for 60 minutes for 10 straight weeks

After Coach West talked to the team in the dressing room, he brought back a tradition started by Coach Charlie Pell several years ago -- distributing cigars to the players for its accomplishments -- three boxes altogether.

## PLAYER QUOTES

Will Young

On South Carolina - "This is a big time rivalry. I heard nobody gives a hoot outside of South Carolina, but that's their problem. It's going to be a big game. It will be a good week of preparation, ~~XXXX~~ since we've clinched some sort of bowl bid, it'll make practice that much more fun. It will make us more focused for practice.

On the dousing of Coach West - "He (Coach West) just laughed about it. I thought he was going to try and fight one of us, then he saw Robert (Jackson) and I don't think he was going to fight Robert. I don't think he'd win that one."

Brian Dawkins (Three Interceptions in First Quarter)

"Basically, I was just playing my position. The ball was in the air and it was a jump ball, and I feel like I can go up against almost anybody, so I just played my position. Each time I caught it I just fell down because I said to myself that I wasn't going to drop it, I was going to hold on to it. Having a game like this going into a game against a passing team next week is a good thing. It's a confidence builder. Taneyhill (South Carolina) is a good quarterback, so this was good practice for that.

"It was a tough battle (to get to a bowl), there were a bunch of teams that we had to play well against, especially defensively. A lot of people and teams didn't think we were going to make it, there was even a little doubt in our minds, but I think we showed a lot of maturity in the things we accomplished this year."

Raymond Priester

"I'm just happy I was able to get that many yards today. I only knew I had the record when they announced it. I was shocked when everybody ran over to congratulate me. I was blushing the whole time, it was tremendous. I was concentrating more on getting 1,000 yards for the season, not on this game. We didn't talk to much about the single game."

Duke Head Coach Fred Goldsmith

"Clemson has improved this year. Obviously they are a good football team-- especially on defense. I think what has helped them is going back to an offense that they know. They are set on personnel, and know what they want to do. That confidence gives the other team an offensive threat.

"It was tough playing in that much mud and wind. We played in perilous field conditions. We tried to stick Clemson on their end of the field. However, we are the ones who turned the ball over. We tried to start each half stopping them in the mud, so we would not be in the hole.

"It was the first kicking game we have lost all season. We are starting to learn the fundamentals. We didn't play great but good against a strong football team. I can see the improvement. We got better as the game went on.

"We are a better football team than we were at the beginning of the season. That is all I can ask for. We are improving."
