“We played a clean game tonight. We didn’t commit a whole lot of penalties, which I was pleased with. We did have those two fumbles, Chancellor had one, but overall I was happy with the way we played.”

“I told the team tonight, don’t go play Temple, just go play football. They needed to just come out and take care of business.”

**Clemson vs. Temple Game Notes**  
**October 12, 2006**

- Prior to the start of the game, the Temple University Football Program made a \$1500 commitment to the Fahmarr McElrathbey Trust by way of a letter written to Ray Ray McElrathbey from the Owls' head coach Al Golden. The Temple football team voted unanimously to donate their per diem for one week game to the trust.
- Thomas Hunter's 53-yard reception in the first quarter is the longest reception by a tight end since Ben Hall's 56-yard reception against Virginia in 2004.
- Gaines Adams recorded his 23<sup>rd</sup> career sack to move into a tie for third with Adrian Dingle and Keith Adams on the Clemson career sacks list.
- Gaines Adams has recorded at least one sack in five consecutive games which ties the Clemson record for most consecutive games with at least one sack. Adams is tied with Chester McGlockton, who accomplished the feat at the end of the 1989 season through the beginning of the 1990 season, and Keith Adams and Leroy Hill, who recorded sacks in five consecutive games in 1999 and 2004, respectively.
- James Davis' 64-yard touchdown run in the second quarter tied his career-long run. Davis also ran for a 64-yard touchdown to put the Tigers on the board in the first quarter against Louisiana Tech earlier this season.
- Will Proctor's 55-yard touchdown pass caught by Jacoby Ford in the second quarter was the longest reception of Ford's career. His previous long was an 11-yard catch against Wake Forest.
- The 49 points scored by Clemson in the first half are the most points scored in a half since the team put 49 on the board in the first half against Wake Forest on Halloween in 1981. The Tigers went on to win that game by a score of 82-24 over the Demon Deacons.
- With his 138-yard performance against Temple, James Davis now has six games with at least 100 rushing yards in his career. He ran for 100 or more yards in four games in 2005 and has reached the century mark in two games so far this season. All six of the games have been played at night.
- The Tigers have now scored more than 50 points in four games this season. This is the first time in Clemson football history that a team has had at least 50 points in four games.
- Nelson Faerber's recovery of Andrew Diomande's fumble for a touchdown in the third quarter was the first time that a Clemson player has recovered a fumble for a touchdown since 1998, when Chris Jones recovered a high center snap in the end zone for a score against Furman.
- Clemson scored in 11 consecutive possessions, including the final three possessions against Wake Forest, all seven possessions of the first half against Temple, and the first possession of the third quarter against the Owls. The streak ended on the Tigers' second possession of the half with a Demerick Chancellor fumble that was recovered by Temple's Terrance Banks.
- The 63 points scored by Clemson is a tie for the most points scored by a Tiger team under Head Coach Tommy Bowden. The last time the Tigers put 63 points on the board was in the 63-17 victory over South Carolina in 2003.
- Clemson has recorded over 200 yards in both passing and rushing for the second straight game. The Tigers are 46-0-1 all-time in games they have reached 200 yards in the air and 200 yards on the ground.
- The 54-point margin of victory by the Tigers in the 63-9 win over Temple is the largest margin of victory by a Clemson team under Tommy Bowden. The previous record was a 53-point difference in the 62-9 win over Missouri in 2000. The previous largest margin of victory for Clemson this season was in the 51-0 shutout of Louisiana Tech on September 30.

## **Opening Statement:**

That's obviously a team that's too big, too fast and too tough for us right now at this stage, and that's the truth. Maybe a lot of people don't want to hear that that's the truth. That's a good team right there that we played. I don't think our kids quit and we're going to keep preaching to them the little things that we have to do. We have to correct this penalty problem. I keep saying it every week. It's absolutely killing us. We just have too many inexperienced guys. There's really not much to say. That's just a high powered team right there. ## **On the performance of KOR Travis Shelton:**

That's the type of student-athlete he is. He's a unique player, truly elite speed and certainly would have made a difference for us and certainly will make a difference for us in the MAC conference. There are very few people like him in the MAC. Travis is a little bit different than he was in the Spring. He's tougher. Travis responded really well. He had the one drop, but I think that was a function of being tired. We have to continue to squeeze him and get him ready to go. He's a competitor and anyone who looks at that tape can see he's at a completely different speed.

## **On the performance of Clemson:**

I think this is the best Clemson team. This is clearly the best Clemson team. I can't recommend what they do, but all I know is this, they are running the ball with power and authority right now. That's the difference right now. They are able to convert on third and short. They're controlling the clock. They're controlling the game up front. He's running those backs in and out. They're kids are disciplined. They're doing a great job up front. They've really bought into what they want to get done down there. To me it's a completely different look. I know when we prepared for them in the past it was (Charlie) Whitehurst, and right now when you look at that O-Line and the way they're running the ball, it really sets up the deep threats.
