Clemson head coach Tommy Bowden

On getting the big win:

It was the first time with five minutes to go that I could actually take the headset off and enjoy an afternoon. Some people get to do it and we have done it here before, but we haven't done it in about a year and a half.

On the team's mental preparation for the game.

I think we did a really good job of getting the team prepared mentally. You try to think of ways to motivate and prepare them to peak on Saturday. I saw our team prepared themselves well, I am really proud of our senior leadership and our players really responded. We played a conference team on the road and got a good win.

On the improvisation of Charlie Whitehurst:

We have a guy who can make plays. Sometimes he scrambled and made a play. A lot times plays break down. Eighty-85 plays in a game and not all of them will go like they are drawn up on the board. If they move when the ball is snapped and then have a guy scramble out and make plays its like having a great tailback take a four-yard run for 60 or 70 yards or having a wideout taking a five-yard hitch 60 or 70 yards.

On what the win means:

It means a lot to the team. They work extremely hard and to get a sixth win with two games to left against two real good opponents. The team wanted to win the game real bad. They practiced hard this week and came to the game prepared really well mentally.

On the balanced effort:

I thought our special teams played solid, I thought our defense played solid and offense solid too. It was our most balanced performance.

On getting two, 100-yard rushers in one game:

You have to credit our offensive line, tight ends included and full backs in that I-formation. Tommy Sharpe looked like he did a pretty productive job along with Gary Byrd, Greg Walker, William Henry, Cedric Johnson and all those guys.

North Carolina Head Coach John Bunting

There's not much to say, except there are a few ballgames left. Today was a game I really thought we would win, but I say that all the time anyway.

We didn't make enough plays to get it done. We had a chance with a couple of big plays in the first half.

There were some better things that happened this week than have happened the previous two weeks, and that's a very, very small silver lining. That's what I'm going to grasp onto and hold onto. When I took this football program over, I knew it wouldn't be easy. I also didn't know it was going to be this hard, but at the same time, I have met challenges before in my life. I said this was going to be a real big one this year, and right now it's very frustrating to me, and I'm sure it's very frustrating to all the folks who support Carolina. I'm asking them to try to be patient and help me help this football program and this football team. And I thank them all for their support.

I think that the coaches, when we look at the videotape, are going to see a whole bunch of things we did well today. And there's a whole bunch of things we don't do well, we fail to do to win a football game like this.

On the final series of the first half:

We don't move the ball then. I thought we were in a two-minute drill. We work that two-minute drill every week, and I thought we would move it and we would go down and score. I felt good about that. And of course they complete a jump ball down there and it's a reversal of fortunes. We need to go out there and start the second half with a great defensive stand, and we kind of just give it to them – penalties and big plays now we're down. And now it's a tough ball game, a real tough ball game. What was a close ball game has turned into a real tough ballgame, and we've got to really make some big plays now.

You can talk about the young defense, (but) you've got some players out there on the offensive line playing too. Those guys are now under duress.

On Clemson QB Charlie Whitehurst:

He is a tremendous athlete. He's fast, he's quick, he made a lot of plays running the football against Duke last week. Do I think he's elusive? He's good enough to make plays running on the perimeter. We did not do a very good job on about two or three occasions getting him pulled up outside. We had pressure coming on the inside and he escapes to the outside. It's something that should not ever happen. If you pressure inside, the people that are responsible for guaranteeing containment don't get their job done, he's outside and it's a big play. That was a discipline error, on that one particular play. He is a talented guy, believe me.

On not winning a game at home:

It's about as tough as it gets – real, real bad. Real bad feeling. I don't know how to describe it any worse than that. I don't know how to come up with any words other than the worst that's ever been, than I've ever felt.

Clemson vs. North Carolina Notes November 9, 2002

*Clemson quarterback Charlie Whitehurst threw four touchdown passes for the second consecutive game. He tied the single game Clemson record for the second straight game. You don't have to go back very far, however to find the last time a Clemson QB threw for scoring passes in consecutive games. Woody Dantzler did it against Duke and Louisiana Tech, the last two games of his Clemson career last year.

*This is the second consecutive trip to Chapel Hill that a Clemson quarterback has thrown for four TD passes in a game. Willie Simmons did it in a reserve role in Kenan Stadium in 2000 in a Clemson 38-24 victory.

*Charlie Whitehurst has now thrown for 694 yards over the last two games. That is the most passing yards in consecutive games in Clemson history. He threw for 420 last week at Duke, a Clemson single game record.

*Whitehurst has now won his first two starts as a freshman QB. The last Clemson freshman quarterback to win his first two games as a starter is Dexter McCleon, who defeated South Carolina and Kentucky (Peach Bowl) in 1993 in his first two and only two starts as a Clemson QB. He played defensive back the rest of his career and is now in the NFL with the St. Louis Rams.

*Clemson running back Chad Jasmin caught three passes for 47 yards and two touchdowns. He had just 3-27 receiving all year entering this game. Jasmin caught a scoring pass at NC State last year from Woody Dantzler. Thus, Jasmin has three career touchdown catches and all have come in the Tar Heel State. Jasmin is the first Clemson running back to catch two touchdown passes in the same game since 1986 when Terrence Flagler caught two scoring passes at Wake Forest.

*Clemson running backs Bernard Rambert (19-106) and Tye Hill (14-105) both had over 100 yards rushing today. It is the first time since 1996 at Virginia that Clemson has had two running backs rush for over 100 yards in the same game. Kelton Dunnican and Raymond Priester did it that day. Clemson did have a pair of 100-yard rushers against Duke last year, as Woody Dantzler and Travis Zachery turned the trick. But, Dantzler was a quarterback in the Clemson attack.

*Clemson head coach Tommy Bowden has now won seven straight road games in the state of North Carolina. He is 2-0 at Wake Forest, 2-0 at Duke and now 2-0 at North Carolina. He won last year at NC State 45-37. His only loss in the Tar Heel state came in 1999 at NC State, a 35-31 defeat. The coach who defeated him was Mike O'Cain, his current quarterback coach.

*Clemson head coach Tommy Bowden is now 10-6 in ACC road games and 9-6 in ACC home games as Clemson head coach.

*The 83-yard scoring pass from Charlie Whitehurst to Airese Currie was the third longest pass play in Clemson history and the longest pass completion in the history of Kenan Stadium. It was the longest pass play by a Clemson duo since 1978 when Steve Fuller threw a 87-yard scoring pass to Jerry Butler at Maryland. Ironically, it was Butler who spoke to the team prior to last Thursday's practice. He was in town scouting the Tigers for the Cleveland Browns.

*Whitehurst threw two scoring passes of at least 40 yards in the first half, giving him four scoring passes for at least 40 yards over a three-quarter period. He threw two in the fourth period of that distance in the fourth period of the win over Duke. Clemson had just six passes of 40 yards or more in 35 quarters prior to his recent streak.

*Charlie Whitehurst is now 46-72 for 694 yards with eight touchdowns and no interceptions over his two games as a starter.

*Clemson's defense held North Carolina to 244 yards of total offense, the fifth time this year Clemson has held the opposition under 300 yards. Clemson did not keep the opposition under 300 yards in any game last season.

*Justin Miller had his fifth interception of the season in the first half. It is the most interceptions in a season by a Clemson first year freshman since 1989 when Robert O'Neal had a school record eight thefts.

*Clemson had six sacks as a team by six different players today. That was a season high in that category, the most since Clemson had six sacks in the win over Louisiana Tech in the Humanitarian Bowl to close last season. Nick Eason recorded his seventh sack of the year, the most sacks in a season by a Clemson defensive tackle since Trevor Pryce had 7.5 during the 1996 season.

*Donnell Washington and Rodney Thomas both recorded their first sacks of the season.

*Clemson was 0-4 on third down in the first half and 8-8 in the second half. Clemson gained a season high 530 yards of total offense. The Tigers are now 43-0-1 in history when gaining at least 500 yards of total offense. The Tigers had at least 200 yards rushing and 200 yards passing in the same game. Clemson is now 2-0 this year and 40-0-1 in history when gaining at least 200 of each.
