Clemson vs. Virginia Tech Notes  
Death Valley, Sept. 12, 1998

The 37-0 loss to Virginia Tech marked Clemson's first shutout in Death Valley since Sept. 15, 1979 when Maryland downed the Tigers 19-0. It was the worst loss by shutout since the 1976 season when Georgia defeated Clemson 41-0 in Death Valley. Clemson's worst loss in history in Death Valley was in 1970 when Auburn defeated Clemson 44-0.

\*This was the 11th time in the last 24 seasons that Clemson has been shutout and six of the shutouts have come in the second game of the season. Clemson has a history of struggling in week two. The Tigers have averaged eight wins a year over the last 21 seasons, but are 10-11-1 in the second game of the year during that time. Each of the last three Clemson teams who have been shutout in the second game of the year (1978, 1979 and 1993) have gone on to a bowl game. Clemson was shutout in the opener in 1996, 45-0 at North Carolina, and went on to a bowl game.

\*Clemson plays at Virginia next week on September 19th. Clemson is 8-0 lifetime on September 19th, the only date in history Clemson has an undefeated record (min. 3 games played).

\*Virginia Tech completed just 7-29 passes, a 24.1 completion percentage. That is the best completion percentage defense by the Tigers since the final game of the 1984 season when South Carolina was 6-25, 24 percent. Ironically, Clemson lost that game too, 22-21.

\*The 31 points scored by Virginia Tech in the second period were the most scored against any Clemson team in any quarter in history. The previous high total against Clemson for a quarter was 28, by Tulane in New Orleans in 1946 when the Green Wave had 28 in the third period, and in 1972 when NC State had 28 in the first period against the Tigers in Raleigh.

\*While Antwan Edwards did fumble a punt in the first period, he did have four passes broken up over the last three periods to set a personal best for a single game. Edwards now has 25 PBUs for his career, 10th in Clemson history. Edwards also had a blocked field goal attempt in the game.

The blocked field goal by Antwan Edwards was the second blocked kick of the year for the Tigers, their 19th under Head Coach Tommy West.

\*Clemson linebacker Chris Jones was credited with a career high 12 tackles from the press box. One of the tackles was a caused fumble.

\*DoMarco Fox had two ~~XXXXXX~~ takeaways in a game for the first time in his career. He had a fumble recovery and an interception, both in the second half.

Rahim Abdullah had two tackles for loss, including a sack, and Adrian Dingle had a sack in the contest. Clemson's two defensive end/outside linebackers now have nine tackles for loss through the first two games.

\*Clemson had just 31 yards rushing today, its low total since getting 21 yards against NC State in 1994. The 102 yards of total offense were a low since Clemson had just 91 yards against North Carolina in 1996.

\*Clemson injuries: O.J. Childress suffered a pulled hamstring and is questionable for this week's game with Virginia.

\*While Virginia Tech scored 37 points, Clemson's defense recorded 11 tackles for loss (11 different plays) and the Hokies has 22 incomplete passes. There ~~was~~ were five other plays in which Virginia Tech failed to gain a yard. Thus, on 37 of Virginia Tech's 79 snaps, they failed to gain a yard, or were sent backwards.

\*Clemson led the ACC in fewest penalty yards per game last year, but had 12-116 this afternoon, including 11-101. The last time Clemson had 12 penalties in a game was in 1995 when the Tigers had 12-74 in a loss to Virginia. The last time Clemson had at least 116 yards in penalties was also in 1995, against Wake Forest when the Tigers had 11-120 in a victory at Wake Forest. Those two games (Virginia and Wake Forest, were back to back.

\*The five turnovers today by the Clemson offense were the most by a Tommy West coached team and the most by a Tiger team since 1993 against Virginia, a 23-14 Tiger win.

Obviously, this is a really good win for our program. I'm really proud of our players. We played awfully well.

On offense, Ricky Bustle did a nice job of mixing things up for us. I thought we really had time to throw. Our protection got better as the day went on. If you can play defense and kick the ball well, you can do some good things if you hang in there but I think it goes back to Ricky Bustle and our offensive line.

Streeter is a fine quarterback but it helps if you have the advantage of playing in game situations. He just doesn't have the experience right now but I have nothing but respect for Clemson. I came in here and I leave here with respect for Clemson but I think it was just our day. We feel good about our program.

We got whipped and we got whipped good, including from me on down. I told the team that we've got to accept that we got beat and we have to accept that fact-- there's no getting around it. Now, we've gotta find a way to get better real soon.

I thought that they were a step ahead of us, regardless of what we did, we were just a step slower on everything -- and that completely surprised me.

They wasn't as good as we'd like things to be. And we had a turnover in the kicking game that put them in position to get a touchdown.
