◆ CHAMPS SPORTS BOWL, Florida Citrus Stadium, Orlando, Fla. (December 27, 2005)

QUICKLY... CU drops a 19-10 decision to No. 23 Clemson, finishing 0-4 against ranked teams for the year; it was the ninth straight setback to ranked opponents, and marked the first time since the 1979 to 1985 seasons where CU went more than one year without beating a ranked foe... This loss will officially count toward **Gary Barnett's** record at Colorado; he thus finishes with a **49-39** record in seven seasons... **QB Joel Klatt** was not cleared to play, but served as the conduit between offensive coordinator **Shawn Watson** in the press box and the sideline, sending in the plays via messenger... 56 players saw action tonight for the Buffaloes, including **OG/DT John Guydon** for just the second time this year on offense... CU sold 580 tickets and used just over 1,400 of its 12,000 allotment (the Big 12 absorbs the cost of the unsold tickets).

SCORING STREAKS. CU added to its school record consecutive games scoring streak, as the Buffs have now scored in **210** straight games dating back to a 7-0 loss at Nebraska in 1988. That streak is the **sixth** longest in the nation and the 13th longest all-time; CU has now also scored in all **27** of its bowl games in its history.

SEASON TRENDS... Here are some updated key trends in Colorado football for 2005:

- ◆ 7-1 when owning advantage in average field position
- ◆ 7-1 when owning the edge in turnover margin
- ◆ 4-2 when committing fewer than 10 penalties
- ◆ 0-5 when allowing 100-plus yards rushing
- ◆ 1-6 when trailing at halftime

BOWL TRENDS... Colorado is 12-15 all-time in its 27 bowl appearances. Here's a look at some won-lost trends:

- ◆ versus ranked teams 9-10
- ◆ versus a higher ranked team 3-9
- ◆ -versus ranked team as an unranked team 2-2
- ◆ when scoring 13 or fewer points 1-7
- ◆ when coming from behind (from the start) 2-9
- ◆ when trailing at halftime (0-2 when tied) 3-9
- ◆ with two or fewer turnovers (2-1 with zero) 8-8
- ◆ when playing at night (5 p.m. or later start) 3-6

LOOOOOOONG... The 68-yard punt by **John Torp** in the first quarter set a Colorado bowl record; he technically broke his own record (his first punt was 63), but coming in the record was 62, held by both **Mitch Berger** ('93 Fiesta) and **Nick Pietsch** ('98 Aloha). Torp's 49.7 average on nine kicks was the third best bowl performance by a CU punter; he owns the second as well (4-50.0 against UTEP in the '04 Houston Bowl); Pietsch set the mark against Oregon (51.5 on six punts).

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL... Colorado is now turnover-free for its last 10 bowl quarters, not committing a turnover in back-to-back bowl games for the first time in its history. CU's last came in the second quarter of the 2002 Alamo Bowl (Robert Hodge interception against Wisconsin).

PICK CITY... Colorado now has at least one interception in its last 13 bowl games, extended this evening when **S Tyrone Henderson** picked off a pass in the second quarter. The streak started in the '91 Orange Bowl when CU defeated Notre Dame, 10-9, to win the consensus national championship; **FS Greg Thomas** had two interceptions with a third by **CB Deon Figures** as time expired to seal the victory. Only one player

since Thomas has had multiple picks in a game—**S Tom Hubbard** swiped a pair in last year's Houston Bowl against Texas-El Paso.

CU INJURIES... Only two injuries of significance occurred in-game, but both players returned: **CB Gerett Burl** (mild concussion) and **OG Brian Daniels** (turf toe). For the record, **QB Joel Klatt** has continued to show erratic symptoms from his concussion sustained December 3 against Texas, and would still be days away from being cleared if CU had another game.

DEFENSE... The 19 points allowed by Colorado were the fewest since a 38-6 win over Oregon in the '96 Cotton Bowl (11 seasons ago), and were the fifth fewest in 27 bowls.

RUSHING... The Buffaloes rushed for **347** yards in its 62-28 drubbing of Boston College in the 1999 Insight.com Bowl; in four bowl games since, CU has managed just **346** yards on the ground, just 17 tonight. The opponent has been held under 200 yards rushing 10 straight bowls, but Clemson **TB James Davis** ran for 150, the first back to top 100 against CU this season; the last to do it was Oklahoma's Adrian Peterson in the 2004 Big 12 Championship game (28-172).

LINER NOTES... Assorted liner notes from tonight's game:

- **QB Brian White (12-7-0, 81, 1 TD).** This was his first extensive action, as he entered with just one career pass attempt (which he completed for 10 yards against Oklahoma State in 2004). He had seen action in just one game this season (mop-up, no passes).
- **DT James Garee.** His blocked PAT kick was his second block of the season; he blocked a field goal against New Mexico State to preserve CU's shutout.
- CU had **12** possessions—the first 11 ended with a kick: nine punts, one field goal, one PAT; the 12th ended when the game expired.
- **Offensive Low.** The 124 yards by Colorado was its second lowest ever in a bowl; as CU mustered just 55 in its first bowl ever, a 28-14 loss to Rice in the '38 Cotton. It was the sixth time CU was held under 200 yards. The 17 rushing yards were also the second fewest, trailing the

minus-11 against Alabama in the '91 Blockbuster Bowl—the former site of this very contest; thus, the Buffs

have 59 rushes for 6 yards in this particular bowl franchise. Ouch.



Colorado Buffalo Football / Postgame Notes

COMEBACK... Colorado rallied from 11 points down (3-14), its second largest comeback in the postseason. The Buffs trailed Washington 14-0 before rallying to win the 1996 Holiday Bowl, 33-21.

SECOND HALF... The Buffs outgained UTEP by exactly two-to-one (294-147) in the second half, in addition to forcing all three UTEP turnovers (converting into 10 points).

BARNETT... Gary Barnett tops off his sixth season in Boulder with an 8-5 record, improving to **42-33** overall, the second most he has been over .500 (he was 31-21 at one point). He is now 77-78-2 in 15 years as Division I-A head coach.

BOWL WINS OVER LAST 15 YEARS... Colorado moved into sole possession of **fourth** when it comes to the most bowl wins since the 1990 season. Miami (9-4), Florida State (9-5) and Michigan (9-5) lead the way, followed by the Buffs (8-4); Tennessee (7-7) could pull even with CU as it faces Texas A&M in the Cotton Bowl.

CLEMSON POST GAME NOTES
2005 CHAMPS SPORTS BOWL

- *Clemson's defense allowed just one touchdown tonight, the only touchdown the Clemson defense allowed over the last 43 possessions of the season. When the Buffs scored in the fourth quarter it broke a streak of 41 consecutive defensive touchdowns without allowing a touchdown.
- *Clemson's defense allowed just 124 yards of total offense by Colorado. It was a record for a Clemson bowl game, breaking the record of 159 allowed against TCU in the 1959 Bluebonnet Bowl. Clemson allowed just 17 yards rushing, best rushing defense in a bowl game in Clemson history. Tennessee had just 38 when Clemson downed the Volunteers in the 2003 Peach Bowl. That means Clemson has allowed just 55 rushing yards in its last two bowl games.
- *The 124 yards allowed were the fewest allowed by the Clemson defense since the season opener of 2000 when The Citadel had just 105 yards of total offense. It was the fewest yards allowed against a Division I-A team since Maryland had just 113 yards of total offense against Clemson in 1996.
- *Charlie Whitehurst completed 19-27 passes tonight and finishes the season with 227 completes in 338 attempts for a 67.2 completion percentage, a Clemson school record. He finishes his career with 42 Clemson school records.
- *James Davis finished the game with 28 carries for 150 yards. It was the second most rushing yards by a Clemson running back in a bowl game, trailing only the 151 accumulated by Clemson career rushing leader Raymond Priester in a loss to LSU in the 1996 Peach Bowl.
- *Davis recorded his ninth touchdown of the season. He broke the Clemson freshman touchdown record with his score in the fourth period. Many Tiger freshman had recorded eight touchdowns as freshmen previously. His 879 rushing yards for the season rank second in Clemson history by a freshmen, Ronald Williams had 941 in 1990. Davis also tied Williams record for 100-yard rushing games in a season by freshman. This was his fourth..
- *Jad Dean broke the Clemson single season field goal record with his 18-yard field goal in the first half. It gave him 24 for the season, one more than Obed Ariri had in 1980 when he led the nation in field goals per game.
- *Dean scored seven points on the night to give him 106 for the season, one point short of the Clemson kick scoring record for a season (107 by Chris Gardocki in 1989). He missed an extra point, his only extra point miss all year, when it was blocked. Had he made it he would have tied Gardocki's record for kick scoring in a season.
- *Gained Adams was credited with two sacks in tonight's game, giving him 9.5 for the season. He had seven of the 9.5 sacks over the last six games of the season. He had 7.5 of his 14.5 tackles for loss over the last three games of the season.
- *Charlie Whitehurst won his 25th game as Clemson's starting quarterback. He moved into second place on Clemson's all-time list, ahead of Nealon Greene who had 24 between 1994-97. Rodney Williams is still the career leader with 32.
- *Clemson won six of its last seven games to close the season. It is the first time since 1991 that Clemson has won six of its last seven games of the season.
- *This was Clemson's first win in a Florida bowl game since the 1990 season when Clemson beat Illinois 30-0 in Tampa in the 1991 Hall of Fame Bowl.
- *Clemson has now won three of its last four bowl games after losing five in a row from 1991-2000.
- *Charles Bennett had a career high 3.5 tackles for loss in his final game as a Clemson player. It was the most tackles for loss by any Clemson defensive player in a bowl game.
- *Clemson finished the season 6-1 when leading going into the fourth period and is now 43-6 under Tommy Bowden.
- *Clemson is now 25-4 with a 100-yard rusher under Tommy Bowden. Clemson is now 22-2 when leading at the half over the last four years.

CLEMSON POST GAME QUOTES

Head Coach Tommy Bowden

Impressions of the game:

"I thought it was a tremendous effort on Colorado's part. What their coaches and players had to go through was an extremely difficult thing. They were given no chance to win and they came out extremely well prepared and played hard the entire game. As far as the way we played, when our defense gives that kind of effort, we're a pretty good football team. It's been indicative of the way we have played all season. We have kept games close all year and then we have had to have a drive at the end and when our team has its back against the wall we seem to respond. It's indicative of how our season has gone all year. Our senior leadership from Charlie on down has built a solid foundation for our team."

On his seniors

"I told them last night that I will have more bowl opportunities but this would be their final opportunity. I could not be more proud of the way this group of seniors responded. They have accomplished things over the last four years that have never been done in Clemson history and we have been playing football for 103 years. Because of them, I think we have turned the corner..."

"We have Charlie Whitehurst sitting up here with a college degree... we have Charles Bennett sitting up here with a college degree... we had eight seniors who were a little late getting down here because they were receiving their college degrees. These guys have been great ambassadors for college football."

On the final drive

"It was something where you wanted to milk the clock as much as you can. They were out of timeouts, but we still needed first downs to keep the ball out of their hands. It was a time where you worry about having your team buckle, but giving it to James made it easy."

On Charlie Whitehurst

"I think he is his own worst critic, but I think all great players are. He struggled a little bit last year, but that was my fault, not his. I didn't put him in the position he needed to be in to make plays. I have been here seven years, and I have been very fortunate to have Charlie as my starting quarterback for four of those years."

On his Defense

"We came into this game without allowing a touchdown on the other team's last 31 possessions. What did they have tonight... One touchdown??? This is the type of defense that it takes to win championships. We have won a lot of games, but this is the type of effort that it takes to win championships."

On Orlando and the Champs Sports Bowl

"I've told Tom Mickle this and some of our media, but I want to publicly say it. Our team, our players, our staff and our administration have great appreciation for the Champs Sports Bowl. There is not a better destination than to come to Orlando for a bowl game. This bowl game with the leadership it has is going to have a long list of guys wanting to come here. I told my team, six wins you go to a bowl, seven wins you get a choice. This is the one we wanted to choose."

Quarterback Charlie Whitehurst

"We moved the ball but struggled getting it into the end zone. The defense kept getting the ball back for us and we put points on the board when we needed them. It was a team effort."

On freshman James Davis

"He's a freshman but he doesn't play like one and hasn't all year. Heck, I think I was more nervous this season than he ever was. We played a lot of first and second year players this year and I think the sky is the limit for them."

Running Back James Davis

"I'm just a freshman, but I am thankful that Coach Bowden gave me an opportunity this year and I was able to run with it."

"This was a great week. We got to go to Universal Studios and its something I always wanted to do. I hope I get to spend a couple of more days down here. As for the game, I think we stayed focused and we were ready to go."

Defensive End Charles Bennett

“Our defense did what it needed to do. Colorado is a good team and we were able to control the line of scrimmage. It’s not any one thing any one player did, it was a team effort.”

**Champs Sports Bowl Post-Game Press Conference
Tuesday, Dec. 27, 2005
Orlando, Fla.**

COLORADO HEAD COACH MIKE HANKWITZ

On the game:

"Well it's a bittersweet moment. I was extremely proud of our team, the way they fought and competed in the most difficult situation, amidst all the distractions, all the things that happened. I was extremely proud of that. I was disappointed that we couldn't stop them there at the end when we needed to and give us a chance to win. I'm proud of the coaching staff and the way they conducted themselves in an even more difficult situation, and I'm proud of the players. It's just one of those disappointing things to come that close, to fight that hard, but I give Clemson a lot of credit. They're an excellent team. We knew that coming in. With 10 points, they could've been a 10-1 team. They've got a great blend of youth and experience, and my hats are off to them."

On the team's inability to throw and how it is detrimental to the team:

"When a team's one-dimensional, it's a lot easier to defend. We thought James (starting QB James Cox) would relax a little. It's his first time in that situation. We thought he'd relax and be able to throw it more effectively and he wasn't able to get out of his tense, you know, stressful situation for him. Yeah, it makes it easier to defend."

On James Cox's nerves affecting his performance:

"It's not the easiest situation for a quarterback to have his first start amidst all the things that we've been through. The injuries we had to our offensive line...I mean, that's a difficult situation. I'd have liked for him to have more experience going into it, but that's the hand he was dealt. Sometimes you do that, you try to hard. You press, because you want to do so well, but you bhurt yourself unknowingly."

On game MVP, Clemson back James Davis:

"In our league, we've had some pretty excellent running backs, but he did an excellent job tonight, and he's got a great future. A young guy like that, I believe he was ACC newcomer of the year, and 750 yards, basically. He made our guys miss tonight."

On the positives to come out of the game:

"We didn't have a turnover. We got an interception. [John] Torp, our punter, punted extremely well. He had a 68 yard punt, which I believe is a bowl record. I think the players should be able to hold their heads high. It wasn't a win. It wasn't what we came to do, but it's hard to explain all the distractions and all the turmoil and all the things that have happened and the effect it could have on those kids. For them to come out and play like they did, I'm extremely proud of them."

COLORADO QB JAMES COX

On nerves affecting his performance:

"Yeah, I just game out and I pressed too hard, I was trying too hard, and I wasn't myself tonight, and that's frustrating to me because I know I can play a lot better than that. I feel like I let my team down in the first half, and in the second half, things just weren't there."

On having a sense of relief for the end of this tumultuous season:

I don't want to say a sense of relief. We played real hard this entire year, and we want to go out, especially for our seniors and our coaches, go out with a win. It was tough. We played a real tough game and everybody fought hard, but it didn't work out for us."

On the close game giving a sense of redemption after the blowout losses:

"It's hard to say redemption when you don't win, because that's what we're all about. We're all about winning. There's obviously some things that we can take away from the game, things that we did well. Our defense played awesome. The second half, we started moving the ball a little bit better. We could take some things away to learn from this."

On Clemson's defense:

“We knew that they had a great defensive line, and that’s how they got pressure, and then they started bringing a little more pressure with their [line]backers. It’s nothing that we weren’t prepared for. There were things there in the first half, and I couldn’t hit the receivers. In the second half, they were getting pressure, and it was hard to get any drop back, because they were getting pressure upfield. It just made it tough on us.”
