played with them, especially in the first half. We had a good opportunity there, but we dropped the ball. I feel great about our defense. They played a lot of plays. It wasn't a push and shove game. They (Clemson) ran it right in there. Offensively, we had a hard time keeping them out of the backfield. We had some good plays developing, but by that time they were on us. You have to give their defense credit. "

FURMAN OUTSIDE LINEBACKER BERNARD SCOTT:

"We worked on the out routes all week and were ready for them. He (Clemson QB) tried to throw it over my head.

(On the missed interception) "I got ahead of myself. I was thinking of the touchdown before I had the football."

STATEMENT BY CLEMSON COACH TOMMY WEST

It looked like at first we couldn't stop killing ourselves. Our first efforts resulted in a dropped pass, two missed field goals and interceptions. We're fortunate to get out just giving up a field goal in all of that.

This team was as excited to play today as any I've ever been involved with. We had a good week on the practice field and we came out nothing with right with the offense. But then we came back in the second half, start on the two yard line and got a field goal out of that drive. But after that, we missed another field goal. Obviously, we got problems with the kicking game right now.

On the other hand, I thought our defense played extremely well.

If I had to pick the biggest play of the game, I'd have to say it was the field goal that David (Richardson) kicked because we were becoming a very frustrated team on the sideline. But David nailed the the field goal and this lifted us up.

It seemed that Nealon (Greene) got very tentative, and it seemed that he got where he wouldn't pull the trigger because he was afraid that something bad was going to happen and you can't do that when you are a quarterback. But I thought he came back in the second half and did better with it (the offense).

We had decided going into the game that Brandon (Streeter) would go in (at quarterback) and with the game on the line, that gave him some playing time.

We had hoped to stop their running game = and therein, is where I thought the defense played well. We worked hard to get them in second and long and third and long, and the key to that, I thought we played extremely well on first down,

I was proud of our conditioning and I don't think we had anybody on the field who looked tired. It was hot and our kids played four quarters.

*Clemson's defense set an all-time school record for quarterback sacks with 12 for 70 yards. The previous record was 10, set against Maryland in 1979 (ironically, a game Clemson lost) and against Duke in 1992. The minus 70 yards in sacks was the second largest in Clemson history. The Tigers had 7 sacks for -71 yards against Kentucky in 1982.

*Clemson also set a school record for rushing defense today. Furman had -29 yards rushing in 33 attempts, breaking the school rushing defense record for eight yards.

Furman had just -21 yards rushing against the Tigers in a game in Greenville in 1941.

*Rahim Abdullah tied the Clemson single game sack record with three this afternoon. The freshman became the first Tiger to record three sacks in a game since 1993 when Wardell Rouse had three against Maryland. The other players to do it are Jim Stuckey, Steve Durham, Michael Dean Perry (twice), Chester McGlockton and Brentson Buckner. All of those players are playing, or played in the NFL. Abdullah is the first to do it as a freshman.

*Anthony Simmons had another strong game with eight tackles, four tackles for loss and two sacks. Simmons now has six tackles for loss for the season, he had 11 all of last year. The four tackles for loss is a career high and was just one off the school record of five set by Michael Dean Perry in 1987 vs. N.C. State and by Steve Durham against Maryland in 1979.

*Clemson now has 14 sacks for the season, half the total the team had in 12 games a year ago.

*Raymond Priester gained 118 yards rushing this afternoon, the sixth 100-yard game of his career. He actually has had consecutive 100-yard games in Death Valley. He had a school record 263 yards against Duke in the final home game last year. Priester now has 1817 career yards and needs just 183 to reach the 2,000 mark. He is now 16th in Clemson history in career rushing yardage and is just seven yards away from passing Ronald Williams for the number 15 spot. When he reaches the 2,000-yard mark, Priester will be the 13th player in Clemson history to reach that total.

*Three veteran Tigers had the longest plays of their career. Dexter McCleon's 51-yard punt return was the longest of his career and the longest by a Tiger since Andre Humphrey had a 53-yard punt return against South Carolina in 1993. Kenya Crooks had a 55-yard reception from Nealon Greene, the longest reception of his career by nearly double the yardage (28), and Joe Woods had a 37-yard reception in the first period, the longest reception of his Clemson career. He did have a 51-yard catch as a freshman for Mississippi against Louisiana Tech in 1992.

*Clemson had 10 plays for 95 yards on one drive in the third period that led to a 12-3 lead. Clemson actually had 100 yards in total offense in that drive because Clemson was offside on one of the plays. That tied for the fourth longest drive in Clemson history (or when reviewing all the play by plays available in the Clemson SID office).

*This is the 14th time in the last 21 years that Clemson has started the season 1-1.

*Clemson has now won seven straight games when it wins the turnover margin battle.

*Clemson has now won 26 straight games over Furman, 32 straight over Southern Conference teams and 41 in a row over teams currently in the Southern Conference.

*Clemson honored its Centennial Team today. Of the 35 man team, 22 returned to campus. Of the 13 not here, seven are in the NFL and three are deceased. Many of the players in the NFL and those deceased had representatives attend the weekend ceremonies.

*Clemson had no injuries to report today. Raymond Priester suffered a hyperextended leg early in the game, but gained 98 yards after the injury.

*Clemson has two weeks to prepare for its next game. Clemson has a 15-2 record after an open date since 1978.

*Jim Phillips was back in the broadcast booth for the Tiger network today. He had his streak of 306 straight regular season games stopped last week when a back injury forced him to miss the North Carolina game, his first miss of a regular season game since 1967.
