Turnovers

Bowden: We had those three turnovers by Derrick Hamilton, Charlie Whitehurst and that one to David Pollack, that they converted into points.

Expectations

Bowden: I thought we would be a little more productive offensively. The defense kept us in the game. We had some chances early on in the fourth quarter, but couldn't capitalize. The defense just ran out of gas.

Attitude for the next couple days

Bowden: We can play better. We're a good team. This gives us a challenge. There's a lot of football left, a lot of room for improvement.

Young Players

Bowden: It was good to get them some playing time. We're going to need them later on in the season. It was good to get them some work.

Running Game

Bowden: Well, we were trying. It's just hard once you're down and there are a bunch of guys coming at you. We had to throw to play catch up.

Off Day Sunday

Bowden: It gives them a chance to reflect on the game, but it also gives the staff time to watch tapes and figure out what we need to do to improve.

Clemson Player Post-Game Quotes Georgia game

Running back Duane Coleman:

“A 30-0 loss makes you very angry. We’ve just got to hopefully keep that anger in and go out there next Saturday (against Furman) and do something big.

“We worked on the running game all spring, and I had hoped it was going to be a big part of the game today. Unfortunately, it wasn’t. I don’t know what we can say about it.

On the fourth-and-two throwback pass...

“I saw Charlie open and I just tried to lob it up and give a guy that is 6’5” a chance to go get it. I believe it was pass interference, but we don’t get everything to go our way.”

Quarterback Charlie Whitehurst:

“It was a tough loss. We didn’t think it would end up like that, and we expected to be in the game at the end. But, we turned it over three times, penalties hurt us down in the redzone, and we just didn’t execute.

“When it was 16-0, we were down there and probably should have had a touchdown or two under our belt if I could just execute. I don’t think they’re in a different league than us, but we need to learn how to win. They’ve learned how to win and have won every close game, but we just have to learn how.

“It’s a tough loss, but there’s still a lot of football to be played. Leadership is good and our unity is good. We’ve just got to stick together.”

Georgia Post-Game Notes Vs. Clemson...Aug. 30, 2003

*Georgia moves to 9-0 on opponent's home field under head coach Mark Richt. The Bulldogs post a season-opening shutout for the first time since 1991 (d. W. Carolina 48-0 in Athens) and their first season-opening shutout on the road since 1954 when they beat Florida State 14-0 in Tallahassee. Prior to today, the last Bulldogs shutout came during the 2000 season against New Mexico State (37-0 in Athens). Georgia was missing four projected starters on defense due to injury today.

*Scoreless Quarters: Georgia kept the Tigers off the scoreboard today, a hallmark for the Bulldogs under defensive coordinator Brian VanGorder. Last season, Georgia shut out five opponents in the first half and two in the second half. Overall, the Bulldogs ranked third nationally in 2002 with 29 scoreless quarters by the defense. This was the first shutout for the Bulldogs under head coach Mark Richt and his staff.

*Georgia has now won its opener seven straight seasons and moves to 83-24-3 overall including 16-9-2 on the road. Today marked Georgia's first season opener on the road since 1994. The Bulldogs take a 41-17-4 lead in the series with Clemson including 7-2 in season openers versus the Tigers. Georgia has won the last five meetings. This was the first shutout of the Tigers since 1978 when the Bulldogs won 12-0 in Athens. Prior to today, Georgia last blanked Clemson here in 1976 (41-0).

*Junior QB David Greene improves to 22-5 as a starter. He went 12-for-17 with 203 yards and 1 TD to earn ABC Chevrolet MVP of the Game honors.

*For the second time in as many seasons and against Clemson, the first time junior FLK Fred Gibson touched the football he scored a TD. Today, he caught a 56-yard TD pass from David Greene. Last season, he returned a kickoff 91 yards for a TD. Gibson finished today with four catches for 104 yards and 1 TD.

*Senior PK Billy Bennett scored 12 points today to move up to third in Bulldog history with 290 points. He passed PK Kanon Parkman who had 282. PK Kevin Butler (353 pts. from 1981-84) and TB Herschel Walker (314 pts. from 1980-82) rank the top two in the record book.

*Junior DE David Pollack snagged his 3rd career interception today. Last year, he had one against South Carolina (for a TD) in Columbia and one against Florida in Jacksonville. Georgia converted the INT today into a TD for a 23-0 advantage.

*Georgia went 3-for-5 in the Red Zone with a pair of field goals and a TD. A bad snap on a field goal attempt resulted in turning it over on downs as did a failed 4th and 2 attempt at the CU 3-yard line on the opening possession of the second half.

*Projected starting snapper sophomore Brian Jordan did not make the trip for today's game due to a one-game suspension. Therefore, redshirt freshman Daniel Inman (ST) served as the snapper on field goals and extra points while redshirt freshman Joe Tereshinski (QB) handled the snaps on punts.

*Points off Turnovers: Georgia got 13 points off three Tiger turnovers on the day.

*First Time Starters: On offense, Daniel Inman (ST), Russ Tanner (C) and Bartley Miller (TG); Marcus Jackson (DT), Arnold Harrison (SLB), Derrick White (MLB). Harrison caused a fumble in the first half that led to a Bulldog field goal. On a related note for "firsts," senior TE Robert Brannon had his first two catches of his career.

*True Freshman: A total of five freshman made their Bulldog debut. They were Tra Battle (DB), Nick Jones (C), Jarvis Jackson (LB), Sean Bailey (FLK) and Leonard Pope (TE).

*Junior RB Ronnie Powell posted career-highs with 17 carries for 54 yards. He saw the most action behind starter Tony Milton (14 rushes for 53 yds today. Powell came in with 11 carries for 28 yards and 1 TD in his career.

- Airese Currie established a career high in receptions today with seven (for 56 yards). He actually reached that total in the first half of the game. His previous career high was 5-59 yards against North Carolina during his freshman year, 2001. He did not establish a career high for reception yards. He had 90 at North Carolina last year on two catches.
- Leroy Hill led Clemson in tackles in today's game with 13. It marks the second time in his career that he has led Clemson in tackles. He had 11 to lead the Tigers in a victory over Duke in 2001, his first-year freshman season. Hill also had a career high three tackles for loss in the game.
- Clemson was shutout today by Georgia by a 30-0 score. It was the first time Clemson has been shutout in the Tommy Bowden era, the first shutout for any Clemson team since October 17, 1998 when Florida State defeated Clemson 48-0 in Tallahassee. It was the first time Clemson has been shut out at home since September 12, 1998 when Virginia Tech defeated Clemson in the second game of the season, 37-0.
- Clemson played the following first-year freshmen in the game: Brandon Pilgrim (OG), Marion Dukes (OT), Jad Dean (PK).
- The following red-shirt freshmen played in a game for the first time at Clemson: Dustin Fry (LT), Dustin Fry ©, Nathan Bennett (OG), Chansi Stuckey (QB), Cole Chason (P), Reggie Merriweather (RB), Kelvin Grant (WR), Anthony Waters (LB), Gerald McCloud (ROV), Buddy Williams (Special teams), Gaines Adams (Special Teams)
- The following players made their first ever start for Clemson: Nathan Bennett (OG), Duane Coleman (TB), DeJuan Polk (DT), J.J. Howard (DE), Leroy Hill (LB), Jamaal Fudge (ROV), Travis Pugh (FS),
- Clemson did not force a turnover on defense today. It was just the second time in the 14 games John Lovett has been defensive coordinator that Clemson failed to force a turnover. The other occasion was at Florida State last year when Clemson committed four on offense and failed to force one on defense.
- Today's attendance of 83,000 was the largest for a home opener in Clemson history. The previous record was 81,482 when Clemson opened the 2001 season against Central Florida.
- Punter Cole Chason had a 41.3-yard punting average today. He allowed just 12 punt return yards on his six attempts for a 39.3 net punting average. Clemson did not have a gross punting average game of over 40yards all of last year and never had a net punting figure over 39 yards all of last season.
- Kevin Youngblood had three catches for 24 yards. He has now caught at least one pass in 16 straight games dating to the 2000 South Carolina game.
- Derrick Hamilton had 65 yards all-purpose running today and now has 3169 for his career. He moved ahead of Kenny Flowers (3146) and Ray Matthews (3128) into fourth place on Clemson's career list for that category. Next on the list is Buddy Gore (3273).
- Aaron Hunt's Clemson record for consecutive games scoring at least one point was broken today. Hunt had scored at least one point in every game he had played in his Clemson career entering today's game, a streak of 36 in a row. He did not score last year against NC State, but he did not play in that game either. He did appear in today's game and missed a 52-yard field goal attempt.
