Scott Wells, C: "Basically, we couldn't get anything going offensively. My hat's off to Clemson. They had an excellent game plan for us. For our offense, they brought a lot of things for us. They had an excellent offensive scheme. We were able to move the ball several times passing it, but weren't able execute in the Orange Zone. They did an excellent job. It seemed like they always brought more guys than we had blockers. We didn't perform as well as we did in practice."

Constantin Ritzmann, DE: "I don't think we lost our poise. Overall, we played hard. You want to end your career on a high note. If you look back, we really came together as a team. Clemson did a good job of throwing some things at us we haven't seen. They came out with some formations where we expected pass but they ran. He threw the ball quickly, but often we were right there. They went deep in their playbook and ran some things we've never seen."

Casey Clausen, QB: "Obviously it's a disappointing end (to the season and the seniors' careers). I told the guys before the game to have fun and do the best they could. Charlie Whitehurst:

"This was a great team win. The offense won the game in the first half and the defense won the game in the second half.

"This is a terrific win for our program. Tennessee was a top 10 team, our second top 10 win in the last four games. We did something only the National Championship team did at Clemson. It was been a great season.

"You can't say enough about the job Chad Jasmin did. A senior in his last game, he ran so hard at the end of this season. He was a difference maker.

Leroy Hill

"We are a team that likes to play defense against a I-back team. It is just easier for us because we are an aggressive attacking defense. The teams with misdirection give us the problems. I said earlier in the week that Tennessee reminds me of Florida State because of the way they play offense.

"It feels good to be on top in this game. We played hard, we practiced hard.

"Coach Lovett made some adjustments at halftime and it made a difference. They came out in some different formations that gave us problems in the first half. But, we made them one dimensional. They like to run the ball more and we took that away from them.

"This is a great way to end my career. It really is a dream to get my first 100 yard game in my last game. But, it was a team effort all the way. What a job by our defense in the second half.

"I was confident we could run on them. Our line has really improved over the course of the season.

"I sure feel good about the state of this program as I leave. We beta the number-six team in the nation. Tennessee is an outstanding team, one of the best defenses in the nation and we got the job done. It is a great feeling as I walk out after my last college game.

### Clemson notes

\*This is Clemson's second win over a top 10 team this year, as Tennessee was sixth entering the game and Florida State was third. This is the first time since the 1981 National Championship season that Clemson has beaten two top 10 teams in the same season. Clemson defeated three top 10 teams that year, including fourth ranked Nebraska in the Orange Bowl. That is the only other time Clemson has defeated more than one top 10 team in the same year.

\*This was Clemson's 50<sup>th</sup> all-time victory over an AP top 25 team.

\*Clemson finished the season with just six lost fumbles, NONE by running backs.

\*Clemson had six sacks in tonight's game, a season high.

\*Charlie Whitehurst went over the 5000 yard passing mark this evening with his 246 yards passing. He became just the second ACC quarterback in history to go over the 5000 yard passing mark by the end of his sophomore year. Phillip Rivers, who just finished his career at NC State, is the only other ACC quarterback to accomplish that feat.

\*Toure Francis, Justin Miller and Charles Bennett all had their first career sacks in Clemson's victory.

\*Chad Jasmin had a career high 130 yards rushing in his final game as a Clemson running back. He had a 31-yard run during the game that was also the longest of his career. A 23-yard run his freshman year was his previous best. He also averaged a career high 8.7 yards per rush. It was just the second 100-yard rushing game by a Clemson player this year, and the most rushing yards by a Clemson player in a game since Woody Dantzler (who was at the game on the Clemson sidelines) had 135 yards rushing against Duke in his final home game at Clemson in 2001. It was the most yards rushing by a Clemson running back since Travis Zachery had 151 yards rushing against Maryland in 2000.

\*Derrick Hamilton became Clemson's career reception leader in this victory. He had five catches to give him 167 for his career, one more than Rod Gardner had between 1997-00. Gardner was at the game this evening. Hamilton still has another year to play.

\*Over the last four games of the season Tommy Bowden defeated the #2 winningest active coach in Phillip Fulmer, the #4 winningest active coach in Bobby Bowden, and the #11 winningest active coach in Lou Holtz.

\*This was Clemson's first win over Tennessee since 1919. The Tigers had lost seven in a row to the Volunteers.

\*Derrick Hamilton had 69 receiving yards, moving him over 1000 yards for the season. He finished the season with 1026. He is just the second Clemson player to reach 1000 yards receiving in a season. Rod Gardner is the other.

\*Kyle Browning scored a touchdown on his only rush of the night, an 8-yard run on the "Panther Play." This is the third time Clemson has used this play since Tommy Bowden has been at Clemson and the Tigers have scored a touchdown all three times. In 2001 Clemson used the play against Virginia and Terrance Huey scored on a 16-yard run. Later that year in the Humanitarian Bowl, Airese Currie scored on a 19-yard run on the play in Boise, ID against Louisiana Tech. Browning made it three in a row this evening.

\*Clemson established a school record for total offense and first downs in a season this evening. Clemson ended the year with 5,467 yards and 303 first downs.

\*Kevin Youngblood finished the year with an even 70 receptions, tied for the second highest figure in Clemson history.

\*This was just the 11<sup>th</sup> victory over a top 10 team in Clemson history. It was the third under Tommy Bowden. His other top 10 wins took place in 2001 at ninth ranked Georgia Tech and this year against a third ranked Florida State. Clemson's wins over Florida State (3<sup>rd</sup>) and Tennessee (6<sup>th</sup>) represent the first and fourth highest ranked wins in Clemson history.

\*Cole Chason had a higher punting average than All-American Dustin Colquitt this evening, something Bowden announced to the team in the locker room after the game. His 42.0 average tonight, included a 41.5 net figure. It was just his fifth game this year in which he averaged at least 40 yards a punt.

\*The team that scored first won every Clemson game this year. Clemson was 9-0 when it scored first and 0-4 when it didn't

\*Derrick Hamilton's 58-yard punt return in the first half was the longest in Clemson history in a bowl game. It broke the record of 47 yards by Billy Davis against Nebraska in 1981. Davis was at the game this evening.

\*Chad Jasmin's 130 yards rushing were the most in a bowl game by a Clemson running back since the 1996 season when Raymond Priester had 151 yards rushing against LSU in the Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl.

### Clemson Coach Bowden Quotes:

“In any situation, any game you enter, especially after a layoff, you never know what the players’ response will be. The seniors kept the team’s focus and attention, especially over the last week. The fan support has been tremendous; they have really supported us. The players, coaches and support staff have had a great time at the Chick-Fil-A Peach Bowl and look forward to returning as many times as the Bowl Committee invites us.

“This is a good win to have over the sixth-ranked team in the country. Tennessee has had substantial success under Philip Fulmer and this game shows us we are heading in the right direction.

“We executed well today. The coaches prepared us well and the players did what they needed to do. One of the keys to this game was the fact that when Tennessee scored and we answered, and then we scored and it was not answered, that gave us confidence. When the run is there, we must take advantage of that opportunity, and the line did a good job. Stopping Tennessee and having success early were also an important piece of the puzzle tonight. It was important to set the tempo early in the game. There will always be momentum changes, and we needed to establish credibility early.

“Tennessee is a good defensive team, and their defense had a lot of momentum late in the season and leading into this game. Our defense really set the tone tonight. The players concentrated well, the coaches had an excellent plan and we executed well. The offense also executed well and followed the preparation and game plan.

“Chad Jasmin found the holes, and sometimes simply ran over players, and I think that was a little demoralizing for Tennessee. Jasmin also motivated the team – he is a fifth-year guy that came out and played hard. He and Leroy Hill are always tough. Hill led the team in tackles as a freshman. Even though they played tough tonight, I do not think they have gotten tougher – they have always been that way.

“Before the game, I told Cole Chason (Clemson’s starting punter) not to get us beat. He was going against an All-American punter, certainly one of the best in the nation. Cole Chason did more than not get us beat, he changed the field position which was very important.”

**Tennessee Coach Fulmer Quotes:** “I congratulate Clemson. They did a great job with what they do. We worked hard and prepared well. I thought we were ready to play. Clemson made some plays and we helped them with four or five major penalties in the second half. We helped them a lot and that’s my responsibility.

“They made some plays at receiver and ran the ball better than I thought they would. The sacks go with protection. They come with one more than you have. We must have missed four or five. They made the plays when we brought people.

“The penalty in the end zone was on one of our players for unsportsmanlike conduct. Whatever happened, I wasn’t there. On the penalties, you have to hope you have better control. I wasn’t on the side where either of the penalties on Kevin Burnett was. The late hit on the quarterback was close. You want your guys to be aggressive.

“James Banks was suspended for the first half for violation of team rules. It happened before we left Knoxville.

“I appreciate the seniors for what they’ve done. They won the East twice and had two 10-win seasons. They left a good legacy with their work and leadership. After the break, we’ll go back to work in the weight room. New leadership will emerge and we’ll build for the future. We have a good-looking young team coming back.

“Casey had a phenomenal game. He made a lot of key throws. He scrambled effectively and ran the two-minute offense well. He is what a quarterback should be, competitive, has the ability and arm strength and can see the field. He does it all.

“We thought that, with a veteran quarterback and the emerging receivers, we could take advantage. At times, we did. There were key plays we didn’t make.”
