UCF Notes:

Javier Beorlegui's 68-yard punt in the third quarter is a career long for the senior punter/kicker. On the day, Beorlegui unted the ball seven times for an average of 44.3 per punt and pinned the Tigers inside the 20 on three occasions, including once inside the two-yard line.

Beorlegui's second quarter miss from 48-yards, snapped a streak of 10-consecutive field goals made. The streak dated all the way back to last season vs. Akron (Sept. 16, 2000).

Redshirt freshman tailback Alex Haynes was one of several players who saw their first action as a Golden Knight in versus Clemson. Haynes also scored his first career touchdown for UCF as well as the Golden Knights first points of the season on a seven-yard scamper in the second quarter. Haynes finished the game with 11 carries for 26 yards and the touchdown. He also had five catches for 38 yards in his UCF debut.

Sophomore tight end Michael Gaines also saw his first action as a Golden Knight versus Clemson, grabbing his first career catch on a six-yard reception late in the third quarter.

Junior wide out Doug Gabriel also saw his first action for UCF, grabbing his first career reception. Gabriel finished the game with two grabs for 19 yards.

Quarterback Ryan Schneider's was 29-of-47 for 297 yards marking the ninth straight game Schneider has thrown for 250 or more yards. However, today's game marked the first time in Schneider's career that the sophomore QB did not throw a touchdown pass as UCF's starting quarterback. In fact Schneider had thrown for at least two touchdown passes in eight straight games for the Golden Knights.

9/1/01 Clemson vs. Central Florida

University of Central Florida Head Coach Mike Kruczek:

“I think dropped passes and fumbles are part of the first game as well as part of the youth. As far as the pass-dropping; that’s been going on most of the summer. We just have to get better. When you throw the ball as much as we do, you have to come up with those kinds of catches. We can’t on third-down put it on the ground... we have to convert.”

One crucial turn-over down in the red-zone on a fumble on a first-down means points for us. That’s hurt us in the past. It’s something that we’ve worked on and I think we’ve gotten a little better with. The number of turnovers wasn’t as great; but we’ve got to eliminate them completely for us to be a team like Clemson.”

“They came after us a bit with the blitz, and we were throwing our short stuff underneath. We have to come up with catches.”

On the kicking game-

“We’ve got a young team. We put a number of young people on that kick off return (the one that came back on us) to try and sub for the guys that were playing on the segments, and we paid the price for the substitutions. It cost us field position.”

On Clemson’s fake field goal-

“I’ve never had that happen; I have to revisit what happened. That should never happen. The defense did their job, they did a great job of bending but not breaking against this ‘great offense’. It was just the special teams that let us down a little bit today.”

“We’d seen it (the trick play) in the past and we had it in the back of our minds that they might play it. We had a guy spying on him, I don’t know what happened, I couldn’t see from my angle.”

On Woody Dantzler-

“Dantzler as we all know has these organizational qualities that are as good as anyone who has ever played the game. He broke it ten a few times and made some big plays. But we knew that he was going to make his plays- we had to minimize those plays and I think we did.

Coach Bowden Post-game Quotes

Overall feelings on the game: "We prepared the team for a sixty-minute game, and that's pretty much what it was. If you look at Central Florida's history, whether it be Nebraska, Alabama, Auburn, Florida State, Georgia, Georgia Tech, Ole Miss, they were pretty much true to tune. They come in, have a couple big games a year; they're well coached. They have good skill guys. They had a great plan."

On the fake field goal and Jeff Scott: "Brad Scott and Ron West pretty much do that. That's kind of their area. Jeff Scott did a good job. He has brilliant speed that he inherited from his father. He runs like his mother. That was a big play; it might have been the winning touchdown. That's a scholarship well-invested. Brad Scott and Ron West pretty much schemed that. They have a tendency all year to do that. We planned to run our second field goal, but the timing was right for the first. [Jeff Scott] is a typical coach's son. He studies the game; he knows what to look for and how to look for it."

On taking risks: "I don't have a problem with it. I don't think I can be described as conservative, even though we were ranked tenth in the nation in rushing last year. People think it's pretty much a pass-happy offense and that we throw it 28, 29, 30 times a game, and would like to run the ball. But if there are opportunities in the kicking game by fakes off field goals and punts, I think it's a part of the game that should not be neglected as far as trickery and deception."

On game situations: "I don't know if ever in my career I've had to bring the ball off the six-inch-line twice in one half. The second half we had the ball on the six, and we punched out, and usually it's three and a punt. So there are a lot of things we need to correct on offense and a lot of things we need to work on. But you look at that field position that we had a lot during the game, the percentage of scoring from the six-inch-line, going 99 yards, the Baltimore Ravens can't hardly do that. Twice we knocked it out, once maybe to the 35-yard-line, and then maybe to the 50, completely changed the field position, took time off the clock."

On the youth of the team: "Derrick Hamilton, a redshirt freshman, made a key catch. Ben Hall, true freshman, Roscoe Crosby, a true freshman, there's still a lot of youth out there on the field we're having to depend on to win games for us and make plays. Hopefully in a couple years we won't have to do that. We're still at the recruiting stage where we're going out there to sign guys that are possibly a little bit better than what we already have here."

Clemson vs. UCF Notes

*Clemson played five first-year freshmen in the game. The list included Roscoe Crosby, who started at wide receiver and caught a Utah pass from Woodrow Dantzler on the first offensive play of the game. The play was good for a 12-yard gain and a first down. Bowden said after the game that he had promised Crosby he would run with the ball on the first play of the season. Other first-year freshmen to play in the game were wide receiver Airese Currie, tight end Ben Hall, defensive end Moe Fountain and star safety Eric Sampson. Crosby was the first first-year freshman to start on a scrimmage play in the first game since 1995 when Anthony Simmons started the first game of the season at linebacker. He is the first offensive player to start the first game of the season as a first-year freshman since 1994 when Anthony Downs started at tailback. *It didn't take Crosby long to lead the Tigers in a statistical category. The freshman from Union had 64 yards receiving in the game.

*Woodrow Dantzler had 46 yards rushing in today's game and became Clemson's career rushing leader by a quarterback with 1746 yards. He broke the record of 1737 by held by Steve Fuller (1975-78). Dantzler is now 19th on Clemson's career rushing list. The graduate student had 154 yards passing and now has 3613 for his career, sixth on the Clemson list. He moved ahead of his former teammate, Brandon Streeter, on the Clemson career list. He will need just 31 yards passing next week against Wofford to move ahead of Homer Jordan, who had 3643. Dantzler had an even 200 yards of total offense and now has 5359 for his career. He needs 152 against Wofford to move ahead of Rodney Williams into third place on Clemson's career total offense list.

*Travis Zachery rushed for 48 yards in 15 attempts and moved over 2500 for his career. He is now fifth in Clemson history in career rushing with 2530 yards. He will need 42 yards next week to move into fourth place on the Clemson career list. Zachery scored the 40th touchdown of his Clemson career on a five-yard reception from Dantzler. It was his seventh receiving touchdown as a Tiger.

*Brian Mance had nine tackles to lead the Tigers according to stats from the press box. It was a career high. The tackle totals will be adjusted after the coaches grade the films on Sunday.

*Braxton K. Williams had two caused fumbles in today's game. He was the first Clemson player to record two caused fumbles in the same game since Tony DeSue had two against NC State in 1996.

*Clemson has now won 15 of its last 18 season openers. The Tigers are now 77-16-8 all time in home openers and 80-19-8 in overall openers.

*Clemson will attempt to go 2-0 next week against Wofford. The Tigers opened 8-0 last year. However, the Tigers have been 2-0 just three times in the last 11 years.

*While Clemson scored just 21 points in today's game, it marked just the second time since 1993 that Clemson had scored at least 20 points and won the game in its first game against a Division I team. Last year the Tigers defeated Missouri 62-9 in its first game of the season against a Division I team. Prior to that you have to go back to 1993, a 24-14 win over UNLV, to find the last time Clemson scored at least 20 points and won in its first game against a Division I team.

*Holder Jeff Scott had a 22-yard rush for a touchdown off a fake field goal, a play that proved to be the deciding touchdown. It was Scott's first career touchdown, but his third career rush on a fake field goal. He now has 3 career rushes for 40 yards.

*Woodrow Dantzler is now 36 for 49 in his career (passing) in the season opener.
