- Today's game marks the 19th meeting between the Tigers and Eagles. Clemson leads the all-time series with a 9-8-2 mark. It is the first time Clemson has defeated Boston College at home since 1958, when the Tigers defeated the Eagles by a score of 34-12. Clemson head coach Dabo Swinney has a perfect 2-0 record against the Eagles.
- Clemson held the Boston College offense to 55 total yards on 49 plays. That defensive performance ranks sixth on the Tigers' all-time list for fewest total offense yards by an opponent. Clemson's defense had an outstanding first half, holding Boston College to -2 yards of total offense. The Tigers also held the Eagles scoreless in the first half, just as they did in Chestnut Hill in 2008. In the third quarter, the Tigers allowed only 49 yards of total offense.
- **C.J. Spiller** is the first player in Clemson history to have a 100-yard game in each of the categories of kickoff returns, punt returns, rushing and receiving over the course of his career.
- **Spiller's** punt return for touchdown at 11:33 in the first quarter is the fifth different way Spiller has scored a touchdown, and is the first player in Clemson history to account for a touchdown five different ways (kickoff return, punt return, reception, run, pass). It was also his first career punt return for a touchdown, but his fifth touchdown on kick returns. That ties him with Justin Miller for the most scores (5) on kick returns.
- **Spiller** has 15 career touchdown plays of 50 yards or more, and is Clemson's career leader in that category. This was his second play of 50 yards or more against Boston College, as he caught a short pass then raced for 82 yards for a touchdown.
- Redshirt freshman **Rashard Hall** recorded his first career interception in the first half..
- **Richard Jackson**, a redshirt junior from Greer, SC, tied the Clemson record for field goals made in a game. Jad Dean set the Clemson record of six field goals made during the 2005 season, against Texas A&M. Jackson had three field goals in the first half, then followed that with a 52-yard field goal with 9:16 left in the third quarter. He tacked on his fifth made field goal of the day at the 10:56 mark of the fourth quarter, with a 42-yard boot. His sixth field goal was a 35-yard field goal made with 2:01 remaining in the game.
- **Jackson** is the first Clemson player to have two field goals of at least 50 yards in two games since 1992. He is the second player in Clemson history to have field goals of at least 50 yards in consecutive games. In 1990, Chris Gardocki had a field goal of at least 50 yards in three consecutive games - against Maryland, Appalachian State and Duke. The Clemson career record for field goals of 50 yards or more is five, held by Chris Gardocki (1988-90) and

Donald Igwebuike (1981-84). Jackson is also the third kicker in Clemson history to kick at least five field goals in the same game.

- Redshirt freshman linebacker **Jonathan Willard** had a tackle for loss (-3 yards) in his first defensive snap.
- Senior **Ricky Sapp** tallied two sacks for the second time in his career during today's game.
- **Jonathan Meeks**, a freshman from Rock Hill, SC, recorded his first career interception and returned it for 17 yards with 3:59 remaining in the game. He also had a PBU in the fourth quarter.
- The **lightning delay** occurring with 5:02 remaining in the third quarter (2:15-3:10 PM) is only the second lightning delay at Clemson since 1963. In 1963, there was a weather delay at Memorial Stadium against Georgia, then a weather delay for 17 minutes in the fourth quarter of the Clemson vs UNLV game in 1993. Today's game had another rain delay consisting of 48 minutes in the fourth quarter.

Richard Jackson

"Eight months ago, if you would have told me I was here, I would have told you that you were lying and laughed in your face. It's come a long way, and I can't take credit for that. I can't be any more honored with what happened today. It was a sloppy day today. There was wind, there was rain, everything was wet. Michael, Matt, and the offensive line were perfect. When they do that, it's easy for me to kick."

C.J. Spiller

"The guys up front did a great job blocking for me. We saw how they were going to punt all week, so once they made their blocks and I saw it open, I just tried to put a foot down and use my speed. It felt great to get that punt return—I've been waiting about four years to get it."

Thomas Austin

"On offense as a whole, we just weren't playing well. We'll see what the film is doing. I thought we were well-prepared, and we came in and made adjustments. A little bit of a silver lining is the way we put that drive together in the fourth quarter and chewed up the clock."

DeAndre McDaniel

"This is our basic defense. We've been wanting to play this since Week One. We didn't get to play this Week One or Week Two because of the offenses we faced, but we were ready to play it today. We knew what we had to come out here and do."

Jarvis Jenkins

"They had four out of five returning offensive linemen, they had an All-American center, and that was motivation for me and Brandon Thompson to go and prove what we can do. They were really good, but I think our offensive line is better up front. We practice against them, and there's nobody better in the country to go against practice-wise."

Quick Notes on Clemson's Win over Boston College

Player Notes

- C.J. Spiller returned a punt 77 yards for a touchdown in the first quarter, his first punt return for a score as a Clemson player. Spiller became the first player in Clemson history to account for a touchdown five different ways (punt return, kickoff return, rush, pass reception and touchdown pass).

- Spiller had 119 punt return yards in the game, third highest total in Clemson history for a single game and second most by a Division I player so far this year.

- Spiller had 77 rushing yards and went over 2500 rushing yards for his career.

- He now needs just 291 all-purpose yards to become the ACC leader.

- Spiller is currently second in the nation in all-purpose running, second in punt returns and fifth in kickoff returns.

- Spiller only player in the nation with a punt return for TD and a kickoff return for a TD so far this year.

- McDaniel has interception in three straight games. Clemson record is four straight games. He is third in nation in interceptions

- Jackson leads nation in field goals with 3.67 per game. Only player in the nation so far to kick six field goals in a game. He is fifth in the nation in scoring.

- Jackson also set Clemson record for yards on field goals in a game, his six field goals were for 217 yards. Also tied kick scoring record with 19 points.

- *Jackson first Clemson kicker to field goals of at least 50 yards in back to back games since 1990 (Chris Gardocki).

- Sapp two sacks and three tackles for loss. 16th in nation in tackles for loss.

Team Notes

- *Had 152 yards rushing, most by Clemson against BC since they came into the ACC.

- Clemson held BC to 54 yards total offense, sixth best in Clemson history, second best against an ACC opponent. Best total defense figure by Clemson team in any game since 1963.

- *Held Boston College to 1.1 yards per play, best by a Clemson defense since 1987 vs. Virginia Tech

- Held Boston College to four first downs, best by a Clemson defense since 1989 vs. Furman.

- *Held Boston College to 25 yards passing, best by a Clemson defense since 1991.

- *Had 127 punt return yards and a 31.8 average. 11th most punt return yards in a game in Clemson history.

- Defense has now held opponents under 30 percent completion percentage twice in a row. That had been done just eight times total in the last 32 years.

- *Had three more interceptions and we now have eight to rank second in the nation. We have forced nine takeaways to rank sixth in the nation.

- Team is now second in the nation in pass efficiency defense and ninth in pass defense (yards allowed).

In 2005 when Jad Dean kicked six field goals in the win over Texas A&M, Clemson's only touchdown in that game was scored on a punt return by Chansi Stuckey. In Clemson's win over Boston College, Richard Jackson kicked six field goals and Clemson's only touchdown came on a punt return...by C.J. Spiller. Clemson scored 25 points in both games.
